Chaplet of the Most Holy Trinity

The Most Holy Trinity chaplet is normally recited on the regular Rosary. It should be offered through the Five Sacred Wounds of Our Lord in reparation for the crimes of sinners.

You begin by praying on the Crucifix,

- V. Incline unto my aid, O God,
- R. O Lord make haste to help me.

On the three small and one large bead, you pray,

V. Glory be to Thee, O most sweet, most noble, resplendent, peaceful, ineffable Trinity.

R. Amen

On each of the ten small beads of each decade, you pray,

V. Glory, honor and praise be to the great Eternal God.

R. Amen.

After each decade of 10 small beads you pray,

V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit

R. as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

You conclude the chaplet with three more Glory Be's and the recitation of the following Divine Praises,

ALL:

Blessed be God!

Blessed be his Holy Name!

Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true man!

Blessed be the Name of Jesus!

Blessed be his Most Sacred Heart!

Blessed be his Most Precious Blood!

Blessed be Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar!

Blessed be the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete!

Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most Holy!

The St. Joseph Chaplet

The St. Joseph Chaplet contains fifteen groups of four beads. Each group of four consists of one white bead and three blue beads. A Mystery of the Rosary is contemplated while each group of beads is prayed. These are the fifteen Mysteries:

- 1. The Annunciation of the Angel Gabriel to Mary / The Angel's Annunciation to St. Joseph in a dream.
- 2. The Visitation of Mary to St. Elizabeth
- 3. The Nativity
- 4. The Presentation in the Temple/
- 5. The Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple
- 6. The Agony in the Garden
- 7. The Scourging at the Pillar
- 8. The Crowning with Thorns
- 9. The Carrying of the Cross
- 10. Jesus' Death on the Cross
- 11. The Resurrection of Our Lord
- 12. The Ascension of Our Lord
- 13. The Descent of the Holy Ghost
- 14. The Assumption of the Mary
- 15. The Coronation of the Mary



Here is how to pray the St. Joseph Chaplet:

- Make the Sign of the Cross.
- Offer any intentions you may have.
- On the white bead, announce the Mystery, and say two Hail Marys.
- On each of the three blue beads, say: "Praised and blessed be Jesus, Mary, and Joseph!"

End the chaplet with the following prayer:

- V. Pray for us, O holy St. Joseph!
- R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ!
- V. Let us pray.

Our Lady of Lourdes Chaplet Prayers

The Our Lady of Lourdes chaplet is made with 9 beads, any color. It consists of 3 sets of 3 beads with a crucifix on one end and an Our Lady of Lourdes medal on the other end. This style chaplet is also known as a "novena chaplet".



On the Medal pray

O ever Immaculate Virgin, Mother of Mercy,
Health of the Sick, Refuge of Sinners,
Comfort to the Afflicted, You know my wants, my troubles,
my sufferings. Deign to cast upon me a look of Mercy.
By appearing in the Grotto of Lourdes, You were pleased to
make it a privileged sanctuary, whence You dispense your
graces; and already many sufferers have obtained the cure of
their infirmities, both spiritual and corporal.
I come, therefore, with the most unbounded confidence to
implore Your maternal intercession.
Obtain, O loving Mother, the granting of my requests.

Through gratitude for favors, I will endeavor to imitate your virtues that I may one day share Your glory.

Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us. Amen.

On the first bead of each set, Pray the Our Father

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

On the second bead of each set, Pray the Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with Thee. Blessed art Thou among women and blessed is the fruit of Thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

On the third bead of each set, Pray the Glory Be

Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be;
World without end. Amen

On the Crucifix Pray

Lord, look upon me with eyes of mercy,
May your healing hand rest upon me,
May your life-giving powers flow into every cell of my body
and into the depths of my soul,
Cleansing, purifying, restoring me to wholeness
and strength for service in your Kingdom. Amen.

CHAPLET OF SAINT THERESA (Little Flower Rosary)

How to pray the Chaplet of Saint Theresa

The Chaplet of Saint Theresa (the Little Flower Rosary) consists of 24 beads which commemorate the 24 years of her life, plus one additional bead.

On the first bead, the following prayer is said:

"Saint Therese of the Infant Jesus, Patroness of Missions, pray for us."

On the other 24 beads is said the <u>Glory Be To The Father</u> to honour the Holy Trinity in thanksgiving for having given us the Little Saint who lived in this world for only 24 years.

CHAPLET OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

How to pray the Chaplet of Our Lady of Guadalupe

The Chaplet of Guadalupe has a cross, 21 beads and a medal. Between the cross and the medal, there 1 bead, a set of 4 beads and then another bead. Elsewhere on the Chaplet, there are 4 sets of 3 beads, each separated by 1 bead (total of 3).

