Management Report

- Thank you to everyone who donated food to the food bank. In the month of February, we donated 41 pounds of food.
- Fountain Blue Pools performed an algae treatment to rid the pool of the algae reported on the steps and interior perimeter of the pool.
- 14 violations were sent out during the month of March.
- Fish and Wildlife Conservation was contacted regarding an alligator located in the Tropical Lake and we are awaiting the removal.
- We are currently obtaining bids for the stripping and waxing of the auditorium and kitchen.
- We are currently awaiting proposals for the electrical pedestals.
- Marzo Roofing recently conducted a Roof inspection as well as a wind mitigation and we are awaiting the results.
- We are awaiting our insurance agent to provide renewal information for the co-op commercial policies.
- As always, we are here to assist you in any way that we can and look forward to your continued partnership with Keystone Property Management.

Reminders as stated in the Co-Op Rules and Regulations:

XI. SELLING, SOLICITING AND SUBLETTING

- B. No signs are permitted on a unit except a mobile home for sale of a size no larger than 12 inches by 18 inches. Mobile home for sale signs of a professional quality, such as those used by realtors, may be placed on the lawn near the lamp post. These signs must be approved by management. Other types of mobile home for sale signs must be placed in the mobile home window or, if hurricane shutters are installed, outside the shutter.
- F. Homeowners may sell their home without the services of management. However, prior to offering the mobile home for sale, the homeowner shall inform management, in writing, that the mobile home is for sale and the price thereof. Sales of Cooperative Parcels by Members are governed by the provisions contained in Section XVII.

A. Utilities

2. Residents are responsible for all electrical work from the mobile home to the outdoor uniform lamppost. Residents are responsible for maintaining the photosensitive uniform post lamp and assuring that it is lit from 9:00pm to 7:00am.

Are you aware of the ST. Lucie County Sheriff's office Citizen's Academy? Below is a brief description of the course.

Citizens Academy

The St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office encourages citizen interest and involvement in the law enforcement process and daily activities of its deputies. To assist in educating citizens, the agency offers a Citizen's Academy. The Sheriff's Office has two academies a year, one in the spring and one in the fall. We are currently accepting applications.

Overview

The Citizen's Academy is a twelve-week overview of the entire law enforcement process from the patrol level of operations through the judicial and detention systems. Students will learn basic concepts to promote a better understanding of the functions of law enforcement.

Classes are held one night each week from the beginning to the end of the Academy with two classes held on Saturdays. It is important that each student attend all training; however, we know that scheduling can be difficult. Students will be allowed to miss 10% or four hours of training. Students missing more than four hours will not graduate.

Acceptance

Because class size is limited to twenty-five students, submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance in the class. Upon receipt of the application, it will be reviewed and processed for a background inquiry. Students selected for the Citizen's Academy will be notified by mail.



EXCERPTS FROM RULES REGARDING PETS

- A. Pets are allowed in the park based on the following criteria:
- The only allowed pets are small domestic animals such as dogs, cats and birds. Neither agricultural, wild animals nor exotic creatures such as iguanas, snakes, etc. are permitted at Tropical Isles Coop, Inc.
- 2. The maximum number of approved pets allowed at each home site is two. (2)
- 3. Pets shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pounds each, This included pets of registered guests.
- 4. Residents must control their pets, and no animal is allowed to run free.
- 5. A pet fee as per the then Schedule of Special Use Fees is paid.
- C. Pets must be housed in the mobile home at all times.
- F. Pets may be walked on roads and common areas throughout the park. In extremely hot temperatures, pets may be walked on the grass near the road to avoid burning their paws. *Areas other than the pet owners unit are not to be used for toileting the pet.*
- H. Pets are never allowed in the recreational and pool areas.
- N. All pets are to be governed by local (St. Lucie County) state and federal laws.
