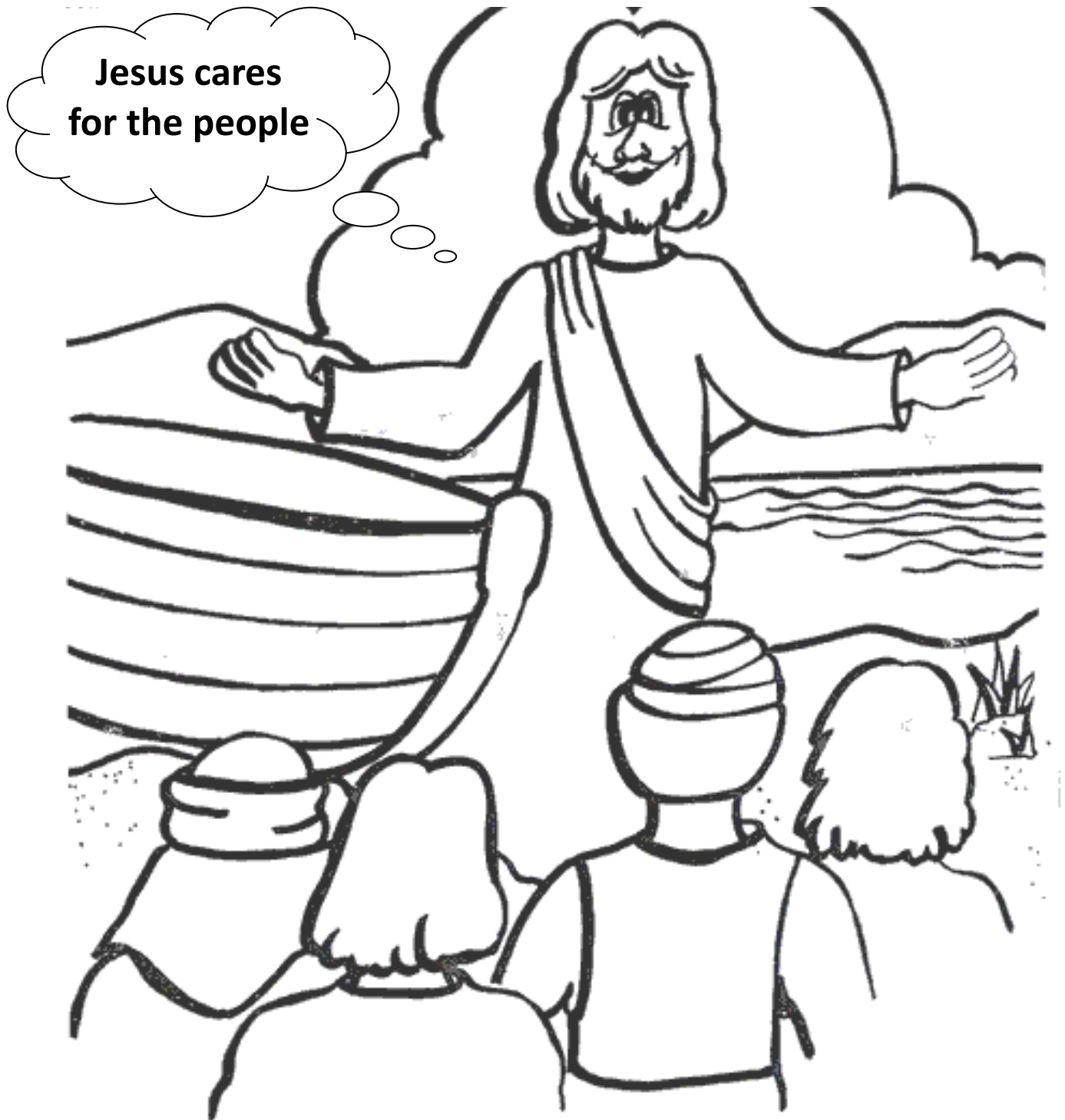

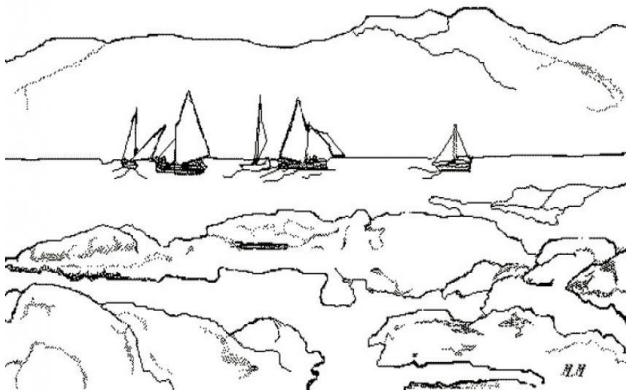
