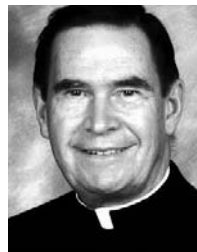
From The Desk of Margaret Trosclair *by Gayle Ponseti*

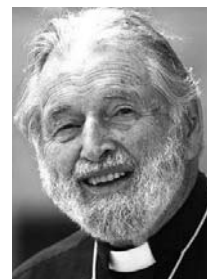

Part 29 CHAPTER TWO
AMID THE CRISIS OF COMMUNAL
COMMITMENT

Other ecclesial challenges - Contd.

104. Demands that the legitimate rights of women be respected, based on the firm conviction that men and women are equal in dignity, present the Church with profound and challenging questions which cannot be lightly evaded. The reservation of the priesthood to males, as a sign of Christ the Spouse who gives himself in the Eucharist, is not a question open to discussion, but it can prove especially divisive if sacramental power is too closely identified with power in general. It must be remembered that when we speak of sacramental power "we are in the realm of function, not that of dignity or holiness." The ministerial priesthood is one means employed by Jesus for the service of his people, yet our great dignity derives from baptism, which is accessible to all. The configuration of the priest to Christ the head

— namely, as the principal source of grace — does not imply an exaltation which would set him above others. In the Church, functions "do not favour the superiority of some vis-à-vis the others." Indeed, a woman, Mary, is more important than the bishops. Even when the function of ministerial priesthood is considered "hierarchical," it must be remembered that "it is totally ordered to the holiness of Christ's members." Its key and axis is not power understood as domination, but the power to administer the sacrament of the Eucharist; this is the origin of its authority, which is always a service to God's people. This presents a great challenge for pastors and theologians, who are in a position to recognize more fully what this entails with regard to the possible role of women in decision-making in different areas of the Church's life.

105. Youth ministry, as traditionally organized, has also suffered the impact of social changes. Young people often fail to find responses to their concerns, needs, problems and hurts in the usual structures. As adults, we find it hard to listen patiently to them, to appreciate their concerns and demands, and to speak to them in a language they can understand. For the same reason, our efforts in the field of education do not produce the results expected. The rise and growth of associations and movements mostly made up of young people can be seen as the work of the Holy Spirit, who blazes new trails to meet their expectations and their search for a deep spirituality and a more real sense of belonging. There remains a need, however, to ensure that these associations actively participate in the Church's overall pastoral efforts.

106. Even if it is not always easy to approach young people, progress has been made in two areas: the awareness that the entire community is

called to evangelize and educate the young, and the urgent need for the young to exercise greater leadership. We should recognize that despite the present crisis of commitment and communal relationships, many young people are making common cause before the problems of our world and are taking up various forms of activism and volunteer work. Some take part in the life of the Church as members of service groups and various missionary initiatives in their own dioceses and in other places. How beautiful it is to see that young people are "street preachers" (*callejeros de la fe*), joyfully bringing Jesus to every street, every town square and every corner of the earth!

107. Many places are experiencing a dearth of vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. This is often due to a lack of contagious apostolic fervour in communities which results in a cooling of enthusiasm and attractiveness. Wherever there is life, fervour and a desire to bring Christ to others, genuine vocations will arise. Even in parishes where priests are not particularly committed or joyful, the fraternal life and fervour of the community can awaken in the young a desire to consecrate themselves completely to God and to the preaching of the Gospel. This is particularly true if such a living community prays insistently for vocations and courageously proposes to its young people the path of special consecration. On the other hand, despite the scarcity of vocations, today we are increasingly aware of the need for a better process of selecting candidates to the priesthood. Seminaries cannot accept candidates on the basis of any motivation whatsoever, especially if those motivations have to do with affective insecurity or the pursuit of power, human glory or economic well-being.

