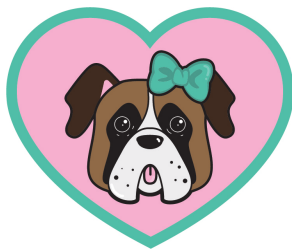
From the East ~

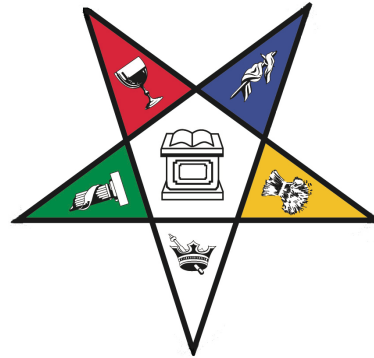
