Bylaw Changes

All Old West Chapter members: We will be voting on these proposed bylaw changes at our Oct. 12, 2023, meeting:

Change #1:

Article V, Sec. 2: The dues of each member shall be **forty** dollars plus the amount of the Grand Chapter Per Capita fees and special assessments plus \$10 Home Assessment per year, payable annually on January first in advance. Non payment of dues and/or assessments shall subject a member to penalties prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the Grand Chapter.

Proposed: The dues of each member shall be **fifty** dollars plus the amount of the Grand Chapter Per Capita fees and special assessments plus \$10 Home Assessment per year, payable annually on January first in advance. Non payment of dues and/or assessments shall subject a member to penalties prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the Grand Chapter.

Change #2:

Article III, Sec. 3a Currently reads: Issue all checks, which are to be signed by any two of the three following officers: Worthy Matron, Secretary or Treasurer.

Proposed: Act as custodian of the checkbook and issue all checks, which are to be signed by any two of the three following officers: Worthy Matron, Secretary or Treasurer.

Change #3:

Article III, Sec 3d Currently reads: Submit biannually a report of the monetary transactions of the Chapter. All Disbursements of Chapter funds shall be paid by check ordered by the Chapter.

Proposed: Submit **semiannually** a report of the monetary transactions of the Chapter. All Disbursements of Chapter funds shall be paid by check ordered by the Chapter. ★
