Welcome to our test! Please arrive at the test site ready to run no later than 7:00 a.m.
The running order is listed below.

Our tests are nearly full and days will be long. Because PCNA tests comprise various events, the dog and handler should be ready to spend an entire day at the test.

LOCATION

Bridgeport, California is located on Hwy 395 in the Eastern Sierra Mountains

TEST GROUNDS

Please note the test grounds here could be subject to a slight change based on the land owners cattle and grazing needs. Please contact the test Chairman 2 weeks before for confirmation. The field test site is located 14.6 miles north from the Hwy 395/Hwy 182 junction on Hwy 182 which turns into Hwy 338 at the Nevada border. Turn right on a dirt road with a sign that says Hawthorne 38 miles--unpaved road. The testing grounds are 1.6 miles on the dirt road.

The UT & NA water site is 4.1 miles north on Hwy 182 on the Bridgeport Reservoir.

The UT duck search site is 8.0 miles north on Hwy 182 on the East Walker River.

Please take extra care to leave the grounds cleaner, if possible, than you found them. Pick up papers and, especially, any "gifts" your dog might leave in the parking areas.

WHAT TO BRING

Appropriate clothing: High temps should be in the 80's and low's in the 40's. If you are running a dog, wear sturdy shoes or boots and long pants.

Ear protection:

Water: For yourself and your dog. Bring a water bottle to carry with you in the field for your dog.

Folding chair: You will be doing quite a bit of waiting throughout the day. You will also want a comfy place to sit while you enjoy lunch.

First-Aid kit for dogs and humans: Insect repellent • Sunscreen and cap

SAFETY AND SPORTSMANSHIP

If you wish to accompany/watch a dog during the test, you must obtain permission from the judges AND the handler.

Blaze orange clothing MUST be worn any time live ammunition is in use. This applies to ALL people in the field. We have orange vests and/or hats available.

Dogs must be kept under positive control during the test except when being judged. Above all, dogs must not be allowed to run at large through fields where other dogs are judged. An exercise area for dogs on & off lead will be designated.

Open containers of alcoholic beverages are not permitted until the last dog has run for the day and shotguns are put away.

Female dogs in season must be kept away from the rest of the dogs and out of the fields.

Any person violating safety and/or sportsmanship rules will be required to leave the grounds immediately.
