Yes, we had another miracle. It concerned our priest, Fr. Paul Bergeron. A couple of years back, he was battling cancer.

We talked him into coming out to the Mass site in Houma to be prayed on by all of us on the spot where Our Lady stood during her visit with Louis Saia. It was the middle of winter, February, to

be exact, and it was colder than you could imagine. He came, and after that the treatments he was taking for his condition began to work, as they had not done before.

A couple of months later, we invited Fr. Paul to come with us on a pilgrimage to the Shrines in Louisiana. He agreed that this kind of trip would not be too hard for him, so he came.

Our first stop was to the Grave Site of Charlene Richard. While there, we all got out to pray the Rosary at her grave. We all headed to the Church of St. Edward, which is just next to the graveyard. Besides paying a visit to the church, Charlene's brother was going to meet us there and give a talk about Charlene. I happened to notice that Fr. Paul was letting everyone go in the church ahead of him. He stopped a small statue of Our Lady Lourdes that was up on a pedestal outside the front door of the church. He told us later, that he stop to ask Our Lady's help in curing

him of his cancer.

From there, we headed to Prairie Ronde, to the Ave Maria Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. If you have not been there, it is an exact replica of the little chapel shrine in Fatima, Portugal. For this visit there, the visionary from Venezuela, Juan Antonio Gil was present. When he is present, Our Lady appears to him with a message for everyone. The people who maintain the Shrine did not know that a priest was with us. But, Our Lady did, and asked Juan Antonio to bring the priest forward.

After Juan received the message, which was translated into English for us, he said that something very unusual happened. He said that when Our Lady appears to him, she is always dressed in the robes of Our Lady of Fatima. But today, she came to him as Our Lady of Lourdes, with the long blue sash tied at her waist. When he said that, we knew that was because of Fr. Paul's prayer to her in Richard, Louisiana. It was as plain as the nose on our faces. Our Lady made sure that Fr. Heaven is for real and our Heavenly Mother Mary and her Beloved Son Jesus are right next to us. We could touch them if we could see them.

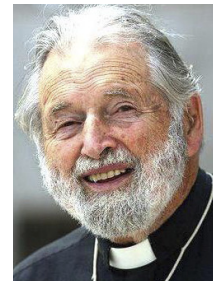
In Mary's messages, she continually asks us to pray, pray, pray. There is a very good reason for her telling us that. Listen to her.

### **A Daily Eucharist Reflection – July 8, 2018**

What reasons have Catholics for believing that Our Saviour gave the Apostles His real body and blood? ... His words, both on the occasion of the promise and at the Last Supper, if taken literally, denote a true, and not a merely symbolic presence of Himself in the Holy Eucharist. He could not have expressed this more clearly or more forcibly than He did: "He that eateth My flesh and drinketh My blood hath everlasting life... For My flesh is meat (food) indeed, and My blood is drink indeed... This is My body... This is My blood."... Those who deny the doctrine of the Real Presence do indeed adduce numerous arguments, but an honest examination of these arguments will show that they all have one common basis—the difficulty of understanding how Our Lord's real body and blood can be simultane-

ously present in thousands of places in a manner imperceptible to human senses. Now, this is only a repetition of the argument brought up by those who listened to Christ Himself at Capharnaum: "How can this man give us His flesh to eat?... This saying is hard, and who can hear it?" The weakness of this argument is that it measures divine power by human standards. He who has assured us that the Holy Eucharist contains His body and blood is the all-powerful, all-truthful God. Shall we twist His assertions to suit our ideas just because our puny intellects cannot understand how the miracle of the Real Presence takes place? Should we not rather exclaim with St. Peter: "Thou hast the words of eternal life," and humbly acknowledge as divine truth the sublime doctrine which the Son of God has made known to us with His own lips?

**Part 42 CHAPTER THREE**  
**THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL**

**An ear to the people**

**Kerygmatic and mystagogical catechesis**

**163.** Education and catechesis are at the service of this growth. We already possess a number of magisterial documents and aids on catechesis issued by the Holy See and by various episcopates. I think in particular of the Apostolic Exhortation *Catechesi Tradendae* (1979), the *General Catechetical Directory* (1997) and other documents whose contents need not be repeated here. I would like to offer a few brief considerations which I believe to be of particular significance.

