

TO OUR **STAKEHOLDERS**



Our focus continues on improving the wellbeing of Lebanon's population and specially the poor and marginalized men, women, and children through empowering healthcare institutions with products and services to facilitate their mission. We have been pleased to extend our services to cover a larger recipient base throughout the country reaching thousands of beneficiaries. With your support, we also added new strategic partners to our donor base.

Although our cash financial donations have been reduced, our supplies and product donor support have impressively grown. Central to our mission is helping one hand at time at the grassroot level to cultivate lower and limited income persons and transition them to become an active and productive members of the society.



FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS



During the calendar year 2022, we have received \$13,015,888 of pharmaceutical products, medical equipment and supplies from which we have distributed the value of \$12,165,510 to more than 120 recipients. Our total in cash donation receipts shrank by 35% from last year to \$177,118 from which we have conducted Donor Directed Missions (DDM) valued at \$65,575. Since its inception in August 2020, People to People aid Corp. has received, shipped meds and supplies mostly originating from the United States of America and distributed in Lebanon more than 500 palettes of products valued at more than \$48 million expending less than \$250,000 on direct global and local logistics and administrative cost.











OPERATING HIGHLIGHTS

During 2022, our team of staff and volunteers has surpassed the 100 distribution missions around the country including special DDMs (Donors Directed Missions) that included the following actions:



- Organized and coordinated the receipt and delivery of a fullfledged Fire Engine to Mar Mikhael Civil Defense Branch in Beirut.
- Donor: The city of Los Angeles in cooperation with the American Task Force On Lebanon (ATFL) and California based Lebanese Americans.

- Supplementing food security to marginalized populations in Beirut and Tripoli.
- Donor: AUB Medical School Class of 1984.
