Dear David and Ann,

When did honour become a title ? I thought honour was something bestowed upon someone for honourable conduct - not only a title for being voted in as a public representative. Do you think all politicians act honourably ?

David, I received a flyer from you saying you were against Labour's (insanely excessive) migration policy. But are you really ? We here in Dalby are about to loose much of our beloved Thomas Jack Memorial Park to commercial development - primarily because of hugely excessive demands for housing. Thereby erasing our actual culture.

Western Downs Regional Council voted unanimously to "dispose of the original site for their planned cultural centre - for HOUSING ". This was before a "Have Your Say Survey" was conducted which included a survey on possible locations, of which the original site (resolved to be sold for housing) was included as an option.

Ann, the company that did the survey (FourFold) actually lied to council by misrepresenting their own findings. In a glowing 39 page report by Council a community response "Should Not take away from Green Space" received a High Priority of over 4 stars. But in a presentation to Council Fourfold said that priority had a "low ranking" of below 4 stars. And for this FourFold received a Commendation from the Planning Institute Australia - an esteemed institution ! A commendation for lying.

Speaking of lying, Anthony Albanese said "my word is my bond" - then turned around and broke his word on taxation and many other things. Is this worthy of the title "Honourable" ? David, you broke ground at the original site promising the people would get a new cultural centre on the original site - is your word, your bond as good as Anthony Albanese ?

Speaking of Leadership, I see that David Crisafulli is now accepting political donations up to something like \$170'000 from property developers - contrary to advice on anti corruption.

And here we are in Dalby, loosing our Park because NOBODY can tell the 94 ALP Representatives (because that's who they represent, their party, not the people) - Nobody is

willing to tell them their grossly excessive migration policy is insane. That this level of migration has caused so much homelessness and stress for many many Australians.

I've seen Crisafulli, Ann Leahy, and the Mayor and Councillors of the Western Downs running around bending over backwards trying to accommodate these ridiculous migration levels by fast tracking housing developments.

And we are about to loose our Park to commercialisation, to pander to Representatives that only represent Globalists that want to re-make all Western Nations into multicultural societies by hook or crook - no matter what the cost. No matter how many stabbings, rapes, or homeless.

Oh if developing our Park to make way for Housing is such a noble cause, why not put thousands of apartments on the hill at Canberra ? All that undeveloped space - and it would probably house 3 weeks of migration - not the 3 hours sacrificing our park will do.
