- **Budget**

- Total budget: \$500.
  - Items to purchase
    - Paw: \$185.
      - Amarilis will purchase the paw.
      - There will be a seven day production time.
    - Four pack fringe for \$19.99 each, totaling \$40.
      - Each pack is 9 ft.
    - Ice.
  - Items to potentially purchase:
    - Zip ties.
      - PTO currently has zip ties, but may need a bigger size.
    - Balloon arch.
      - TBD; dependent on weather.
    - PVC pipes.
      - PTO has a donation from Ace Hardware that may be utilized in order to make this purchase.

- Paw on the bed of the truck.
