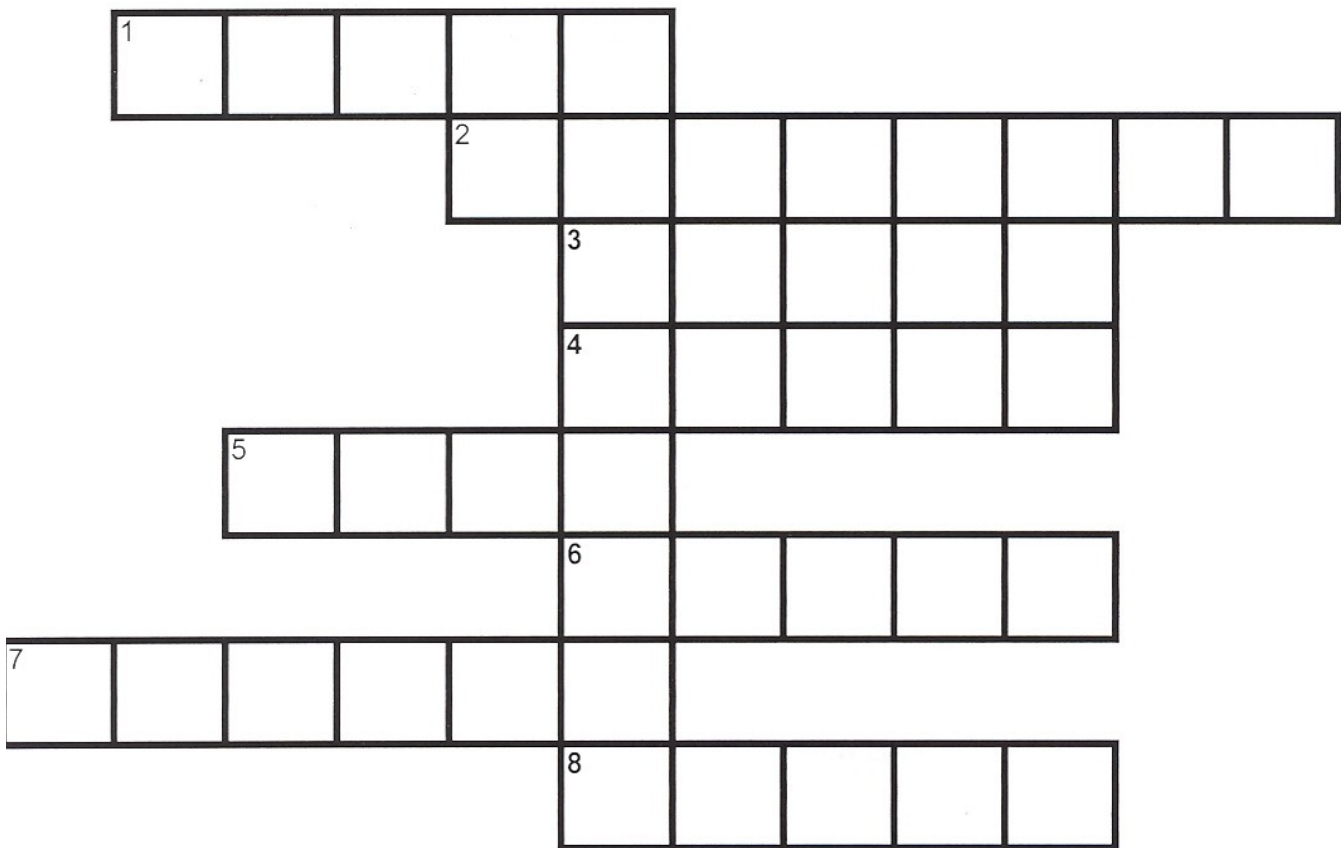


Jesus stood up to read the Scriptures in the Synagogue

