### Falling into History and why we started "LIV" and why we still do HOW WE STARTED "LIGHTING UP"

UHRA's Holiday Light Up began in 1951 when a few Upper Hastings Ranch families decorated their driveways with luminaria – paper bags with candles inside – to help guide Santa to each home. The next year, the families on Coronet Avenue made the first parkway display - a giant candlestick with a real burning flame. It created a lot of smoke, and the Pasadena Fire Department didn't think it was such a great idea. The following year, the Coronet families built a painted wooden display with electric lights, and a friendly competition developed between the other blocks. We've continued our tradition for more than 70 years, with each year bringing new visitors and generations to the Ranch.
