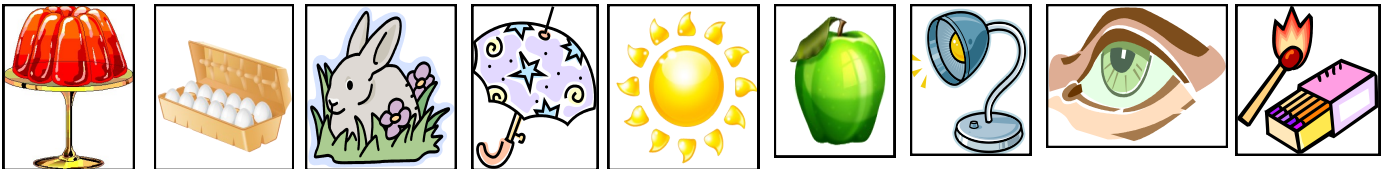
Crowds of people always followed Jesus everywhere

Jesus invites us all to be on his side

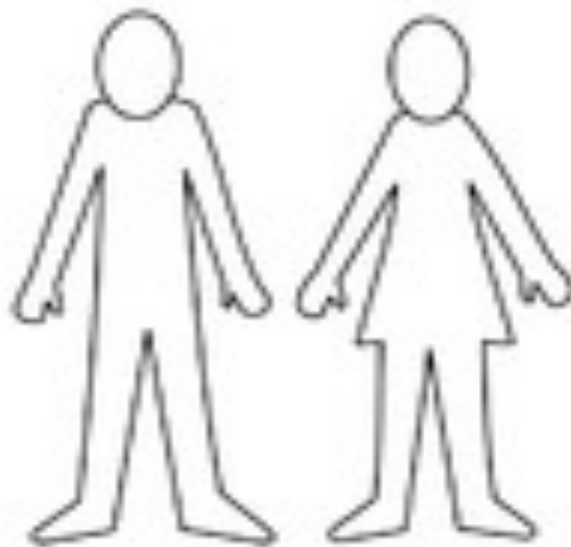


Being on God's side means more than calling yourself a Christian. It means believing in him even when things aren't going well.