Begin with the following prayer:

"Our Lady of Guadalupe,
Mystical Rose,
make intercession for our Holy Church,
protect the sovereign Pontiff,
help all those who invoke you in their necessities,
and since you are the ever Virgin Mary
and Mother of the true God,
obtain for us from your most Holy Son
the grace of keeping our faith,
of sweet hope in the midst of the bitterness of life,
of burning charity,
and the precious gift of final perseverance."

Amen.

On the first bead, pray 1 "Our Father...".

Pray 4 "Hail Marys..." on the set of 4 beads in honour of Our Lady of Guadalupe's 4 apparitions to Blessed Juan Diego.

Pray 1 "Glory Be...".

Each set of 3 beads represents on apparition.

The First Apparition:

Our Lady of Guadalupe appears to Blessed Juan Diego. Our Lady requests a temple in her honour.

Pray 1 "Our Father..."

Prayer:

"Our Lady of Guadalupe,
my Queen and my Mother,
I thank you for your first apparition
to Blessed Juan Diego
when you revealed that you are the Most Pure Virgin,
Mary, Mother of the True God and Mother of all mankind.
I thank you for requesting a temple
to be built where you stood,
to bear witness to your love,
your compassion,
your aid and your protection
for all who would love you,
trust you, and invoke your help."

Pray 3 "Hail Marys..." followed by 1 "Glory Be...".

The Second Apparition:

Our Lady of Guadalupe gives Blessed Juan Diego encouragement after his return from the Bishop's house.

Pray 1 "Our Father..."

Prayer:

"Our Lady of Guadalupe,
my Queen and my Mother,
I thank you for your second apparition
to Blessed Juan Diego when,
upon his return from the Bishop's house,
he knelt in humiliation
and defeat before you
since he was unable to accomplish your mission.
I thank you for the courage
and encouragement you gave to Blessed Juan Diego
to make a second appeal to the Bishop."

Pray 3 "Hail Marys..." followed by 1 "Glory Be...".

The Third Apparition:

Our Lady of Guadalupe promises a sign to Blessed Juan Diego for the Bishop.

Pray 1 "Our Father..."

for all that you have undergone."

Prayer:

"Mother, I thank you for your third apparition to Blessed Juan Diego when, after this unsuccessful attempt to have a temple built, you said to him, 'So be it, son.

Return tomorrow in order that you may secure for the Bishop, the sign for which he has asked.

When this is in your possession, he will believe you; he will no longer doubt your world and suspect your good faith.

Be assured that I shall reward you

Pray 3 "Hail Marys..." followed by 1 "Glory Be...".

The Fourth Apparition:

Our Lady of Guadalupe fulfills her promise by showing herself on the tilma of Blessed Juan Diego.

Pray 1 "Our Father..."

Prayer:

Our Lady of Guadalupe, my Queen and my Mother, I thank you for your fourth apparition to Blessed Juan Diego when you ordered him to pick the roses he would find on the summit of the hill and bring them to you. I thank you for arranging them in his tilma when you said, 'This cluster of roses is the sign that you shall take to the Bishop. You are to tell him, in my name, that in this he will recognize my will and that he must fulfill it. You will be my ambassador, wholly worthy of my confidence. Only in the presence of the Bishop shall you unfold your mantle and disclose that which you carry.' I thank you for your image printed on the tilma which appeared when the roses were released.

Pray 3 "Hail Marys..." followed by

1 "Glory Be...".

Closing Prayer:

Remember, 0 most gracious Virgin of Guadalupe, that in thy celestial apparition on the Mount of Tepeyac, thou didst promise to show thy compassion and pity towards all who, loving and trusting thee, seek thy help and call upon thee in their necessities and afflictions; also to hearken to our supplications, to dry our tears and to give us consolation and relief.

Inspired with this confidence we come before thy august presence, certain that thou wilt deign to fulfill thy merciful promises. We are full of hope that, standing beneath thy protection nothing will trouble or afflict us. Thou has desired to remain with us through thy admirable image, thou who art our Mother, our health and our life.

O Mary, Mother of God, hear our petitions and in thy mercy answer us.

Amen

Optional Prayer to Our Lady of Guadalupe

Our Lady of Guadalupe, my mother, into your hands joined in prayer,

take my prayers, petitions and hopes, and present them to Jesus for me.

Remembering the love and care your hands rendered to Him, He will not refuse what they hold now, even though they are from me.

Amen.

