

CASE STUDIES – CROWN CASINO

Crown Casino Perth and Sydney

Project background and description — The Crown Promenade Perth Refurbishment Perth complex underwent a massive extension and makeover in 2015.

The Crown project manager was looking for cost effective wall panel solutions on 27 floors of corridors, elevators and other entertainment venues within the complex.

Budget restraints were restricting the ability to source and provide a locally produced durable customised high quality wall panel solution.

The problem — Perth based suppliers were unable to provide a customised solution in line with Crown's stringent quality and durability specifications.

With an ever expanding cost of the entire refurbishment, the Crown project management team were looking for a supplier globally to meet their specific requirements under tight timelines.

Project goals and objectives — The selected major national architectural firm, acting on behalf of Crown had to frequently change the specifications and review their clients specifications.

Many samples were made until the final approval.

Outcome — The entire 27 floors of corridors, elevators and other entertainment areas located at the Crown Promenade Perth Refurbishment Perth complex had tailored made wall panel solutions within budget and on time whilst exceeding quality expectations.

The wall panel solution was so successful, the walls were added to other areas of the Crown Promenade Perth Refurbishment Perth complex and will also be included in the new Crown Towers Barangaroo, Sydney due to open December 2020.
