



SPARKLING

FRANCE

- Voirin - Jumel NV - Champagne (100% Chardonnay) 25/100
Champagne, Blanc de Blancs, brut, well structured, rich, strong minerality, green apple, dry and crisp.
- Domaine Nicolas Brunet 2018 - Chenin Blanc 15/45
Loire Valley, Blanc de Blancs, brut, vouvray method, smooth, supple, creamy, toasted, ripe fruits, gingerbread, mineral finish.
- Gustavo Lorentz - Sparkling Rose (Pinot Noir) 17/57
Alsace, brut, nice medium body, creamy with a little bit of citrus. delicious.

ITALY

- Villa Loren – Prosecco (Glera) 9/27
Veneto, extra dry spumante with a velvety texture. Notes of acacia blossom, golden delicious apple and pear.

SPAIN

- Biutiful - Sparkling Rose (Granacha) 12/36
Cava, brut, fun and fruity, easy to drink, light body, stone fruit, touch of citrus

AUSTRIA

- Loimer - Sparkling Rose (Pinot Noir, St. Laurent) 19/60
Weinland, brut, some notes of strawberry, a bit yeasty, and some citrus to finish.

WHITES | ROSES

FRANCE

- Caves Jean Bourdy 2016 – Savagnin 90
Côtes du Jura Blanc AOC. Biodynamic, Demeter certified. Powerful aromatics and richness, nutty, minerals, yellow apples and pear.
- Chateau L'Ermitage 2019 - Roussanne, Grenache, Viognier 11/33
Cotes du Rhone, dry, light body, some minerals, tropical fruits, refreshing and unique
- Licence IV Blanc 2018 - Muscadet (1 Liter) 15/75
Loire Valley, super easy drinker, medium acidity with mineral finish.
- Domaine de Matignon 2019 - Chenin Blanc 11/33
Loire Valley, crisp green apple, high acid, jolly rancher, heavy viscosity upfront melts into a crisp finish.
- Champalou 2019 - Chenin Blanc 15/45
Vouvray, touch of sweetness, straw, low acid
- Chateau Beaubois 2018 – Rose (Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault) 12/36
Burgundy, light, crisp, yellow apple, acidity upfront, reasonably dry.

ITALY

- La Tunella 2017 - Pinot Grigio 14/42
Colli Orientali del Friuli, light body, dry, well balanced, soft on the palate, a little toasty on the back end.
- Villa Matilde 2018 - Falanghina 12/36
Campania, dry, soft and feminine with a touch of melon, some lemongrass, nice light body. Excellent for the patio
- Piero Brunet 2018 - Prie 67
Valle d'Aosta, beautifully balanced white with notes of green apple, honey, a bit earthy,

SOUTH AFRICA

- Lothian Vineyards 2016 – Riesling (limited release) 14/54
Elgin, award winning, very unique, petroleum, dry, clean, a little vanilla and notes of citrus. Not sweet

SPAIN

- Palacio de Bornos 2018 - Verdejo 9/27
Rueda, light bodied, dry, a touch of acidity, citrus and green apple.
- Agerre 2019 - Hondarrabi Zuri 12/36
Getariako Txakolina, light, refreshing, crisp, very citrusy, herbal and mineral... everything you want in a summer wine.

ARGENTINA

- Heritage Tvc 15 2018 - Chardonnay 12/36
Mendoza, dry and balanced, supple mouth feel, minerals.

