

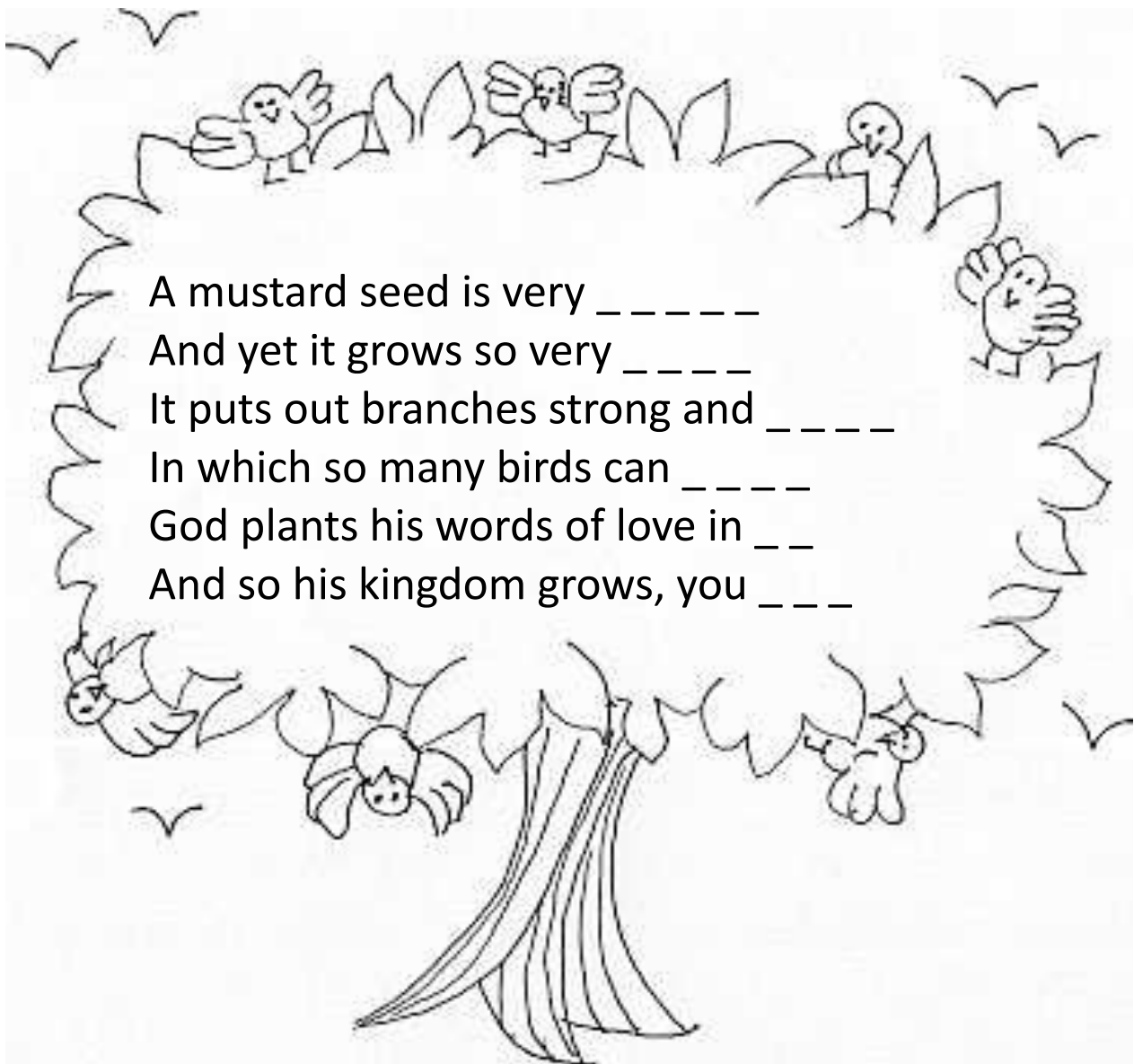

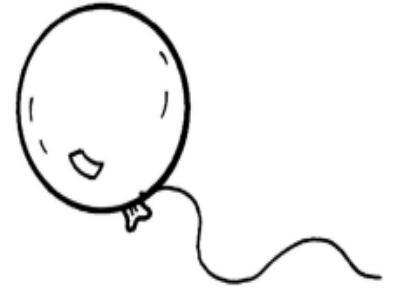


A mustard seed is very \_\_\_\_\_