CHAPLET OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

How to pray the Chaplet of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

This devotion is prayed on the popular 59 beads Marian Rosary.

Start by making the <u>"Sign of the Cross"</u> 5 times in veneration of the Saviour's 5 Holy Wounds.

On the large beads, say:

"Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, Pray for those who seek refuge in you."

On the small beads, say:

"Holy Mother, save us through your Immaculate Heart's flame of love."

You finish the Chaplet by praying 3 "Glory be".

THE CHAPLET OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS # 3

Use the regular 59 beads Marian Rosary for this Chaplet.

On the Crucifix, say the following prayer:

"O Jesus give us Thy Heart as a pledge of Thy love and as a place of refuge that we may find there a secure repose during our life and sweet comfort at the hour of our death."

Then, say the following prayers on the first 5 beads:

1 Our Father...

3 Hail Mary...

1 The Apostles' Creed...

On each of the remaining large beads, say:

"Thee I adore, praise and love O Sacred Heart of my dear Jesus penetrated with grief at the thought of so many offences which have been hitherto committed against Thee in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. I offer up to Thee in satisfaction there of the amiable Heart of Thy most beloved Mother with the merits of the saints.

Amen."

On each of the remaining small beads, say:

"O Sacred Heart of Jesus, burning with love of us, inflame our hearts with love of Thee."

CHAPLET IN PRAISE OF THE VIRGIN MARY (In Reparation for Blasphemy.)

How to pray the Chaplet in praise of the Virgin Mary

The Chaplet in praise of the Virgin Mary is prayed on the regular Marian Rosary of 59 beads.

At the beginning of the Rosary, the "Creed" and "Our Father" is replaced with:

"Mary, my Immaculate Mother, I desire to offer thee reparation for the offenses which thy Immaculate Heart receives from the horrible blasphemies which are uttered against thee. I offer thee these praises to console thee for so many ungrateful children who do not love thee, and to console the Heart of thy Divine Son Who is so deeply offended by the insults offered to thee. Receive, my Purest Mother, this little act of homage. Make me love thee more each day and look with pity on those blasphemers that they may not delay to cast themselves into thy maternal arms.

Amen."

On the large bead prior to each set of 10 beads, say:

"Grant that I may praise thee, O Holy Virgin!

Give me strength against thy enemies!"

On the 10 small beads is prayed once each of the 10 following praises:

- "1. Blessed be the Great Mother of God, Mary Most Holy!
- 2. Blessed be her Holy and Immaculate Conception!
- 3. Blessed be her Glorious Assumption!
- 4. Blessed be the Name of Mary, Virgin and Mother!
- 5. Blessed be her Immaculate Heart!
- 6. Blessed be her Virginal Purity!
- 7. Blessed be her Divine Maternity!
- 8. Blessed be her Universal Mediation!
- 9. Blessed be her Sorrows and her Tears!
- 10. Blessed be the graces with which the Lord crowned her Queen of Heaven and Earth!"

At the end of each set of 10 beads, say the following prayer:

"Glory be to Mary, Daughter of the Father! Glory be to Mary, Mother of the Son! Glory be to Mary, Spouse of the Holy Spirit!"

Concluding Prayer:

"My Mother,
I love thee for those who do not love thee;
I praise thee for those who blaspheme thee;
I surrender myself to thee
for those who will not recognize thee as their Mother."

(Repeat the above concluding prayer 5 times)

Chaplet for The Deceased (also called "Beads for the Dead")

is made with 45 beads. It has 5 introductory beads and 4 sets of 10 beads. The 4 sets of 10 symbolize the 40 hours that Our Lord is thought to have spent in Limbo.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

(On the crucifix)

De Profundis

- v: Out of the depths I call to you, Lord. O Lord, listen to my cry.

 Be attentive to the sound of my pleading.

 If you, Lord, note all our offences, who then, O Lord, could stand?

 But with you is forgiveness, for which we revere you.
- R: I wait for the Lord, my soul awaits; I hope in His word.

 My soul waits for the Lord, more than watchmen wait for dawn,
 more than watchmen awaiting the dawn. Israel, hope in the Lord,
 for with the Lord there is mercy and generous redemption.

 It is He who redeems Israel from all their sins.

(On the Our Father bead)

- v: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord
- R: And let perpetual light shine upon them.
- v: May they rest in peace.

(On the 3 Hail Mary beads)

Act of Faith

- v: O, my God, I firmly believe that you are one God in three divine Persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

 I believe that your Divine Son became man, died for our sins, and that He will come to judge the living and the dead.
- R: I believe these and all the truths which the Holy Catholic Church teaches, because You who have revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived.

