Curtis is a real singer. He used to have a band. He sang 2 songs on the program. The

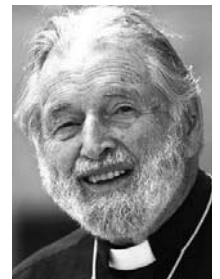
one he sang live, Yvonne came upstairs to hear him. She'd heard him sing many years ago, when his band played at an event she attended.

Im sure, by now, many of you have heard the good news, but I wanted to share it in a special way with you today too! On May 31, the feast of the Visitation, Our Lady gave us a wonderful gift! The Vatican press room issued a statement regarding Medjugorje which made us rejoice: Pope Francis has appointed a special Apostolic Visitor for the parish of Medjugorje. To our great joy, this appointee is Archbishop Henryk Hoser, who was appointed with a short term mission in Medjugorje in February 2017. At that time he was asked to acquire a deeper knowledge of the pastoral situation, and to assess the needs of the faithful in Medjugorje.

This mission proved to be very positive; Mgr. Hoser had stated that he was sent by the Pope to "comfort us." "In Medjugorje, there are many spiritual fruits," he said at the end of that mission.

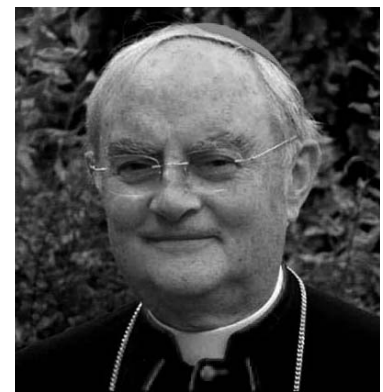

given to Mgr. Hoser, with the renewed hope that this Vatican statement has given us! And most importantly, let us continue to respond to the calls of the Queen of Peace, because it is by living her messages that Medjugorje will bear all the spiritual fruits that Heaven expects. "Make further progress" as said St. Paul to the *Thessalonians* (4.1).

Here is the official text that Fr. Marinko (the parish priest of Medjugorje) read to us that day after the evening Mass. Needless to say it was greeted with much excitement and was widely applauded by the large numbers of faithful who had gathered for the feast of the Visitation and that of the Blessed Sacrament (*Corpus Christi*):

"On this day, the 31st of May, 2018, the Holy See has appointed Henryk Hoser, SAC, the retired Archbishop of Warsaw-Prague (Poland) as Apostolic Visitor with a special role for the parish of Medjugorje for an indefinite time, and ad nutum Sanctae Sedis. At the specific request of the Holy See, his appointment is for pastoral

ministry, a continuation of the mission of the special envoy of the Holy See for the parish of Medjugorje, entrusted to Mgr. Hoser on February 11, 2017, and in which he completed in the previous months."

The purpose of the mission of the Apostolic Visitor is to provide a firm and permanent accompaniment of the parish community in Medjugorje and the faithful who come on pilgrimage here, whose needs require a special attention."

Dearest Mother, we thank you so much for the gift of Mgr. Henryk Hoser! Guide him and lead him in his work, and help him to provide the spiritual nourishment the parish community and pilgrims need. May this step forward from the Vatican draw even more people closer to your Son Jesus.

We are sooooo excited!!!!!!!

We've all heard negative statements from people who said that Pope Francis doesn't like Medjugorje. Why would anyone even say that?

The news of this letter came just weeks after we were discussing the outcome of the bishops first visit with a friend. Our statement was, "Our Lady will have to take care of it Herself, just as she did in Lourdes and Fatima!"

And guess what? She did! ▀

We heard that Hilda took care of the Blessed Mother statue in the garden at Metairie Manor for years. She saw to it that it was kept clean and freshly painted year round. She was also a member of the Legion of Mary.

Hilda was close to Mother Mary all of her life. She was one of 4 children; with 6 grandchildren & 8 great grandchildren.

At her funeral, one of her granddaughters sang, "I Will Always Love You." I guarantee, there wasn't a dry eye in the church.

Hilda was a living example to all of faith and love to her family. We know she will be greatly missed. We know that she is looking down on all of us.