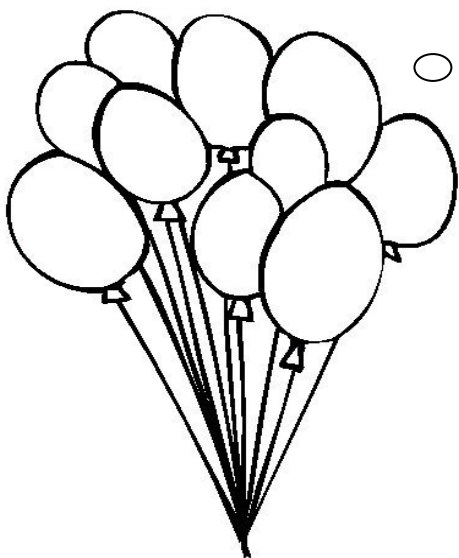
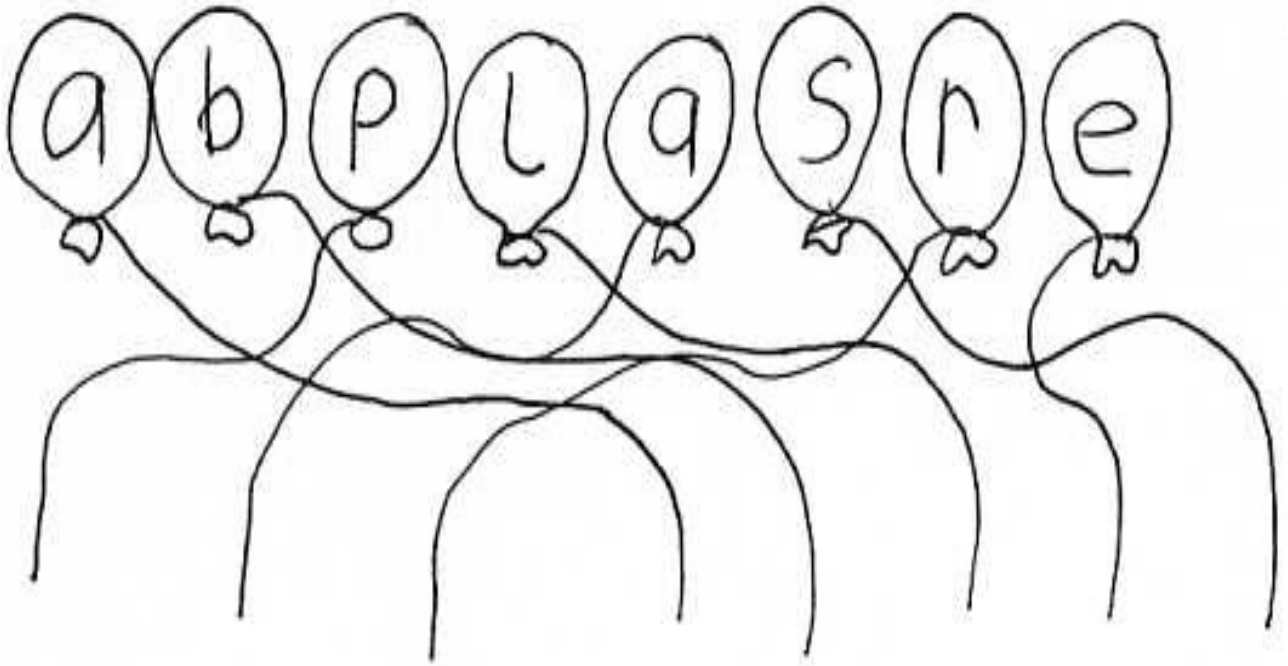
Can you see the birds hiding in the tree?