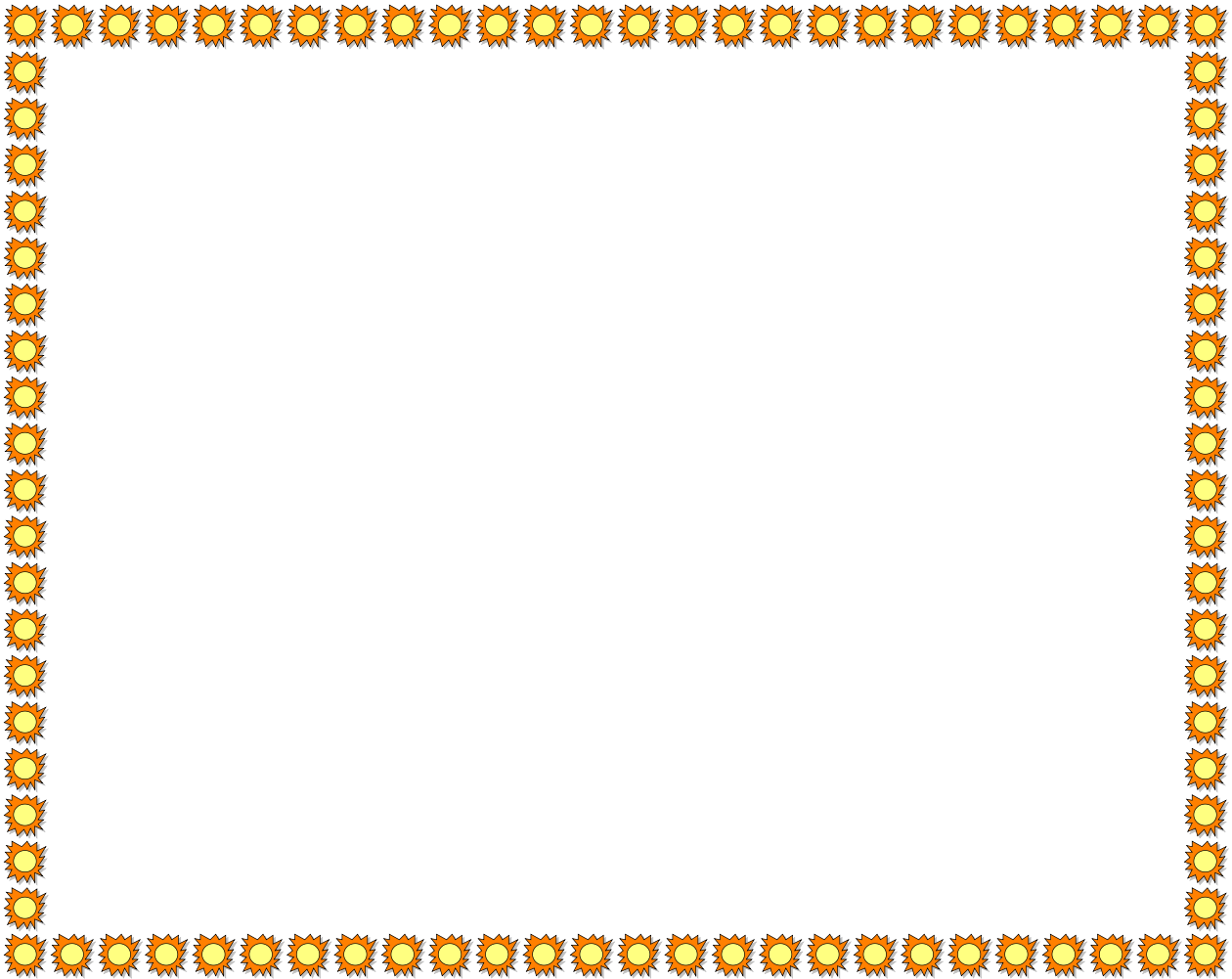
18 July 2021, the Eighth Sunday after Pentecost: Mark 6: 30-34, 53 to end