**164.** In catechesis too, we have rediscovered the fundamental role of the first announcement or kerygma, which needs to be the centre of all evangelizing activity and all efforts at Church renewal. The kerygma is trinitarian. The fire of the Spirit is given in the form of tongues and leads us to believe in Jesus Christ who, by his death and resurrection, reveals and communicates to us the Father's infinite mercy. On the lips of the catechist the first proclamation must ring out over and over: "Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you." This first proclamation is called "first" not because it exists at the beginning and can then be forgotten or replaced by other more important things. It is first in a qualitative sense because

it is the principal proclamation, the one which we must hear again and again in different ways, the one which we must announce one way or another throughout the process of catechesis, at every level and moment. For this reason too, "the priest – like every other member of the Church – ought to grow in awareness that he himself is continually in need of being evangelized."

**165.** We must not think that in catechesis the kerygma gives way to a supposedly more "solid" formation. Nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful and wisdom-filled than that initial proclamation. All Christian formation consists of entering more deeply into the kerygma, which is reflected in and constantly illumines, the work of catechesis, thereby enabling us to understand more fully the significance of every subject which the latter treats. It is the message capable of responding to the desire for the infinite which abides in every human heart. The centrality of the kerygma calls for stressing those elements which are most needed today: it has to express God's saving love which precedes any moral and religious obligation on our part; it should not impose the truth but appeal to freedom; it should be marked by joy, encouragement, liveliness and a harmonious balance which will not reduce preaching to a few doctrines which are at times more philosophical than evangelical. All this demands on the part of the evangelizer certain attitudes which foster openness to the message: approachability, readiness for dialogue, patience, a warmth and welcome which is non-judgmental.

**166.** Another aspect of catechesis which has developed in recent decades is *mystagogic* initiation. This basically has to do with two things: a progressive experience of formation involving the entire community and a renewed appreciation of the liturgical signs of Christian initiation. Many manuals and programmes have not yet taken sufficiently into account the need for a mystagogical renewal, one which would assume very different forms based on each educational community's discernment. Catechesis is a proclamation of the word and is always centred on that word, yet it also demands a suitable environment and an attractive presentation, the use of eloquent symbols, insertion into a broader growth process and the integration of

every dimension of the person within a communal journey of hearing and response.

**167.** Every form of catechesis would do well to attend to the "way of beauty" (*via pulchritudinis*). Proclaiming Christ means showing that to believe in and to follow him is not only something right and true, but also something beautiful, capable of filling life with new splendour and profound joy, even in the midst of difficulties. Every expression of true beauty can thus be acknowledged as a path leading to an encounter with the Lord Jesus. This has nothing to do with fostering an aesthetic relativism which would downplay the inseparable bond between truth, goodness and beauty, but rather a renewed esteem for beauty as a means of touching the human heart and enabling the truth and goodness of the Risen Christ to radiate within it.

If, as St. Augustine says, we love only that which is beautiful, the incarnate Son, as the revelation of infinite beauty, is supremely lovable and draws us to himself with bonds of love. So a formation in the *via pulchritudinis* ought to be part of our effort to pass on the faith. Each particular Church should encourage the use of the arts in evangelization, building on the treasures of the past but also drawing upon the wide variety of contemporary expressions so as to transmit the faith in a new "language of parables." We must be bold enough to discover new signs and new symbols, new flesh to embody and communicate the word, and different forms of beauty which are valued in different cultural settings, including those unconventional modes of beauty which may mean little to the evangelizers, yet prove particularly attractive for others.

**168.** As for the moral component of catechesis, which promotes growth in fidelity to the Gospel way of life, it is helpful to stress again and again the attractiveness and the ideal of a life of wisdom, self-fulfilment and enrichment. In the light of that positive message, our rejection of the evils which endanger that life can be better understood. Rather than experts in dire predictions, our judges bent on rooting out every threat and deviation, we should appear as joyful messengers of challenging proposals, guardians of the goodness and beauty which shine forth in a life of fidelity to the Gospel.

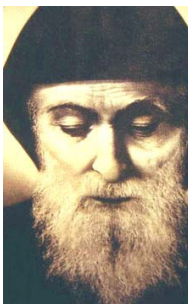
**St. Sharbel Makhlof**

**Recent Documented Miracle**

The testimony in the following miracle involves a "visit" from St. Sharbel

**M**r. Salib Doub, a resident of Ohio, was born in Egypt in 1950. After being diagnosed with fourth degree lung cancer the cancer

spread into his thoracic cavity. The treatment of chemotherapy and radiation was begun, but severe pain ensued. Nothing seemed to improve his condition; the doctors estimated that his time was short and therefore advised his family to fulfill all the father's requests.

