"Shrinky-Dink" Class Repeat: Some of you may remember "Shrinky-Dink" back in the '70's & 80"s, where you color a picture on plastic, then shrink it in the oven. The first class was held on March 15th with only 3 participating. But we were able to test out the project and learned what worked and didn't work. So now we would like to offer it again so that more will know how to do this before we present it to the children as an activity at one of the local ferias, after-school classes, or maybe at the sterilization clinics. It has also been proposed by a community member that we start a registry of the dogs in the Pedasí district in concurrence with this activity. THE COST OF A STERILIZATION CLINIC

Animal Advocates of Pedasi offers low-cost spay & neuter clinics to everyone. But income for these services can be far less than the actual cost of the clinic. We do share with those who seek our services what our vet(s) charge, presently \$30 per dog & \$15 per cat. And we ask, if they are able, to pay this low amount. But no one is turned away for lack of being able to pay, and all are told to pay what they can. And then there are the feral cats with no owners that AAP volunteers trap and sterilize at each clinic. There are many additional costs as well: paper & cleaning supplies, table & chair rental fees, food & drinks for the vets and volunteers, etc. Plus one time purchases when necessary for traps, crates, recovery mats, etc. This is why we ask for cash donations & volunteers, and conduct various fundraisers to help subsidize all the additional costs in order to offer clinics throughout the area.