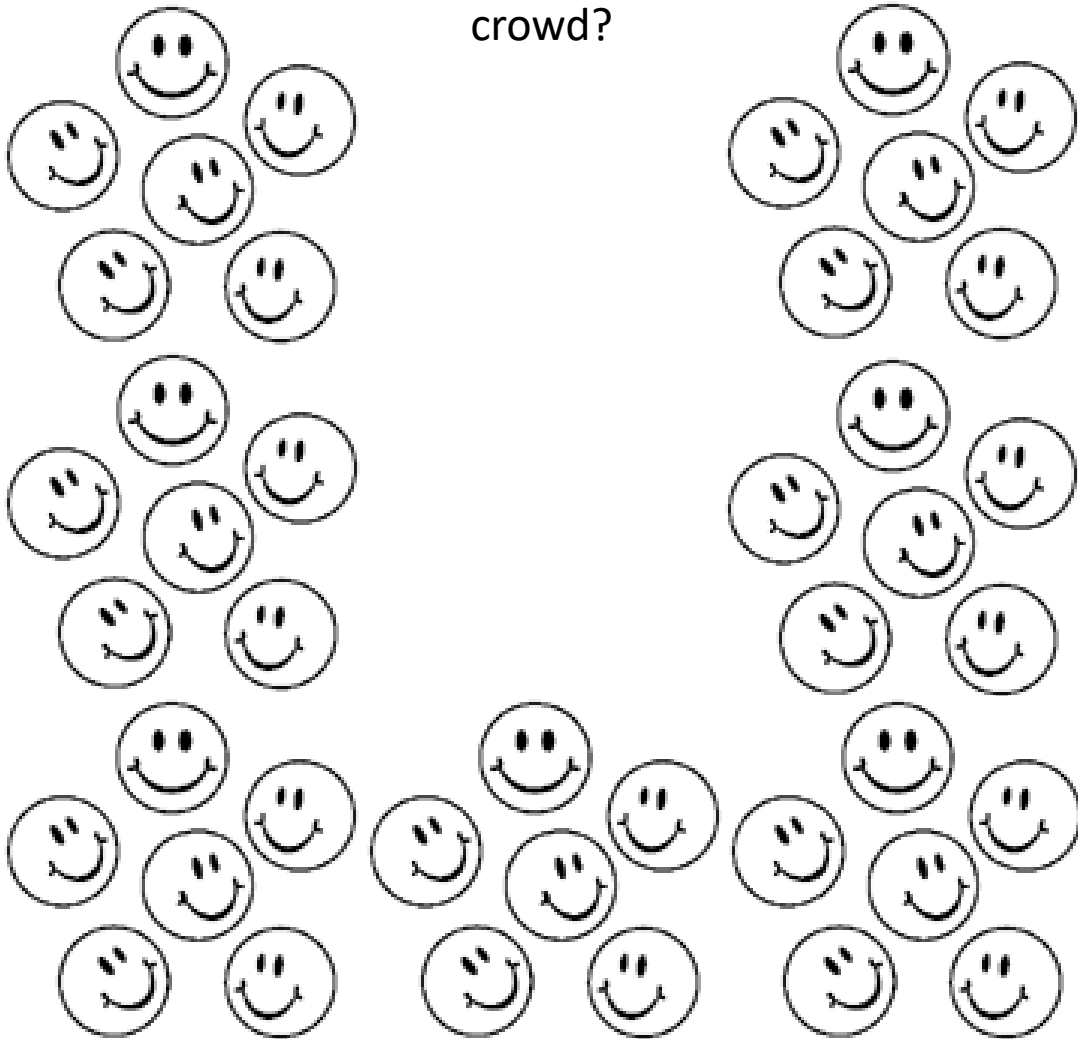
Jesus crossed the lake but people recognized him and brought sick people to him to heal

Draw a picture of where you would like to go

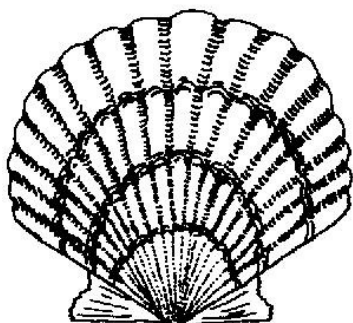


Here is a crowd of smiley faces. Can you draw Jesus in the middle of the crowd?



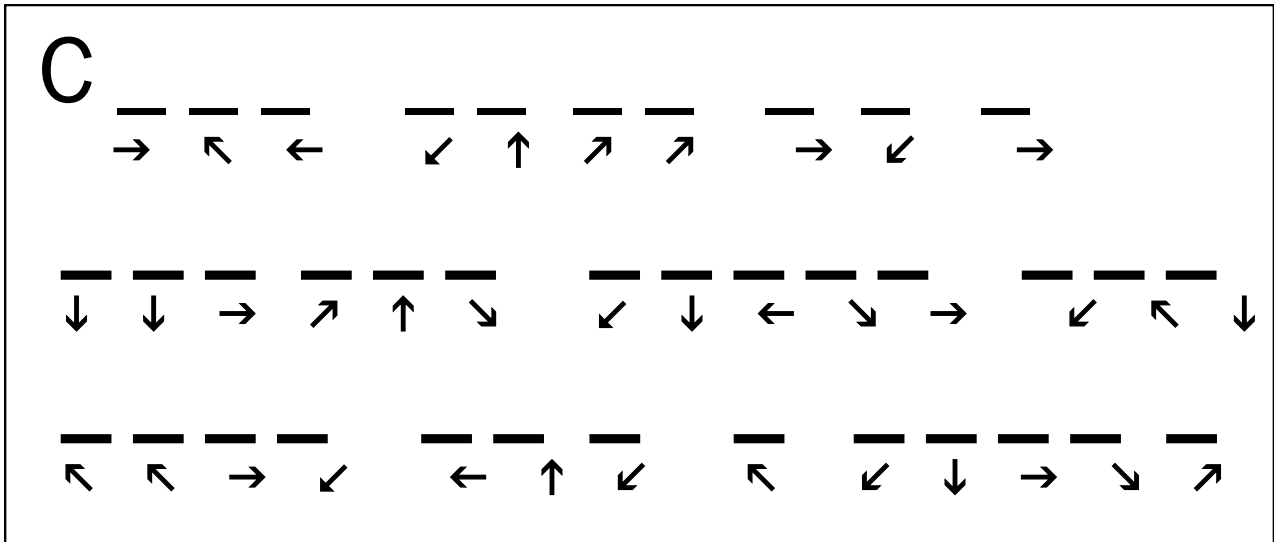
