- ii. Holiday Shop
  - 1. Holiday Shop had a profit of \$3600.62.
  - 2. PTO used Natalie's Elf Shop for this year's event.
  - 3. Over 30 volunteers showed up to help run the event and help kids to shop.
  - 4. One of the most successful parts of the event was volunteer incentives and the 50% discount offered to both staff and volunteers on the final day of the event.
  - 5. PTO was able to donate gifts for Angel Tree kids so that they could pick gifts for their families.

### iii. Ornament Paint Night

- 1. Holiday Paint Night had a profit of \$271.98.
- 2. 9 10 volunteers helped to run the event with an estimated attendance of 150 200 people.

- 4. PTO sold hot chocolate, juice, and water during the event and gave away one free snack with each drink purchase.
  - a. The snacks were leftover donations for Fall Booknic that were not used.

- iv. P.S. I Love You Day

- 1. P.S. I Love You Day took place in the morning on February 9th.
- 2. The Mission of P.S. I Love You Day is to bring awareness to the importance of mental health and decrease bullying.
- 3. PTO cut strips of purple paper and distributed them to class rooms a couple of weeks prior to this day. The kids were able to write a note to someone they love or a positive affirmation. Those strips were then turned into a chain and hung through the school, symbolizing that each student is loved and not alone.
- 4. PTO sold P.S. I Love You Day sweatshirts to staff and t-shirts to the entire Cadence community. A portion of all proceeds will be donated to the P.S. I Love You Day Foundation and the Children's Mobile Crisis Response Team.
