This petition was suggested by David Littleproud in response to Warwick Geisel, the former 19-year Mayor of Dalby. It followed a discussion about what more could be done to bring State and/or Federal scrutiny to Council's community consultation process and transparency. The focus is on the proposed reconstruction *and location* of the community and cultural centre, replacing what was demolished at MyALL 107.
