Grand Prairie United Charities was founded in 1955. We are committed to fostering a compassionate community where every family has the resources they need to thrive. Our mission is to empower families by providing essential support through food distribution, emergency financial assistance and a steadfast commitment to bring hope to anyone who has fallen on hard times. Together we strive to build a brighter future for all members of our community.

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Grand Prairie United Charities provides **free services** for low-income families within the Grand Prairie city limits, who **struggle with basic needs** such as food, utilities, and shelter. These are the programs offered at Grand Prairie United Charities.

- Qualified families can apply for emergency financial assistance to assist with rent, mortgage, shelter, and/or utilities (based on funding available).
- People and Nutrition (PAN) is a non-perishable food program for adults 60 or over. We collaborate with North Texas Food Bank to assist over 125 families monthly.
- Our **on-site food pantry** is open 4 days a week to alleviate food insecurity.
- We also provide over 400 holiday meals for both Thanksgiving and Christmas.

GPUC is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization funded through generous donors like you, corporations, private foundations, and the City of Grand Prairie. We have two major fundraisers each year, Off to The Races and Boots, Bag & Bingo. We invite you to join us!
