



## SPARKLING

### FRANCE

- Voirin - Jumel NV - Champagne (100% Chardonnay) 25/100  
Champagne, Blanc de Blancs, brut, well structured, rich, strong minerality, green apple, dry and crisp.
- Domaine du Petit Coteau - Chenin Blanc 15/45  
Loire Valley, Blanc de Blancs,ouvray method, great alternative to champagne, dry and delicate, yeasty, yellow apple, minerals and lingering mouth feel.
- Gustavo Lorentz - Sparkling Rose (Pinot Noir) 17/57  
Alsace, brut, nice medium body, creamy with a little bit of citrus. delicious.

### SPAIN

- Biutiful - Sparkling Rose (Granacha) 12/36  
Cava, brut, fun and fruity, easy to drink, light body, stone fruit, touch of citrus

### AUSTRIA

- Loimer - Sparkling Rose (Pinot Noir, St. Laurent) 19/60  
Weinland, brut, some notes of strawberry, a bit yeasty, and some citrus to finish.

## WHITES | ROSES

### FRANCE

- Caves Jean Bourdy 2016 – Savagnin 90  
Côte du Jura Blanc AOC. Biodynamic, Demeter certified. Powerful aromatics and richness, nutty, minerals, yellow apples and pear.
- Andre Dezat 2020 - Sauvignon Blanc (Sancerre) 18/59  
Loire Valley, nice acidity, green, flinty with mild minerality
- Domaine de la Croix Senaillet 2019 - Chardonnay 14/42  
Burgundy, fantastic crowd pleaser, stainless steel with malo (buttery) and balanced. Rich Summer white wine

### AUSTRIA

- Weszeli 2020 - Zweigelt (Cab Franc Rose) 12/36  
Niederosterreich, nice minerality, raspberry, melon and strawberry. High acid with some effervescence up front

### ITALY

- Tamellini 2020 - Garganega 11/33  
Veneto, floral nose, gentle on the palette, medium acid and clean finish
- La Tunella 2017 - Pinot Grigio 14/42  
Colli Orientali del Friuli, light body, dry, well balanced, soft on the palate, a little toasty on the back end.
- La Tunella 2016 - Friulano, Ribolla Gialla 60  
Colli Orientali del Friuli, round and medium bodied, aged in oak, fresh notes of fruit and white flower, vanilla, delicate and supple, a bit nutty at the finish.

### SOUTH AFRICA

- Lothian Vineyards 2016 – Riesling (limited release) 14/54  
Elgin, award winning, very unique, petroleum, dry, clean, a little vanilla and notes of citrus. Not sweet

### SPAIN

- Palacio de Bornos 2018 - Verdejo 9/27  
Rueda, light bodied, dry, a touch of acidity, citrus and green apple.
- Cortijo 2017 - Viura 9/27  
Rioja, dry, lemon zest, medium acid, touch of petrol on the finish, lingering mouth feel.

### HUNGARY

- Kovacs Nimrod 2016 - Chardonnay 17/54  
Eger, classic style of chardonnay with notes of apple, pear and minerality with light buttery and toasted oak notes

### ARGENTINA

- Heritage Tvc 15 2018 - Chardonnay 12/36  
Mendoza, dry and balanced, supple mouth feel, minerals.

### SOUTH AFRICA

- Lothian Vineyards 2016 - Riesling (limited Release) 14/54  
Elgin, award winning, very unique, petrol, dry, clean, a little vanilla and notes of citrus. Not sweet.

