Experimental Encaustic Workshops 2020 Schedule:

FOUR HOUR CAVO-RILIEVO LEAF PRINT WORKSHOPS:

Cavo-Rilievo: meaning Hollow Relief in Italian. It is a simple process of making leaf impressions in warm beeswax with live plant leave and then rubbing oil pastels in leaf vein impressions.

Students will complete one leaf print on a 6x6" birch panel and one leaf print on a 5x7" birch panel.

Students can bring their own live leaves to work with.

We will be making wax leaf prints with live leaves. Dry and brittle leaves will not work for this process. Hardy leaves with thick vein that can lay flat work best for this process. Keep leaf sizes under 5". Examples: maple, cedar, oak, ferns, and ginkgo leaves work great. After picking leaves keep live leaves cool, moist, and flat until the workshop. No succulent and thick leaves.

FOUR HOUR ENCAUSTIC PHOTO TRANSFER WORKSHOPS:

Taking black and white toner photo copies and transferring images onto wax. High contrast images work best.