REDS

FRANCE

- Domaine de Font - Sane 2017 – Grenache & Syrah 19/57
Côtes du Rhône AOC. Organic. earthy and jammy, soft lasting tannins, white pepper, fruit forward. finish with vanilla and licorice.
- Jean-Philippe Marchand 2018 – Pinot Noir 15/45
Burgundy, AOC. Lovely red fruit palate, silky and long finish. Moderate acidity, light body and refreshing. Notes of cherry with moderate richness reminiscent of ripe raspberries.
- Domaine de la Ronze 2018 - Gamay 13/45
Burgundy, AOC, unoaked and perfect for the summer time. fresh ripe strawberries, spices, light body, acidic and super drinkable.
- Domaine de Gayard 2018 – Braucol 12/36
Southwest France, Gailac, aged with new oak, intense aromas, red fruit with peppery spiced notes, upfront tannins melt into a smooth mouth finish.
- Chateau Fleur Haut Gaussens - Merlot, Cabernet 12/36
Bordeaux Superieur, ABSC, very dry, bold, medium to high tannins, acidic, black fruits, notes of tobacco and a little smoky
- Domaine Duseigneur 2019 - Grenache, Syrah 14/42
Côtes du Rhône, funky nose, gentle and fruit forward, well balanced, silky tannins and easy to drink
- Château Eugénie 2017 – Malbec & Merlot 15/45
Cahors, AOC. Bold, well-rounded plummy flavors, dark ruby red and crimson tints, black fruit, pepper and graphite. Powerful attack on the pallet and harmoniously restrained balance, fresh finish with fine tannins.
- Domaine de L'R 2018 - Cabernet Franc 19/57
Loire Valley, smooth and velvety, a slight tongue tingle, medium body, round mouth, red cherries, lots of depth, lingering finish.
- Château Fleur Haut Gaussens 2016 - Malbec 72
Bordeaux Supérieur, fragrant nose of blueberry and toasted oak, velvety tannins and dark fruits on the pallet with hints of chocolate and tobacco. Well balanced with medium plus acidity.
- Domaine du Cayron 2016 - Syraz, Mourvedre, Cinsault, Grenache 90
Gigondas, DGC, this wine is bad ass... drinkable yet bold and earthy with notes of red and dark fruit, medium body, medium tannins, complex red wine.
- Domaine du Père Coboche – 2019 Grenache blend 90
Châteauneuf-du-pape, Rhône-Valley, beautifully balanced wine with nice volume and dense tannins with notes of spices and licorice.
- Chateau Saint - Saturnin 1989 - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon 150
Bordeaux (Medoc) AOC, Cru Bourgeois award, aged in concrete barrels since 1989 and recently bottled, surprisingly light bodied, intense on the pallet, slightly dry finish.
- Chateau de Pibarnon Rouge 2017 - Mourvedre 144
Bandol, ABC, refined, earthy, oaky, licorice, black fruits, medium tannins, full bodied, leather. When you think of big bold red wine... this is it.

ITALY

- Cappo Zafferano 2019 – Primitivo 18/54
Primitivo di Manduria, DOC, rich and intense, dried red fruits, chocolate, tobacco, mild to medium tannin. Let airate for 5 min.
- La Mannella Rosso di Montalcino 2014 - Sangiovese 13/39
Toscana, DOC, medium body, well structured and dry, red fruits, notes of tobacco and vanilla, very earthy
- Peri Bigogno 2016 - Marzemino 14/42
Montenetto di Brescia, rare grape, very well balanced, bursting with flavor with a smooth finish.

SPAIN

- Guelbenzu Lautus 2019 - Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot 120
Ribera del Queiles, highly sought after wine, rich and intense, smoky cherry and dark berry aromas, roasted coffee, licorice and dried flowers. Supple texture with good depth.
- Pinea 2017 - Tempranillo 100
Ribera del Duero, rich and silky, beautifully balanced, smoky black fruits, notes of chocolate, vanilla and oak.
- Isaac Fernandez (Sensible) 2015 - Tempranillo 11/33
Castilla y León, smooth and dry, notes of bramble and black fruits. touches of oak and allspice. Low tannins.
- Legado del Moncayo 2018 - Grenacha 11/33
Campo de Borja, dry and bold with notes of red fruit and a touch of pepper. Well balanced and short finish.
- Guelbenzu Evo 2013 - Cabernet Sauvignon 15/54
Ribera del Queiles, award winning wine, bold, black fruits, dry, earthy, tannic, long oaky finish.
- Senorio de Sarria Reserva Especial 2014 - Cabernet Sauvignon 23/69
Navarra, award winning wine, aged for 2 years in American and French oak barrels, big, bold and well balanced, dark fruit, notes of chocolate and spice.

ARGENTINA

- Cicchitti 2016 - Malbec 13/39
Mendoza, bold, earthy and dry. Ripe red cherries, tobacco and notes of chocolate. Medium tannins and acidic.

SOUTH AFRICA

- Quando 2015 - Pinot Noir 13/39
Robertson, delightful and dry red, light body, fruit forward bouquet, a little woody on the finish.