Act of Hope

- v: O my God, relying on Your almighty power and infinite mercy and promises, I hope to obtain pardon of my sins, the help of Your grace, and life everlasting
- R: through the merits of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Redeemer.

Act of Charity

- v: O, my God, I love Thee, with my whole heart and soul, and above all things, because Thou art infinitely good and perfect, and most worthy of all my love; and for Thy sake, I love my neighbor as myself.
- R: Mercifully grant, O, my God, that having loved Thee on earth, I may love and enjoy Thee forever in heaven.

 Amen.

(On the Glory Be bead)

- v: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord
- R: And let perpetual light shine upon them.
- v: May they rest in peace.

(On the Hail Mary beads)

- v: Sweet heart of Mary, be my salvation.
- R: Sweet heart of Jesus, be my love.

(After each set of 10, on the Our Father bead)

- v: Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord
- R: And let perpetual light shine upon them.
- v: May they rest in peace.

Concluding Prayer:

- v: May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
- R: Amen.
- v: May the love of God and the peace of the Lord, Jesus Christ, bless us and console us, and gently wipe every tear from our eyes.
- R: Amen.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

November is traditionally an especially important month to pray for those in purgatory and many visit the graves of the departed on All Souls' Day, November 2. According to the liturgical calendar of 1962, when November 2 falls on a Sunday, All Souls' Day is transferred to Monday, November 3. On All Souls' Day the rosary or chaplet for the souls in purgatory is a practice earnestly recommended to all persons who desire to assist the Poor Souls. In anticipation of All Souls' Day, when night comes on this day, we darken the room, light a candle blessed at Candlemas, and pray the rosary for our dead.

Promises of St. Michael

Whoever would practice this devotion in his honor would have, when approaching the Holy Table, an escort of nine angels chosen from each of the Choirs. In addition, for the daily recital of these nine salutations, he promised his continual assistance and that of all the holy angels during life, and after death deliverance from Purgatory for themselves and all their relations.

How to pray the Chaplet of St. Michael

The chaplet begins with the invocation on the medal. Then say one Our Father and three Hail Marys after each of the following nine salutations in honor of the nine Choir of Angels:

- 1. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of Seraphim, may it please God to make us worthy to receive into our hearts the fire of his perfect charity. Amen.
- 2. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of Cherubim, may God in his good pleasure, grant us grace to abandon the ways of sin, and follow the path of Christian perfection. Amen.
- 3. By the intercession of St. Michael and the sacred Choir of Thrones, may it please God to infuse into our hearts the spirit of true and sincere humility. Amen.
- 4. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of the Dominations, may it please God to grant us grace to have dominion over our senses, and to correct our depraved passions. Amen.
- 5. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of the Powers, may God vouchsafe to keep our souls from the wiles and temptations of the devil. Amen.
- 6. By the intercession of St. Michael and the admirable heavenly Choir of the Virtues, may it please God to keep us from falling into temptation, and may He deliver us from evil. Amen.
- 7. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of Principalities, may it please God to fill our souls with the spirit of true and sincere obedience. Amen.
- 8. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of Archangels, may it please God to grant us the gift of perseverance in the faith, and in all good works, that we may be thereby enabled to attain the glory of paradise. Amen.
- 9. By the intercession of St. Michael and the heavenly Choir of all the Angels, may God vouchsafe to grant us their guardianship through this mortal life, and after death a happy entrance into the everlasting glory of heaven. Amen

Say an Our Fathers on each of the four large concluding beads:

The first one to St. Michael
The second one to St. Gabriel
The third one to St. Raphael
The fourth one to our Guardian Angel

End this Chaplet with the following Anthem and prayer.

Anthem

Michael, glorious prince, chief and champion of the heavenly Host, guardian of the souls of men, conqueror of the rebel angels, steward of the palace of God under Jesus Christ, our worthy leader, endowed with superhuman excellence and virtues: vouchsafe to free us all from every ill, who with full confidence have recourse to thee; and by thy incomparable protection enable us to make progress every day in the faithful service of our God. V. Pray for us, most blessed Michael, Prince of the Church of Jesus Christ. R. That we may be made worthy of his promises.

Prayer

Almighty and Eternal God, who is thine own marvelous goodness and pity didst, for the common salvation of man, choose the glorious Archangel Michael to be the prince of the Church: make us worthy, we pray Thee, to be delivered by his beneficent protection from all our enemies, that, at the hour of our death, none of them may approach to harm us; rather do Thou vouchsafe unto us that by the same Archangel Michael, we may be introduced into the presence of thy most high and divine majesty. Through the merits of the same Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
