How to pray the Chaplet of Our Lady, Star of the Sea

This Chaplet has a Medal of the Virgin Mary, 3 separate beads and then 1 set of 12 beads.

Beginning at the medal, say the following prayer:

V: Most beautiful Flower of Mount Carmel,
Fruitful Vine, Splendor of Heaven,
Blessed Mother of the Son of God,
Immaculate Virgin,
assist me in this my necessity.
O Star of the Sea,
help me and show me herein
that you are my Mother.

R: Holy Mary, Mother of God,
Queen of Heaven and Earth,
I humbly beseech you
from the bottom of my heart,
to succor me in this necessity;
there are none that can withstand your power.

V: For the Holy Father
Our Father....

V: For the Bishop
Hail Mary....

V: For the Parish Priests
Glory Be....

On each of the 12 beads that follow, these representing the 12 stars on
Our Lady's Crown, say

V: *Hail Mary....*

V: Our Lady, Star of the Sea

R: Help and protect us.

V: Sweet Mother,

R: I place this cause in your hand.

End with the Sign of the Cross.