St. Sharbel Makhlof

May 8, 1828 - December 24, 1898

Saint of Miracles

Back as promised - Part 7



The Saint's
Tomb is Opened

Fr. Sharbel's body had been placed in a common grave for the monks according to the rule of his order. With the continuous requests of the faithful and the reporting of a mysterious light that was

being seen around the grave since the burial, the Superior allowed the grave to be opened. One of the men, Saba Bou-Moussej, who asked to be the first to enter the tomb, had been suffering for two years with severe pain in his back and had come to ask Fr. Sharbel's intercession for a cure. Saba had tried all types of treatment, but to no avail. He had been with Fr. Sharbel at his death, but did not ask for his intercession at that time. When he entered the tomb, he and the other witnesses that entered, found the body of Fr. Sharbel to be exactly as they had placed it on the day of his burial. The clothes of Fr. Sharbel were dry but the body was covered in mold. Saba wiped his hand over Fr. Sharbel's back and chest. Saba reported that all the muscles of Fr. Sharbel were soft and flexible. He also pointed out to the

Superior that there was no mold on the thumb and finger of Fr. Sharbel's hand. Saba rubbed his back with the mold that had stuck to his hand from the body asking the saint for his miraculous intercession. The Superior then asked everyone to come out of the grave and for it to be closed.

After the visit to the tomb, Saba accompanied the monks to a funeral that required two hours of walking. Upon his return he realized that Fr. Sharbel answered his petition as he experienced no fatigue from the journey and there was no longer any pain.

The Superior, realizing the sanctity of Fr. Sharbel, sought and received permission from both the Father General of the Order and the Patriarch to transfer the body to a more honorable burial site.

On April 15, 1899, less than four months after the burial of Fr. Sharbel, the grave was opened for a second time. Witnesses went into the original vault and laid out the body on some boards to transfer it to a new resting place. The witnesses all testified that rainwater had penetrated the roof and the walls of the crypt. The body of Fr. Sharbel lay in mud water which was dripping onto his uncovered face and was covered in mold. When the mold was cleaned from the body, the remains were intact, the body still flexible and supple like those of a living person. The skin still retained a healthy glow and no hair on his head or beard had fallen out.

The features of Fr. Sharbel appeared as one sleeping. There was also noted a mixture of blood and water that oozed from his body. The underclothing

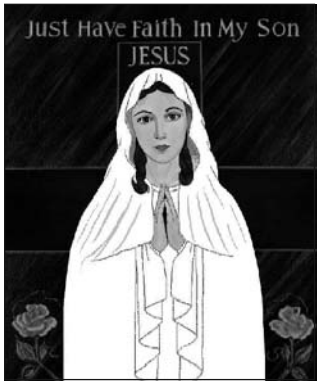
of Fr. Sharbel was changed and the body was dressed in a new vestment before being placed in an uncovered coffin and carried to a substitute storeroom that served as a repository for old relics and even for charcoal. This storeroom was in a high corner of one of the church walls. The only available access was up a stone staircase which was built inside the walls. This seemed to be the best place to hide the body of St. Sharbel from the pious who may attempt to take pieces of his corpse as relics.

Saba Ouwaini, one of the men who helped remove the original garments of Fr. Sharbel, wiped the mold from the body with a cotton quilt from the monastery and kept the quilt in his home as a precious treasure. He shared many pieces of the quilt with those who requested it as a blessing. He reported that it first smelled of mold, but later a pleasant smell emanated from it. Unfortunately, a month later someone stole it from his home. The body of Fr. Sharbel continued to give off this bloody sweat. It defied decomposition and maintained the characteristics of someone sleeping. The monks at prayer began to notice a peculiar odor and this would give away the secret resting place of the saintly priest. Additionally, the liquid that had been oozing from the body had now reached the stone staircase and would be visible to everyone.

The body was removed from the storeroom and placed in a cell on the north side of the monastery.

