I've heard from several people who told stories of how Margaret recruited them. She knew who to put in place to get things done. Ask anyone who was close to her. She was a remarkable women. A great example to several generations.


Know that anyone who gives their life to God will be attacked by the evil one. Margaret was no exception. She pushed through all the trials and tribulations with the public statement and meaning every word of it, "Nothing is forever, only God is."

Those words still ring in my ears.

At the funeral, I gave the eulogy. After all, we were sisters for 32 years, who knew her better. I told Fr. Peter Mary Rookey, OSM the celebrant that I could The Apostle of Compassion have talked for another hour about Margaret and have not repeated myself.

We think Margaret has already had her first healing miracle. One of our members from the bayou area called us to have his wife put on the prayerline. She was in severe pain. 15

minutes later, I received Margaret M. Trosclair a text message from him June 19, 1933 - March 14, 2019 saying that the pain stopped suddenly. I replied,

At the funeral, Fr. Buddy Noel said, "Margaret was so persistent, she is up there pulling on Jesus' robes." I said, "No Father, she's closer, she is sitting on His knee and whispering in His ear." Later, I told Fr. Buddy about the above miracle and he said, "I see what you mean."

Margaret's family came in for her funeral from all

statue, so she needed to get the best price she could.

The first day, she was brought to Ivo's shop. When he finished looking at all of her measurements, he presented her with his price. Of course, she thought it was expensive. She planed to go to another shop, on the first day, so she would have something to compare to. Margaret suddenly got sick and passed out. The daughter took her back to her home and she and her parents brought Margaret to the hospital. Her diagnoses was severe, strange and unknown. She was sent back to the house for rest. When Margaret recovered enough to decide what to do, she felt God was telling her, this is where I want the statue to be carved. So, she had the contracts drawn up, signed them, and returned to Medjugorje for the return trip. Her group was still there waiting for her.

We later found out, that over 100 years ago, Ortesi, Italy was Ortesi, Austria. After World War I, country boundaries changed. The same Austrian or German sounding sir name appeared on both documents. Marga-

A Phenomenal Story - Margaret's Masterpiece

Our Lady of Lourdes of Medjugorje The Replica Statue

he fact that Margaret hitchhiked to Ortesi, Italy to procure the beautiful statue that is now enshrined in the Visitation of Our Lady Church for all to see. (It is worth a trip to Westbank to see it.)

Margaret's idea, since so many pilgrims originated from the New Orleans area, there would be many others who could not make the trip. By having an exact replica statue of the one in St. James Church would give those people a little peace of Medjugorje.

To accomplish this, Margaret had the Franciscan pastor in Medjugorje agree to take the statue down, lay it on a large roll of paper to be traced for size and measurements. Since the statue was carved out of wood, it was not too heavy. She rolled up the paper, and with Polaroid pictures from every angle, set on her journey. The pastor asked at the Mass if there was anyone who had come by auto from Italy. If so, please meet with him in the sacristy after Mass. Margaret got a ride. There were 3 adults, parents with a grown daughter. They welcomed the chance to help Margaret. It just so happened that they lived near Ortesi, Italy. The daughter spoke English and agreed to go with Margaret to visit the statue carving shops. The entire town is dedicated to carving statues of wood.

Part 38 CHAPTER THREE THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL Reverence for truth - Contd.

148. Certainly, to understand properly the meaning of the central message of a text we need to relate it to the teaching of the entire Bible as handed on by the Church. This is an important principle of biblical interpretation which recognizes that the Holy Spirit has inspired not just a part of the Bible, but the Bible as a whole, and that in some areas people have grown in their understanding of God's will on the basis of their personal experience. It also prevents erroneous or partial interpretations which would contradict other teachings of the same Scriptures. But it does not mean that we can weaken the distinct and specific emphasis of a text which we are called to preach. One of the defects of a tedious and ineffectual preaching is precisely its inability to transmit the intrinsic power of the text which has been proclaimed. **Personalizing the word**

149. The preacher "ought first of all to develop a great personal familiarity with the word of God. Knowledge of its linguistic or exegetical aspects. though certainly necessary, is not enough. He needs to approach the word with a docile and prayerful heart so that it may deeply penetrate his thoughts and feelings and bring about a new outlook in him." It is good for us to renew our fervour each day and every Sunday as we prepare the homily, examining ourselves to see if we have grown in love for the word which we preach. Nor should we forget that "the greater or lesser degree of the holiness of the minister has a real effect on the proclamation of the word." As Saint Paul says, "we speak, not to please men, but to please God who tests our hearts" (1 Th 2:4). If we have a lively desire to be the first to hear the word which we must preach, this will surely be communicated to God's faithful people, for "out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks" (Mt 12:34). The Sunday readings will resonate in all their brilliance in the hearts of the faithful if they have first done so in the heart of their pastor.

