

# **BILLING POLICY**

Little Gem Medical is a Universal Bulk Billing practice effect 1st November 2025.

#### 1. Consults are Bulk Billed

Bulk billing is the process of a doctor billing Medicare, Australia's public health insurance scheme, directly for the services provided to the patient, so there are no out-of-pocket expenses.

All doctors at Little Gem Medical now Bulk Bill all medical consults for all Medicare covered patients.

### 2. Fees for Procedures

Procedures requiring a more specialised skill and use of supplies will incur a flat fee to cover costs. This will be discussed with your Doctor prior to the service being provided.

Procedures include, but are not limited to, Excisions, Implanon insertion/removal, Iron Infusions, Spirometry, ECGs, Cryotherapy and Ear Syringe.

## 3. National Immunisation Program

The National Immunisation Program provides government funded vaccinations for infants and children, pregnant women, seniors, First Nation's people and anyone under Medicare with a condition that puts them at greater risk of certain disease.

Any immunisations outside of the National Immunisation Program will incur a cost to the patient which will be confirmed prior to anything be administered.

Program eligibility and the immunisations covered is detailed here.

#### 4. Questions and Answers

- a. What if I have travelled from overseas and I am not covered by Medicare? You will be asked to privately pay for the consult at a fee determined by the specific Doctor.
- b. What happens if I have a Newborn without a Medicare Card?

  Newborn babies who are waiting on their new Medicare cards will have payments 'held' until they reach 3 months of age and then bulk billed when the card is received. It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure Little Gem receives the new Medicare card.
- c. What if I have a Department of Veteran Affairs (DVA) card? If you have a Veteran Gold Card, DVA will cover the cost of all medical conditions.

If you have a Veteran White Card, DVA will cover the cost of medical care for an approved war or service caused injury or disease.