My Mom, who lives in North Carolina, has been very sick and I was very upset about it. She had a stroke, was losing all feeling in both of her legs and was unable to even get out of bed. I was really concerned because I couldn't go to see about her, since I have been very sick myself. I was still weak and falling asleep in the car coming home from the

doctor's office.

I had been familiar with Mary's Helpers from when my husband was sick and having gone to Fr. Rookey's Healing Mass. As I said earlier, I have been pretty sick and I just thought I'd pick up the phone and call. I had to have a cat-scan and x-rays and ultra sounds and all this. When I phoned to put myself on Mary's Helpers prayerline, Margaret answered. The next day I was going in to meet a specialist. Margaret asked me to stop by Mary's Helpers before I went to the hospital at L.S.U. Medical Center, she said she had a scapular and prayer she wanted me to have. I told her I didn't know if I would have the strength but, through her urging I did manage to find the strength. So I stopped by Mary's Helpers before my appointment and we prayed. She gave me the picture of Mary with the words "Just Have Faith in My Son Jesus" from Louis Saia. She had just gotten them in. I was the first person to receive one. She told me to take it home. This was in December 2001, I picked up the picture on Thursday the 20th and nations cannot be rewarded or punished in the next world, they must be in this. By an inevitable chain of causes and effects, Providence punishes national sins by national calamities."

Near Birmingham, Alabama, Marija, the vision- ary from Medjugorje, spent over two and one half months. Our Lady appeared to her every day. Our Lady did many beautiful things. One particular apparition is of great significance because Our Lady chose a day and said she would appear outside and she wished the public to come. The day was November 24, 1988, Thanksgiving day, the one day that we as a nation give thanks to God. It is our exclusive religious holiday. Many are trying to change it, calling it Turkey Day, but we, in commu- nity believe that where these apparitions took place holds a great significance for our whole country. We believe Our Lady desires to lead a reawakening, to go back to what we were founded upon. A few years later, Our Lady gave a message confirming our discernment. She said on August 25, 1994: "...I Pray and intercede before my Son, Jesus, so the dream that your fathers had may be fulfilled..."

It is time for a radical change in our lives and in our country's direction. We must abandon them and their miserable path as they have abandoned

That night, it was carried up to the terrace and laid out so it would be exposed to the air. It was thought that this might dry up the bloody sweat which was seeping from the back and side of the corpse. The bloody sweat was so abundant that the body was wrapped in two fresh sheets each day for four months with no sign of change.

It was decided to remove the vital organs from the body to see if this would stem the flow of the bloody liquid. When the stomach was opened the intestines were found to be like that of a living man. This procedure proved fruitless in stopping the flow of the liquid from the saintly priest's body.

Dr. Nagib el-Khoury thought he had found a way for stopping this bloody sweat and was determined to submit the body of Fr. Sharbel to a severe test. The remains were placed in a closet in an upright position. The feet were sunk into quicklime, a certain method to stop the secretions and decompose the limbs. This experiment proved fruitless as the condition of the body remained unchanged. The doctor however was changed! Dr. Nagib was a nonpracticing Christian and declared, "I

hereby swear that this body is being preserved by a power that cannot be explained by scientific means. There can be no doubt that the saintliness of Fr. Sharbel has much to do with it."

Dr. Elias el-Onaissy declared, "I examined the body of God's servant, Fr. Sharbel, at the monastery of Annaya. I was aware of an odor that similar to that of a living body emanating from the corpse. When I inspected it more closely, I noticed a sweat-like substance issuing from its pores, a strange and inexplicable thing according to any law of nature, considering the length of time this body has lain inanimate. I have periodically carried out this identical examination with the same results."

Dr. George Shucrallah one of the most celebrated doctors in Lebanon at the time, conducted at least thirty studies on the body over seventeen years. He was astonished at the preservation of the body and was particularly interested in the reddish fluid that exuded from the body. He calculated that the body secreted far more liquid than the total weight of the

body! He questioned, "How can less give more?"
