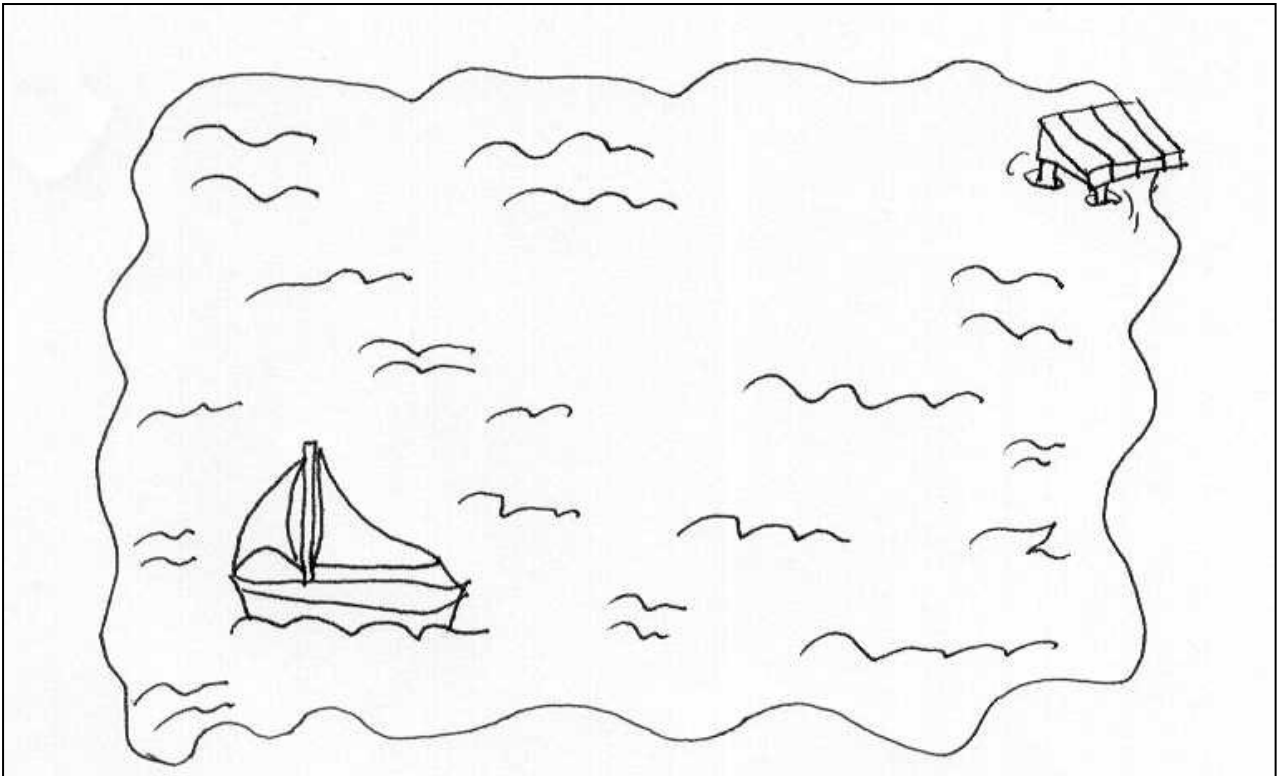
20 June 2021, the Fourth Sunday after Pentecost: Mark 4: 35 to 41

Can you draw the course the boat took through the waves?



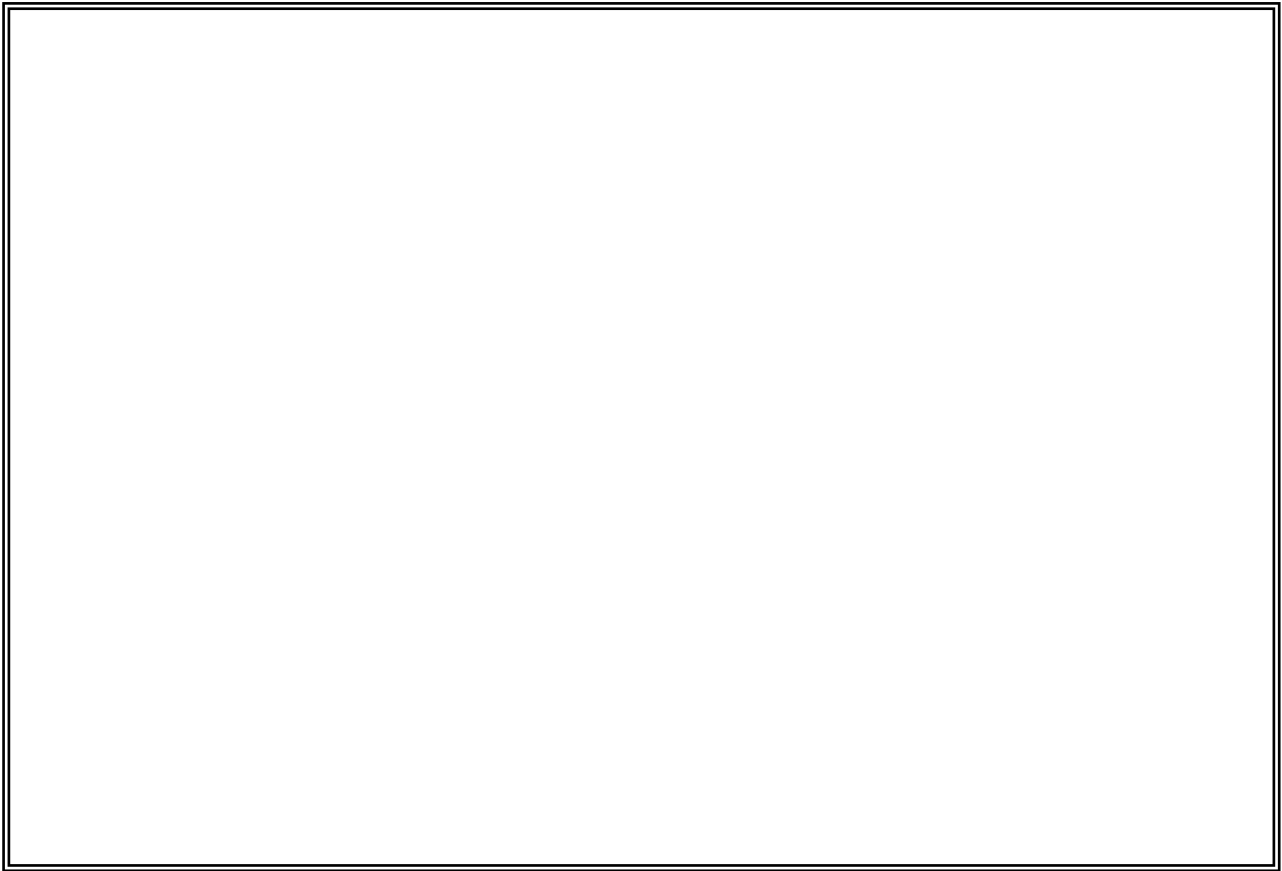
A great storm blew up and the boat began to sink
