Sharing Secrets

The Legion of Mary, Our Lady of Humility, shares from The Secret of the Rosary by Saint Louis Marie de Montfort. The saint writes of 50 "Roses" or secrets of the most Holy Rosary.

From the Sixteenth Rose: The Hail Mary-Beauty

We are reminded that there is nothing greater than God and He is pleased when we praise Him: in prayer, in song, in the Holy Mass. Our Blessed Mother sings His praises in the Magnificat when we read "my soul proclaims the Greatness of the Lord." Mary is the perfect model for us to sing God's praises and submit ourselves to His Holy will. In the Lord's prayer, we ask that God's Will be done in our lives every day. Our daily prayers are lifted to Him in praise, petition and thanksgiving. This is the beauty of prayer, and Mary's beautiful thanksgiving to God and all of His goodness.



Seventeenth Rose: The Hail Mary-Fruits

The Hail Mary prayer is described as an "Angelic Salutation" and a divine salutation, that is to be adored and recited reverently. It is a grace received by God, our Heavenly Father, to love and serve Our Lady through this salutation. The Hail Mary prayer helps us grow in virtues such as faith, hope and love of God. These are a few of the "fruits of the mysteries" that we reflect on when we pray the Glorious Mysteries of the Resurrection and Ascension of Our Lord Christ Jesus, and the Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples. We can imagine that the "garden of the soul is watered by this prayer" when we delve more deeply into the life of Christ and His Mother, strengthening our faith along the way.

This Month's Consecration Dates

Have you consecrated yourself to The Virgin Mary or to St. Joseph? Is it time to renew your consecration? The original program, True Devotion to Mary, was written by St. Louis Marie de Montfort in the 1700s, and is considered the greatest book on the Blessed Virgin Mary ever written. It has been recommended and practiced by eight Popes. The next, Totus Tuus, the papal motto of Pope St. John Paul II, means "Totally Yours" and is a collection of excerpts from scripture and this beloved Saint's encyclicals. Finally, 33 Days to Morning Glory by Fr. Michael Gaitley, is a summary of the teachings of St. Louis Marie de Montfort, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Teresa of Calcutta, and St. Pope John Paul II. Finally, Consecration to St. Joseph was written by Fr. Donald Calloway. (Contact us for links to 33 videos we produced.) **No matter which you choose to follow, your life will be greatly blessed.**

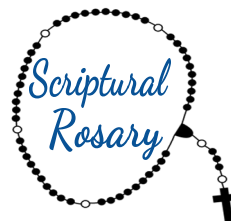

*** Immediately following 5:30 Traditional Latin Mass**

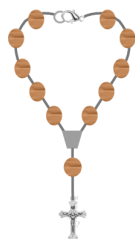