Mr. Doub's daughter asked one of her friend's

to obtain oil from the tomb of St. Sharbel for her father. On June 29, 2019, after receiving oil and soil from the tomb, Mr. Doub's wife anointed him with the oil and dissolved the soil in a glass of water for him to drink. On the same day, Mr. Doub was healed! St. Sharbel had answered their prayers through a miracle of healing!

The medical reports were sent to the monastery where the miracle was recorded on July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

**Second Miracle**

Joe Michael Abi Hatem, an agricultural engineer born in Lebanon in 1995 began experiencing headaches that became more severe each day. An injury to his finger caused bleeding that could not be stopped. He was taken to the emergency room where he was examined by Dr. Salma Sfeir. Tests were taken that showed Joe Michael had cancer of the blood. He started chemotherapy and underwent surgery. St. Sharbel appeared to Joe in a dream and stayed beside him in silence. The

Lord also appeared in the dream and placed his hand on Joe's waist. On the second day, December 22, 2018, Joe's immune system recovered! On December 30, 2018 Joe was discharged from the hospital.

After several reviews of the laboratory tests, the doctors told Joe and his family, "Congratulations! Joe Michael is healed!"

St. Sharbel appeared to Joe's mother in a dream and said to her sweetly, "Be quiet, be quiet." She asked him for a sign to understand if Joe Michael was healed. St. Sharbel then gave her a sign by closing and opening his eyes three times.

The family went to Annaya in July of 2019 to thank St. Sharbel and brought the medical records to register the miracle.

After I got Harold settled in the emergency room, I went to put his cloths in the car. That's when I discovered Mother Mary's picture was still in my trunk. This time it was wrapped as a gift. I brought it in and tore the Christmas paper off. I stood it up on a big flat top sheet pail. The male nurse told me I couldn't keep it there because the pail is used a lot. I found another place where she would be looking down directly to the front of Harold instead of the back. He and I prayed like we never prayed before.

Then the x-rays began. I hadn't phoned any family yet, I was waiting 'til I had some information. When I said, "No one," she said, "Margaret, you have to tell Lori, she'll be more upset if you don't." I asked Gayle to call my son-in-law first, then let everyone else know. After I hung up the phone, I went back to where Harold was. He was in

so much pain, I decided to phone Lori myself, but Gayle had already done that, so I called Jane, Harold's sister. She waited until the next day to see him, since she had been helping all the other sick relatives. Harold was treated with anti-biotics to stop any infection, then more x-rays, anti-biotics and pain medication.

Harold's good friend and fishing buddy, Val, was a blessing to me. He came to relieve me so I could go home to rest. I had not had any sleep for 48 hours.

Thanks to Mary's Helpers, the Servite prayerline for all the prayers and through Our Lady of Compassionate Protection, Harold was released from the hospital, Friday, January 24th, our 49th wedding anniversary, without having to have surgery.

In January 1998, when I had my yearly mammogram it was discovered that an irregular lump was found in my left breast. On March 16, 1998 I had a biopsy done and the results came back as cancer. I returned to surgery on march 25 and they did a

partial mastectomy with a lymphectomy. From May to July I had 35 treatments of radiation. After regular check up I was clear of the cancer. I continued to have yearly mammograms. In December 2002 another lump was discovered a quarter of an inch from the previous one. The doctor recommended that it be taken out immediately. The surgery was scheduled for June 14th. On December 17th, we came to the Mass here at Saia's and Louis said a Rosary for cancer patients. It really touched me that night. Also Benediction was for those there with cancer and I went up to receive the blessing.

My husband and I said the Rosary in front of the Blessed Mother's picture at home. He would ask that they wouldn't find the lump to be cancer and for a sign.

The surgery was performed on the 14th of January and we came to the Mass on the 17th. Louis said the Rosary again for cancer patients.

Well, I went for the results of the biopsy and it wasn't cancer, just fatty tissue.

If you remember, it was very cold on the 17th and the next few days. The Sunday when returning

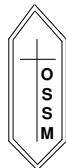
