



been duped into thinking that secular history is important. History should be taught from a spiritual perspective. For example: Why did George Washington pray so often? Why did Abraham Lincoln say that the Civil War was chastisements for our sins?

Should we teach:

World War II for the United States, started with the bombing of Pearl Harbor, December 7, 1941, and ended with Japan on August 15, 1945.

Or

Should we teach:

Our Lady is the patron saint of the United States. In Fatima, She said that unless man turns away from sin, a larger and greater war will break out. The prophecy came true. It happened on the vigil of the Feast of the Immaculate Conception,

December 7, 1941, when Japan attacked Pearl Harbor. Congress declared war on Our Lady's Feast Day, December 8, 1941. The war ended, on the Vigil of the Feast of the Assumption in our part of the world. In Japan, where the decision was made, this was August 15, 1945, the feast day itself.

In every event, was God involved? Was not God involved? Our whole life is a spiritual matter and every action and heart will be judged where he will be for eternity. Learning history minus God has no value for eternity, rather only for the world.

In the preceding article, "...Reclaim our Lady's Land," God was involved and wanted by man to help and influence history. What happens when God is not involved, when man chooses purely to be secular, to minus God out of our life? This can also be taught from a spiritual perspective and when properly taught, we would benefit greatly from history as the following will show: This is from a period in history when man chose not to include God. Before 1963, "public" schools were similar to religious institutions. The Bible was taught. For example, many first grade school books taught the alphabet using Bible quotes which were started with the letters of the alphabet, A, B, C., etc. Throughout all of the schools textbooks, the teachings of Christ permeated the lessons if not 'built in' directly. Virtues were taught. It is so important to note in 1963 when we saw school prayer removed, out went the all other material which had any reference to Christianity. So in 1963 when the Supreme Court removed school prayer, it removed much more than a singular prayer before school began. Before that ruling, going back to our forefathers, many cases were tried, challenging Christianity in the school. Time and again

Margaret and I met Fr. Apostoli several years ago, when we attended our first Catholic Marketing Network Convention (CMN) in Chicago. Fr. Apostoli was their spiritual director for many years. It was love at first sight. Fr. Andrew also was a guest on our radio program. Many people share with me the loss of such a dynamic personality.

It was a privilege to have known him.

Mass started promptly at 6:00 p.m. Fr. Anthony's homily was mostly on the two saints, Peter & Paul, as the readings was of the Vigil of the Feast. But he included the fact that Our Lady was praying very hard for them to succeed in the ministry of starting the Church of her Son, Jesus.

Following Mass, before the Healing Service began, an announcement was made instructing the people to remain in their pew until the usher called them. Standing in the aisle was not permitted and the children would be the first to come up, then those in wheelchairs, etc., than row by row. That is how Fr. Rookey's healing services were, orderly, except the wheelchairs came before the children. This brought back so many memories to me. I felt like I was stepping back in time.

Fr. Anthony exposed the Blessed Sacrament with the beginning of Benediction. (Fr. Rookey always exposed the Blessed Sacrament for his healing services.)

Then Fr. Anthony turned to the congregation (packed church) and asked, portraying Jesus, "Do you love Me?" Three times. The voices got

108. As I mentioned above, I have not sought to offer a complete diagnosis, but I invite communities to complete and enrich these perspectives on the basis of their awareness of the challenges facing them and their neighbours. It is my hope that, in doing so, they will realize that whenever we attempt to read the signs of the times it is helpful to listen to young people and the elderly. 

The Cause for Beatification

Fr. Sharbel's cause for beatification was introduced with two other members of his order, Fr. Nimatullah Kassab al-Hardini, Fr. Sharbel's spiritual Father & Sister Rafqa Ar-Rayes. The Superior General of the order went to Rome in 1925 to petition His Holiness Pope Pius XI to begin the proceedings on behalf of all three.

A Commission was established and it was decided that the body of Fr. Sharbel needed to be moved to a new site to prevent it from being venerated before an official decision was made by Rome. On July 24, 1927, his body was exhumed in the presence of a large crowd. He was wearing his priestly garments, his head was covered with the hood. A speech was delivered on his life, death, and the other previous burials. The cause for his beatifications being presented to Rome was also noted. The report was signed and sealed with the Commission's stamp and placed in a metal container along with a medical document describing the condition of the body at that time. The body was placed in a new wooden coffin which was then enclosed in a second coffin made of zinc. Two large stones were placed beneath the coffin in the new tomb located in the wall of the crypt. The tomb was then carefully cemented closed.

The faithful continued to come to pray for

experience, which warns us not to foolishly repeat our past mistakes. Young people call us to renewed and expansive hope, for they represent new directions for humanity and open us up to the future, lest we cling to a nostalgia for structures and customs which are no longer life-giving in today's world.

109. Challenges exist to be overcome! Let us be realists, but without losing our joy, our boldness and our hope-filled commitment. Let us not allow ourselves to be robbed of missionary vigour!

CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

110. After having considered some of the challenges of the present, I would now like to speak of the task which bears upon us in every age and place, for "there can be no true evangelization without the explicit proclamation of Jesus as Lord," and without "the primacy of the proclamation of Jesus Christ in all evangelizing work." Acknowledging the concerns of the Asian bishops, John Paul II told them that if the Church "is to fulfil its providential destiny, evangelization as the joyful, patient and progressive preaching of the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ must be your absolute priority." These words hold true for all of us.