Use the clues below to spell out the name of the town

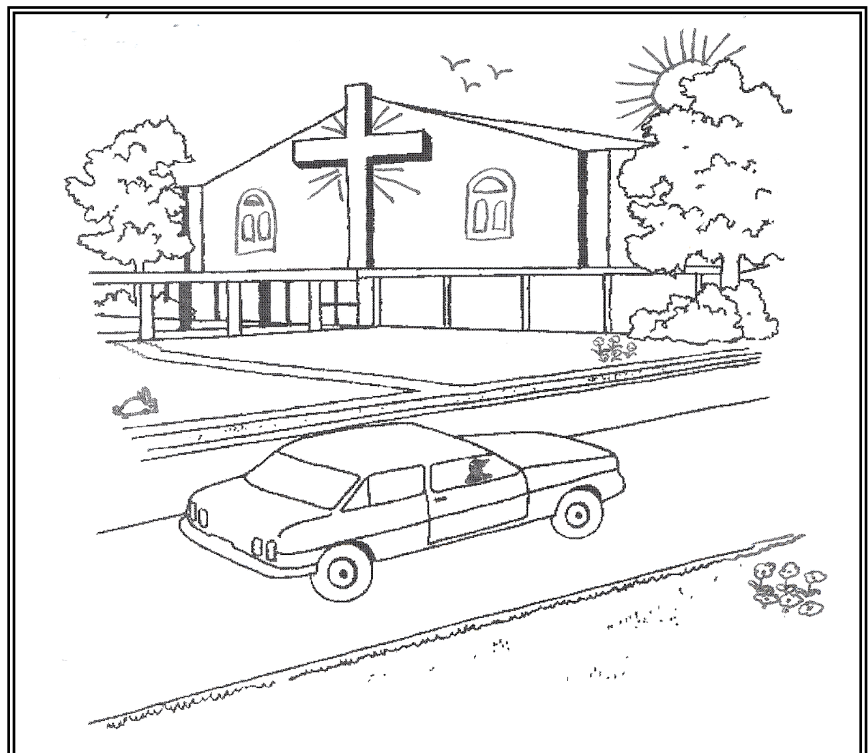
