**For Remaining Lapsed Leads:** First and foremost, I hope you are keeping yourself safe and healthy. I also want to thank you for your past support as a donor. Your generosity played an important part in bringing the artistry of New York City Ballet to the world, and we will always be grateful for that. Thank you!

<u>For Acquisition Leads:</u> First and foremost, I hope you are keeping yourself safe and healthy. I also want to thank you for your interest in New York City Ballet. Your support as a \_\_\_\_\_ [ticket buyer/subscriber] means a lot to us.

## PRESENTATION and FIRST ASK

I'm calling about the hundreds of New York City Ballet dancers, musicians and staff whose work and livelihoods have been impacted by the cancellation of our spring season at Lincoln Center. Despite the complete loss of ticket sales, New York City Ballet made a commitment to continue paying its artists and staff through the end of the spring season, which has led to a budget shortfall of approximately \$8 million through June 30th alone.
