F R A N C E

- Stephane Coquillet - Pinot Noir, Chardonnay 150
Champagne, classic representation of champagne, clean on the palate, biscuit, minerals and green apple, clean finish.
- Gonet-Medeville - Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier 160
Champagne, fun and minerally, full body, fleshy and a little nutty.

W H I T E S

F R A N C E

- Caves Jean Bourdy 2016 – Savagnin 90
Côtes du Jura Blanc AOC. Biodynamic, Demeter certified. Powerful aromatics and richness, nutty, minerals, yellow apples and pear.
- Chante Cigale 2020 - Roussanne, Grenache Blanc, Bourboulenc, Clairette 88
Chateaunuf-du-Pape, light and funky, minerally, citrus undertones with a creamy finish.
- Domaine Bader-Mimeur 2019 - Chardonnay 168
Chassagne-Montrachet, buttery and complex, floral notes, sweet spices, medium bodied and round on the palate, delicious with or without food.

R E D S

F R A N C E

- Chateau Saint - Saturnin 1989 - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon 150
Bordeaux (Medoc) AOC, Cru Bourgeois award, aged in concrete barrels since 1989 and recently bottled, surprisingly light bodied, intense on the pallet, slightly dry finish.
- Chateau de Pibarnon Rouge 2017 - Mourvedre 144
Bandol, ABC, refined, earthy, oaky, licorice, black fruits, medium tannins, full bodied, leather. When you think of big bold red wine... this is it.
- Chateau La Tour Carnet 2018 - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot 130
Bordeaux, Haut-Medoc Grand Cru Classe, 91 points, left bank, this wine is a treat to have with red meat, big and bold with dense tannins, shows blue fruits, oaky, with notes of pepper and earth.
- Chateau Gruaard-Larose 2018 - Bordeaux Blend 230
Bordeaux, Grand Cru Classe, sophisticated yet approachable, silky and well rounded, tannic, classic Grand Cru Bordeaux style, left bank, perfumed nose, with notes of blackfruits, and tobacco.
- Domaine Jean Royer 2017 - Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault 100
Chateauneuf-du-Pape Cuvee Tradition, concrete tanks, licorice, black tea, herbaceous, light to medium body, good structure and ready to drink from the bottle.

I T A L Y

- Corte dei Venti 2016 - Sangiovese (Brunello) 160
Toscana, DOCC, 95 point, bold and full bodied, well balanced, notes of red fruit and leather, lasting tannins, smooth and very drinkable.
- Raina 2017 - Sagrantino 90
Umbria, dark fruits, medium body, some pepper, licorice, balanced and structured tannins that finish quick on the palette.

S P A I N

- Guelbenzu Lautus 2019 - Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot 120
Ribera del Queiles, highly sought after wine, rich and intense, smoky cherry and dark berry aromas, roasted coffee, licorice and dried flowers. Supple texture with good depth.
- Pinea 2017 - Tempranillo 100
Ribera del Duero, rich and silky, beautifully balanced, smoky black fruits, notes of chocolate, vanilla and oak.
- Martinez Corta 2016 - Tempranillo 120
Rioja, D.O.C. elegant and structured with layers of fruit and grippy tannins. Notes of licorice, toffee, cocoa and vanilla. Aged in French oak barrels for 15 months

U N I T E D S T A T E S

- A. Rafanelli Vineyard 2018 - Zinfadel 136
California, aged 18 months in French oak, fruit forward, gentle and well perfumed, bold, smooth and rich on the palette.
- Domaine Eden 2017 - Cabernet Sauvignon 105
Santa Cruz California, new french oak, mountain style, green, smooth, dark fruits, toasted notes and a hint of vanilla.