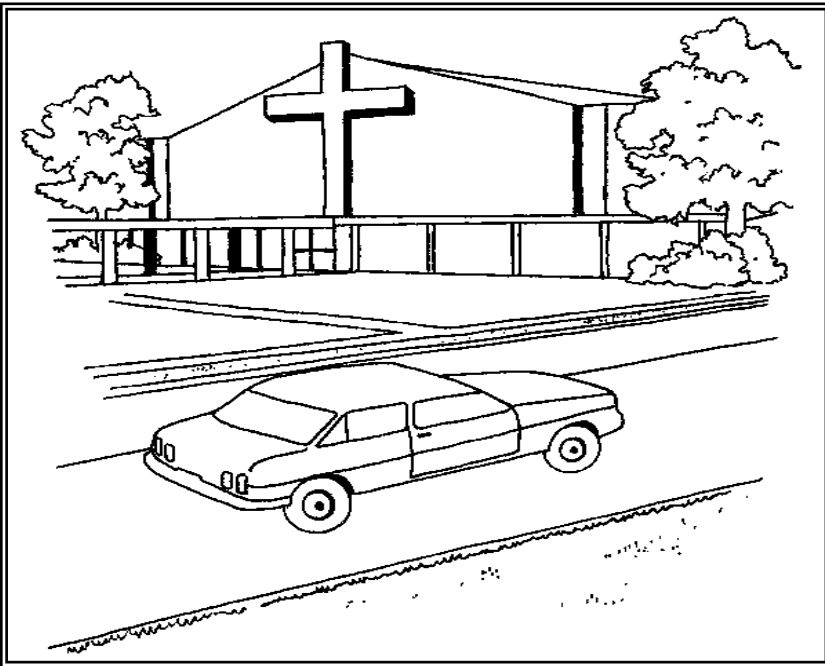

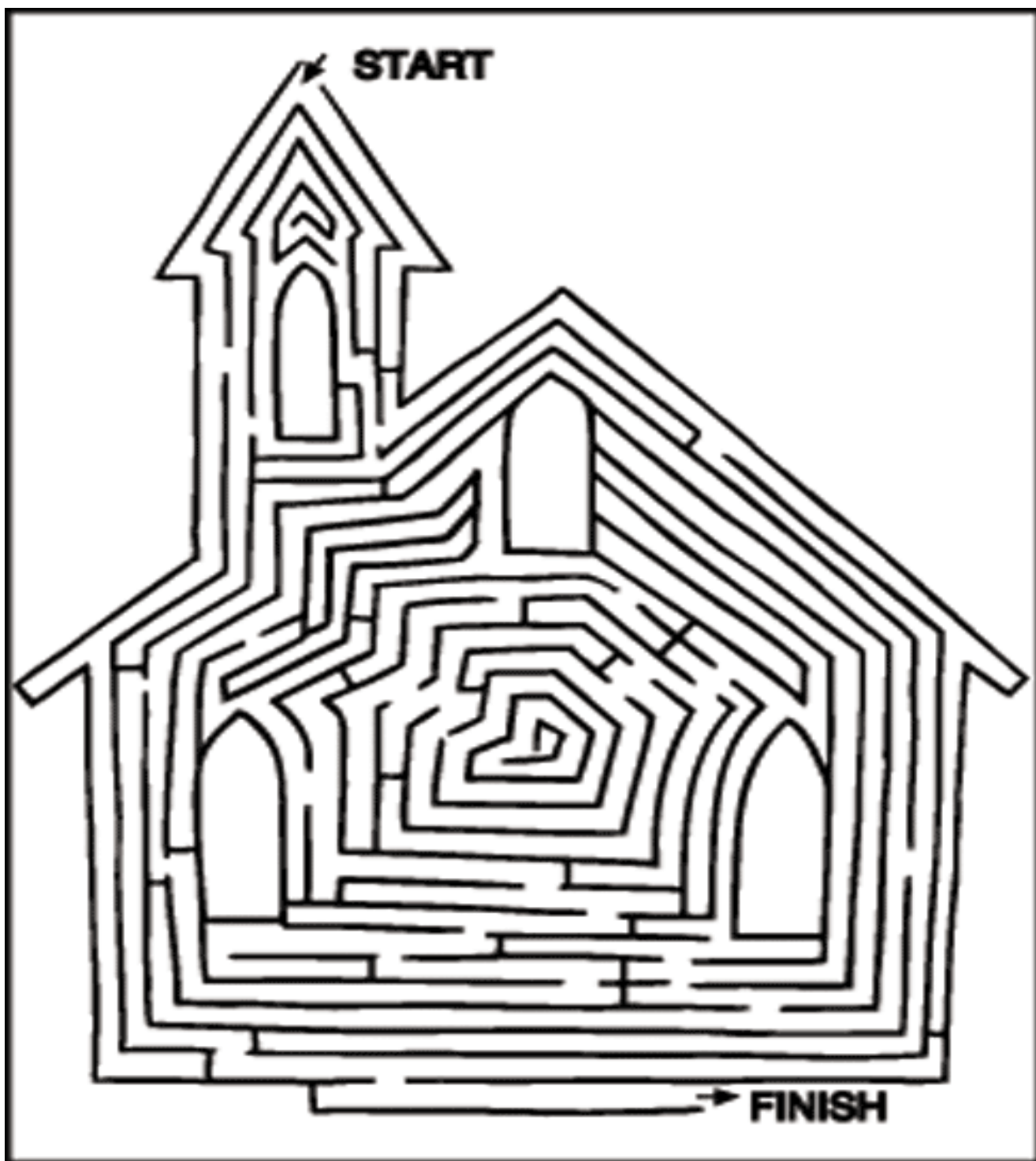
