

A Community's Vision

Rebuilding the Cultural Centre at 107 Drayton

1. ****Prepare the Soil Jar:****

- **Collect your soil from ****107 Drayton Street / Warrego Highway, Dalby******, the site where the *first sods were turned and the promise made to build the cultural centre there.*
- Place the soil in a jar or container that feels meaningful to you—this will hold the energy of the promise and the land.

2. ****Tie the Binding:****

- Take your survey flagging tape or a piece of string or wire even, and use it to tie around the jar. As you do this, visualise the act of ****binding**** the promise to this site and to the people.
- As you tie the tape, ****state your intention out loud**** (or in your mind):
 - *“This binding holds the promise made here at 107 Drayton Street. We bind this commitment to the land, to the people, and to the future. The cultural centre will be built here, as promised. And we call upon the politicians to honour their word.”*
- Let the act of tying the binding serve as a visual and energetic tether to that original promise.

3. ****Display the Jar:****

- Place the jar of soil with the binding in a place where you'll see it daily—on a shelf, desk, or somewhere visible.
- Every time you see the jar, ****reaffirm the vision****: I see the new cultural centre being built on the promised site at ****107 Drayton Street****.

4. ****Visualise the Promise Fulfilled:****

- As you look at the jar, close your eyes and ****visualise**** the cultural centre coming to life at the promised site at 107, just as it was intended. See it growing, bustling with energy, and serving the community.
- In your mind, ****remove Thomas Jack Park**** from the development plans entirely. Picture it as the green, historical space it has always been, preserved and untouched.

5. ****Reaffirm Your Withdrawal of Consent:****

- With each glance at the jar, also visualise withdrawing your consent from the development plans for ****Thomas Jack Park****. You are actively taking back your power and refusing to accept the development of the park.
- You can say silently or aloud: *“We withdraw our consent for development in Thomas Jack Park. The promise was made, and it is the people's will that this park remain untouched. Let the centre be built where it was promised, at 107 Drayton Street.”*

6. ****Extend the Binding:****

- If possible, ****share this ritual**** with others in your community. The more people who see the jar and participate in this act of "binding," the stronger the energy becomes.
- Encourage others to collect soil from the original site, tie their own string, and join the collective vision of holding the politicians accountable to their word.

You're taking control of the energy around this situation, binding the politicians to their original plan, and withdrawing consent for any alternative that doesn't honour it.