## REDS

### FRANCE

- Albert Bichot 2018 - Pinot Noir 15/45  
Burgundy, AOC. Lovely red fruit palate, silky and long finish. Moderate acidity, light body and refreshing. Notes of cherry with moderate richness reminiscent of black currant.
- Irancy 2018 - Pinot Noir 17/50  
Burgundy, cocoa leaf, eucalyptus, stone, tobacco, medium body... super fun and funky
- Chateau Gautouy 2010 - Malbec 12/36  
Cahors, well balanced, big and mature, black cherry, touch of oak, drying tannins, smooth finish, palatable and easy to drink.
- Mas des Caprices (R.A.S.) 2019 - Grenache, Carignan, Mourvedre 16/48  
Languedoc-Roussillon, perfect for the summer, aged in concrete vats, fresh and fruity, light body, brambly, floral and earthy spices with a bit of herbaceous notes.
- Château Eugénie 2017 – Malbec & Merlot (temp out) 15/45  
Cahors, AOC. Bold, well-rounded plummy flavors, dark ruby red and crimson tints, black fruit, pepper and graphite. Powerful attack on the pallet and harmoniously restrained balance, fresh finish with fine tannins.
- Famille Chasselay "Beaujolais is not Dead" 2020 - Gamay 19/57  
Beaujolais, 'carbonic and juicy AF with a non-serious undertone' red berry, pop of citrus, graphite, soft herb, well structured.
- Château Mauvesin Barton 2012 - Bordeaux Blend 17/54  
Bordeaux, Moulis-en-Medoc, great expression of a left bank Bordeaux, big and bold wine, high acid, with notes of vanilla, oak, dark fruits, leather, graphite and tobacco.
- Château Fleur Haut Gaussens 2016 - Malbec 72  
Bordeaux Supérieur, fragrant nose of blueberry and toasted oak, velvety tannins and dark fruits on the pallet with hints of chocolate and tobacco. Well balanced with medium plus acidity.
- Chateau Vieux Coutelin 2016 - Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot 84  
Bordeaux, Black and red fruits, vanilla, spicy and peppery, long and fleshy. A supple attack, grain, a pleasant fruity development of black fruits supported by salivating tannins.
- Domaine du Cayron 2016 - Syraz, Mourvedre, Cinsault, Grenache 90  
Gigondas, DGC, this wine is bad ass... drinkable yet bold and earthy with notes of red and dark fruit, medium body, medium tannins, complex red wine.
- Domaine du Père Coboche 2019 - Grenache blend 90  
Châteauneuf-du-pape, Rhône-Valley, beautifully balanced wine with nice volume and dense tannins with notes of spices and licorice.
- Domaine Paul Autard 2018 - Grenache, Syrah, Cunoise 90  
Châteauneuf-du-pape, a wow wine, fruit, soft tannins, medium body, perfect for the fall
- Chateau Saint Pierre De Mejans 2019 - Grenache, Syrah, Carignan 72  
Rhône, balanced, dry and velvety tannins, pepper finish with blue fruits.

### ITALY

- Averoldi 2016 - Gropello 12/36  
Lombardy, light bodied and leathery, easy to drink, a little funky and spicy
- Corte Dei Venti 2018-Sangiovese, Merlot, Cab Sauvignon 12/36  
Tuscan, ripe red fruits, cloves, dark chocolate, round on the palate and great finish.
- Cacina I Carpini 2011 - Barbera 19/57  
Piedmont, light and earthy, red and black fruits, gentle and feminine, easy to drink, needs time to open.

### SPAIN

- Martinez Corta 2016 - Tempranillo (1 Liter) 120  
Rioja, D.O.C. elegant and structured with layers of fruit and grippy tannins. Notes of licorice, toffee, cocoa and vanilla. Aged in French oak barrels for 15 months
- Pinea 2017 - Tempranillo (temp out) 100  
Ribera del Duero, rich and silky, beautifully balanced, smoky black fruits, notes of chocolate, vanilla and oak.
- Luz Millar Roble- Tempranillo 12/36  
Ribera del Duero, aged for 6 months in French and American oak barrels, you'll experience fresh red fruit and spices such as liquorice, cinnamon and vanilla.
- Guelbenzu Evo 2013 - Cabernet Sauvignon 15/54  
Ribera del Queiles, award winning wine, bold, black fruits, dry, earthy, tannic, long oaky finish.
- Senorio de Sarria Reserva Especial 2014 - Cabernet Sauvignon (temp out) 23/69  
Navarra, award winning wine, aged for 2 years in American and French oak barrels, big, bold and well balanced, dark fruit, notes of chocolate and spice.

### ARGENTINA

- Cicchitti 2016 - Malbec 13/39  
Mendoza, bold, earthy and dry. Ripe red cherries, tobacco and notes of chocolate. Medium tannins and acidic.

### SOUTH AFRICA

- Quando 2015 - Pinot Noir 13/39  
Robertson, delightful and dry red, light body, fruit forward bouquet, a little woody on the finish.

### CHILE

- Antiyal (Kuyen) 2018 - Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Carménère 19/57  
Maipo Valley, big body, blue fruits, jam, chocolate, earthy, mild tobacco, medium tannin
- Villard Grand Vin - L'Assemblage 2018 - Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon 16/51  
Casablanca Valley, 94 points, delicious and flavorful, medium to full bodied, aged in 100% French oak for 9.5 months, notes of dark fruits and forest floor.

### SLOVENIA

- Buba Mara 2017 - Pinot Noir, Syrah 13/40  
Stajerska, beautifully crafted Pinot with the structure of Syrah, aged in oak, light to medium body, delicious.

### UNITED STATES

- Domaine Eden 2017 - Cabernet Sauvignon 105  
Santa Cruz, new french oak, mountain style, green, smooth, dark fruits, toasted notes and a hint of vanilla.