1. The entire people of God proclaims the Gospel

111. Evangelization is the task of the Church. The Church, as the agent of evangelization, is more than an organic and hierarchical institution; she is first and foremost a people advancing on its pilgrim way help and protection through the intercession of Fr. Sharbel. In 1950, a Holy Year, it was noticed that the wall of the oratory was damp. The Superior, Fr. Pierre Youness, was notified and it was confirmed that it was not water, but the viscous fluid that had flowed from the body of Fr. Sharbel. Fearing that the coffin and the body had decomposed, Fr. Youness, ordered the tomb reopened.

On February 25, 1950, the tomb was opened under the direction of the Superior. The bloody liquid had penetrated the wooden and the zinc coffins and was dripping down the exterior oratory wall. The body was intact! The Superior wiped the face and hands of Fr. Sharbel with a white cloth; his facial image and an imprint of his hands was left on the cloth. The tomb was then closed.

On April 22, 1950 the tomb was again officially opened after a ministerial inquiry was called. Three expert doctors in their fields were called in for consultation. Present at this time were the Vicar General for the Maronite Patriarch in the district of Jbeil(Byblos), and the Superior General of the Order, as well as all the monks of Annaya. The following was recorded: "The bloody body fluid observed in 1899 and in 1927 persisted. It covers the entire cadaver and has drenched his clothing. One part of the chasuble is mildewed, the bottom of the zinc coffin has fallen through at one end, (the area beneath the feet), the tube containing the documents of 1927 has rusted away, the documents themselves are still intact." The doctors placed the naked body of Fr. Sharbel upon a sheet during their examination. The features of Fr. Sharbel's body were found imprinted on the sheet after the body had been removed. The examination over, his body was freshly dressed, a new chasuble was placed upon him, and he was then put back in his coffin

towards God. She is certainly a mystery rooted in the Trinity, yet she exists concretely in history as a people of pilgrims and evangelizers, transcending any institutional expression, however necessary. I would like to dwell briefly on this way of understanding the Church, whose ultimate foundation is in the free and gracious initiative of God.

A people for everyone

112. The salvation which God offers us is the work of his mercy. No human efforts, however good they may be, can enable us to merit so great a gift. God, by his sheer grace, draws us to himself and makes us one with him. He sends his Spirit into our hearts to make us his children, transforming us and enabling us to respond to his love by our lives. The Church is sent by Jesus Christ as the sacrament of the salvation offered by God. Through her evangelizing activity, she cooperates as an instrument of that divine grace which works unceasingly and inscrutably. Benedict XVI put it nicely at the beginning of the Synod's reflections: "It is important always to know that the first word, the true initiative, the true activity comes from God and only by inserting ourselves into the divine initiative, only begging for this divine initiative, shall we too be able to become – with him and in him – evangelizers." This principle of the primacy of grace must be a beacon which constantly illuminates our reflections on evangelization.

which was then sealed with red wax. The tomb was blocked with stones and cement.

Annaya was hit with a human tidal wave. Crowds of infirm arrived, the blind, the deaf, the mute, and the paralytic. Astounding recoveries were reported and the pilgrims would cry out with joy with each one. Crowds in increasing numbers came to the monastery from every part of the world.

On May 8, 1950, the anniversary of Fr. Sharbel's birth, a bus load of forty professed brothers, novices, scholars and servants arrived at Annaya. In the group of forty was Brother Elias Nohra. Brother Elias ascended to the hermitage of Saints Peter and Paul where Fr. Sharbel had spent the last years of his life. It was here that Brother Elias wanted to take a picture with some brothers who were with him. Also present for the photo was a young man visiting the shrine, Youssef Tannous. On May 9th the film was developed and there before the young man Youssef Tannous was the image of Fr. Sharbel! The body of Fr. Sharbel was transparent and dressed in the Lebanese monastic habit. Youssef Tannous stated that while he was visiting the hermitage of Saint Sharbel on May 8, 1950 he was approached by some visitors to the hermitage who invited him to be in a photo. When he posed for the picture a monk suddenly appeared before him saying, "I want to take a picture with you and sit in front of you." He reported that Brother Nohra Elias took the photo and the monk disappeared.. When the photo was developed the same monk that spoke with him had appeared in the developed photo. Those who knew Fr. Sharbel identified him in the picture. This is the only photo ever taken of St. Sharbel.

 it was upheld that this was a Christian nation. One case before the Supreme Court was:

**Church of the Holy Trinity vs.
 United States 1892**

It ruled: Our laws and our institutions must necessarily be based upon and embody the teachings of the Redeemer of mankind. It is impossible that it should be otherwise and in this sense and to the extent, our civilization and our institutions are emphatically Christian.

To arrive at the 1892 decision, they Went all the way back through cases to the forefathers and cited eighty-seven separate precedents to base its ruling upon.

Another case: People vs. Ruggles 1811
 The court said: Whatever strikes at the root of Christianity tends manifestly to the dissolution of civil government.

The case dealt with a man who wanted Christianity out of schools, and who accused Jesus and blasphemed Him. The court said it was blasphemy. If you attack Jesus Christ, you are attacking Christianity. If you attack Christianity,

you have attacked the foundation of the United States. He was sentenced to three months in jail and was fined \$500.00 for his attack on the United States through blaspheming Jesus.

All cases before 1963 had many precedents to prove from the country's founding that Christianity was the fabric of our country. But in 1963, satan entered the courts for the first time and changed almost two hundred years of tradition regarding school prayer. The court's decision was unprecedented. It was unbelievable. It could not happen, yet it did, and a brand new direction began with no past cases cited to arrive at its decision.

In 1963 when Kennedy was shot, the world, for the first time, watched it on TV. Then the alleged assassin, Oswald, was shot and was also seen on live TV. It seems it is the year that the devil came out. It is history showing, from a spiritual perspective, what happens when man turns away from God.