150. Jesus was angered by those supposed teachers who demanded much of others, teaching God's word but without being enlightened by it: "They bind heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on the shoulders of others; but they themselves will not lift a finger to move them" (*Mt* 23:4). The apostle James exhorted: "Not many of you should become teachers, my brethren, for you know that we who teach shall be judged with greater strict-

ness" (Jas 3:1). Whoever wants to preach must be the first to let the word of God move him deeply and become incarnate in his daily life. In this way preaching will consist in that activity, so intense and fruitful, which is "communicating to others what one has contemplated." For all these reasons, before preparing what we will actually say when preaching, we need to let ourselves be penetrated by that word which will also penetrate others, for it is a living and active word, like a sword "which pierces to the division of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerns the thoughts and intentions of the heart" (Heb 4:12). This has great pastoral importance. Today too, people prefer to listen to witnesses: they "thirst for authenticity" and "call for evangelizers to speak of a God whom they themselves know and are familiar with, as if they were seeing him."

151. We are not asked to be flawless, but to keep growing and wanting to grow as we advance along the path of the Gospel; our arms must never grow slack. What is essential is that the preacher be certain that God loves him, that Jesus Christ has saved him and that his love always has the last word. Encountering such beauty, he will often feel that his life does not glorify God as it should, and he will sincerely desire to respond more fully to so great a love. Yet if he does not take time to hear God's word with an open heart, if he does not allow it to touch his life, to challenge him, to impel him, and if he does not devote time to pray with that word, then he will indeed be a false prophet, a fraud, a shallow impostor.



A Little Closer to Home

My mother, Valerie
Vercher, goes to pray
at Mary's Helpers. I know
with the type of woman
my mother is, she prays
for everyone else more
than she prays for herself.

That's just how she is.

My name is Georgette LaRose. I am 47 years old and I was blessed with my first child and son at the age of 40 with a boy, named Luke. He is a very loving child. He is funny and he has the greatest and biggest imagination any child can have. Here is my story and testimony. At the age of 3, I could tell that Luke was always on the go and would never stop. At first, everyone would tell me that he is a boy and supposed to be active. But I could see it was a different type of activity. He would never...never stop, always on the go. Then I noticed that he wouldn't speak, and being the type of mother I am, I brought this up to his pediatrician and had him evaluated numerous times. Autism was one of the things that stuck in my head, as he displayed some of the symptoms. We placed him in a school, and the school couldn't handle him. I was told that "he literally wore the teachers out." We were asked to put him some place else. I was very fortunate at the time to find a "godsend of a lady" to watch Luke and she continues to watch him during the holidays and summer. She also raised a son with similar characteristics as Luke, so she could relate to Luke and he related to her.

Three years ago, Luke finally got a diagnosis of being ADHD, Developmental Delayed and also Sensory Processing Disorder. So from a private school, he was placed in public school (in Special Ed), where he started receiving the help and understanding that private school couldn't provide for my son. Many days and nights, I would cry myself to sleep and then I would cry during the day wondering what did I do wrong. My mom would tell me to pray and pray. I was told numerous times that God knew what He was doing when He gave me a special child because God thought that I was special and I could handle it. There are times when it is hard, but I constantly pray and ask God, "Please don't change my son, just give me the strength to deal with him," and it has helped me tremendously.

One evening, I was picking Luke up from school and my mom handed me a brown paper bag and told me Mrs. Gayle said to put this oil on Luke at night, say a prayer, burn some incense and rub a piece of cloth on him. The oil, prayer, incense and a relic all connect to a Saint names St. Charbel. It has been close to three months that I have been doing this to my son every night. He is also on medication which was a very hard decision I had to make, but within those three months, my son has gone from red days (bad days) and is





me. She told me my family could pick it up and the next morning and start praying to Our Lady while I was in surgery. After hanging up with Margaret, Gayle called back and told me she would bring the picture straight over to me that night. I began praying to Our Lady that night and also the morning of my surgery, my family continued to pray before the image for the next few days. The day after my surgery, I was doing wonderful, I was even taken off of the epidural only a few days after surgery. One week later, my daughter that was spending the night with me was talking on the phone with my husband. Before hanging up she told him to pray for me. A few minutes after hanging up the phone, my doctor walked in and told me that the spots that were removed were not active cancer cells and were only scar tissue.