We made frequent visits to Chicago to visit with Fr. Rookey and his friends, the Stauntons, where we lodged. Every First Monday of the month, the Stauntons would host a Rosary, Mass & Healing Service in their home. Fr. Rookey was usually the celebrant. When Fr. Rookey conducted a Healing Service, he fasted all day. When the Services were over, he sat down to a sumptuous meal, all by himself. At the Stauntons, he was seated at the breakfast table, in the back corner of the kitchen, he actually sat in the corner. He was right by the phone, which hung on the wall, with a long cord. This particular night, I was standing there when the phone rang. A woman's voice asked for Fr. Rookey, and to tell him that Dolores was calling. I leaned over to Father and gave him the message. He said he would take the call. I could not hear what he was saying, but when he hung up the phone, he said, "That was Dolores Hope. She is going to fly me out to California for her 100th birthday celebration.

This past month, July 17th, our guest priest at the Mass site in Houma was Fr. Joseph Doyle, SSJ, while Fr. Paul was out of town. It was a delight to see Fr. Doyle again. He had not changed, he still looks young and full of the Spirit. Fr. Doyle did mention the fact that the Remnant Church is everywhere, looking at the size of the attendance

monstrance as the beautiful colors begin, and then our Lord's awesome Glory comes pouring out upon those adoring our Lord. This was the first time this has happened outside of Holy Adoration. I am so thankful to our God for such a precious gift!

A Daily Eucharist Reflection – April 2018 - A Eucharistic Miracle -

On 14th September, 1226, the festival of the Holy Cross was being solemnly celebrated in Avignon, when the Rhone suddenly overflowed its banks and flooded the city to such an extent as to make people fear that the water would reach the altar on which the Most Holy Sacrament was exposed in the chapel of the Grey Penitents. When the first panic had subsided a few courageous men went to the church in a boat to save it. The water had certainly entered the church, but divided to the right and the left, leaving the passage to the altar, on which was still the Most Holy, surrounded by burning candles, quite dry. In an incredibly short time, knowledge of the miracle spread, and a number of boats were seen to move towards the church, among them that of King Louis VIII, who happened to be in Avignon. In memory of the prodigy, daily exposition of the Most Holy Sacrament which, after seven centuries, is still carried on, was established in this chapel,

Part 31 CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

A people for everyone Contd.

113. The salvation which God has wrought, and the Church joyfully proclaims, is for everyone. God has found a way to unite himself to every human being in every age. He has chosen to call them together as a people and not as isolated individuals. No one is saved by himself or herself, individually, or by his or her own efforts. God attracts us by taking into account the complex interweaving of personal relationships entailed in the life of a human community. This people which God has chosen and called is the Church. Jesus did not tell the apostles to form an exclusive and elite group. He said: "Go and make disciples of all nations" (Mt 28:19). Saint Paul tells us in the people of

Miracles Abound

The famous photo taken at the Monastery of St. Maron on May 8, 1950 that bore the image of St. Sharbel was shown to those who Sharbel had appeared to in special visions and

he was identified as the St. Sharbel who had appeared to them. After this verification of the picture the monks of his Lebanese-Marionite Order then offered the picture to the public as the real picture of St. Sharbel.

One of those who was blessed to see the holy monk was Naeem Ghawy who was appointed as a physician for the Monastery of Saint Maron in 1950. He reported the following story. The people were everywhere in and outside of the monastery. A thirteen year old Armenian boy came to the monastery carried by his father. He had been treated for a bone tuberculosis disease in an American Hospital and was in serious condition. The boy was carried to the tomb by his father and the next day I was informed the boy was experiencing serious chest pain. I tried to persuade the father to take him to a nursing room so he could be treated but the father refused saying, "It's better for my son to lose his life and not lose his place near the tomb." That same night at midnight four buses arrived at the monastery; the visitors entered the church

God, in the Church, "there is neither Jew or Greek... for you are all one in Christ Jesus" (Gal 3:28). To those who feel far from God and the Church, to all those who are fearful or indifferent, I would like to say this: the Lord, with great respect and love, is also calling you to be a part of his people!

114. Being Church means being God's people, in accordance with the great plan of his fatherly love. This means that we are to be God's leaven in the midst of humanity. It means proclaiming and bringing God's salvation into our world, which often goes astray and needs to be encouraged, given hope and strengthened on the way. The Church must be a place of mercy freely given, where everyone can feel welcomed, loved, forgiven and encouraged to live the good life of the Gospel.

A people of many faces

115. The People of God is incarnate in the peoples of the earth, each of which has its own culture. The concept of culture is valuable for grasping the various expressions of the Christian life present in God's people. It has to do with the lifestyle of a given society, the specific way in which its members relate to one another, to other creatures and to God. Understood in this way, culture embraces the totality of a people's life. Each people in the course of its history develops its culture with legitimate autonomy. This is due to the fact that the human person, "by nature stands completely in need of life in society and always exists in reference to society, finding there a concrete way of relating to reality. The human person is always situated in a culture:

singing hymns. One of the visitors tried to pass a prayer book to an old monk who had accompanied them into the church. When the visitor got closer to the monk, the monk disappeared! I was close to the church when I noticed the sudden quietness. I rushed toward the window thinking someone must have fainted. Before I reached the window, I saw a monk walking out of the church. I passed so close to him that our shoulders touched. When I learned from the visitors what had transpired I rushed outside to find out the identity of this monk. When I looked toward the hermitage, I saw the monk walking toward the east. I chased after him and pointed my flashlight at him. The moment I reached him and my hand touched his clothes, I stopped, perplexed, and was about to lose consciousness from fear. The monk suddenly disappeared. I looked around and then saw above the hermitage a strange brilliant light blurring my sight. While I was still in this state of fear, I heard coming from the side of St. Sharbel's tomb, cheers and applause. The young Armenian boy was completely healed.

A Shiite from Southern Lebanon shared the following story of his healing. I entered jail on November 9, 1948. I was healthy but I had a neurological disease. While I was in jail my worries increased because I had a family that depended on me. Five months ago, I felt pain in my body and weakness in my left eye. The fingers in my right hand became stiffened. I was treated by the doctors. After a long treatment, I lost all vision in my left eye. Then a month ago, I got joint inflammation.

I heard about Sharbel's miracles and I was making fun of them at first as if they were superstitions. I thought these miracles were propaganda to raise money. Finally, when I read in the newspapers about the numerous miracles and saw the photos

"nature and culture are intimately linked." Grace supposes culture, and God's gift becomes flesh in the culture of those who receive it.

116. In these first two Christian millennia, countless peoples have received the grace of faith, brought it to flower in their daily lives and handed it on in the language of their own culture. Whenever a community receives the message of salvation, the Holy Spirit enriches its culture with the transforming power of the Gospel. The history of the Church shows that Christianity does not have simply one cultural expression, but rather, "remaining completely true to itself, with unswerving fidelity to the proclamation of the Gospel and the tradition of the Church, it will also reflect the different faces of the cultures and peoples in which it is received and takes root." In the diversity of peoples who experience the gift of God, each in accordance with its own culture, the Church expresses her genuine catholicity and shows forth the "beauty of her varied face." In the Christian customs of an evangelized people, the Holy Spirit adorns the Church, showing her new aspects of revelation and giving her a new face. Through inculturation, the Church "introduces peoples, together with their cultures, into her own community," or "every culture offers positive values and forms which can enrich the way the Gospel is preached, understood and lived." In this way, the Church takes up the values of different cultures and becomes *sponsa ornata monilibus suis*, "the bride bedecked with her jewels" (cf. Is 61:10). *NEXT Month - Part 32*

of patients who had received healing through Sharbel's intercession, I believed in his holiness and vowed fifty Lebanese Liras. I asked the nurse, Avduca Saliba, to visit his tomb and here is the petition I wrote: I am a man who was imprisoned unjustly. I lost my vision and my health in prison. Therefore, I have recourse to God and Saint Sharbel. If he heals me from my sicknesses and I get out of jail, I would owe him five hundred Lebanese Liras. If I am guilty I don't want to get out of the jail and remain blind and lame. Here is my fifty Lebanese Liras with Avduca as down payment.

The nurse went to Annaya, along with a nun, the principal of the hospital, and Corporal Shafiq Beydoun, the chief officer. I felt optimistic about the visit. When they returned from the visit they gave me incense, blessed water, soil, and a piece of cotton from Sharbel's tomb. I soaked the cotton with the holy water and rubbed it on my eye and the swollen and painful parts of my body. After two hours, tears flowed down my eye after four months of dryness. The next morning I woke up early and realized I was completely cured. There was no trace of the inflammation or the pain. I also could move my stiffened fingers normally. My eye has begun to improve day by day. I am now reading large letters and my eye is on the way to full recovery.
