[Those were the days we made all those pilgrimages to Convers, Georgia. And, we were heading for the Trappist Monastery first. I had a clip board for everyone to sign and put their seat number on. She wouldn't sign it. I later found out, that her mother told her, "You're going on a trip with Catholics, don't sign anything." True story.

All of a sudden, it came out from nowhere, I said, "Okay, you go up and sit in the front seat. You can read the meditations that we have printed in a folder. And this she did.



Sharbel she lost all hope in medicine and that he was the only one who could help her by his intercession before the Lord for her healing.

On her return to Aleppo, she continued to pray and ask his intercession. In addition, she applied the saint's holy oil to her body and drank for three consecutive days some of the holy oil.

Later, she was admitted to the hospital for severe painful diarrhea. It was decided that all the tests should be run again including a colonoscopy.

The night before the colonoscopy, October 22, she saw St. Sharbel in her dream digging and withdrawing his hands in her belly for three consecutive times. She had excruciating pain each time he dug his hands in her belly. When she awoke in the morning she did not tell anyone about the dream. When the doctor performed the colonoscopy he was surprised that there was no sign of colitis. He told her to thank God for the cure. She then told him about the dream of St. Sharbel the night before the procedure.

On April 2, 2019, Janet Zabita visited St. Sharbel in Anaya to thank him for the grace of healing and brought with her the medical records to register the miracle.

After I got Harold settled in the emergency room, I went to put his cloths in the car. That's when I discovered Mother Mary's picture was still in my trunk. This time it was wrapped as a gift. I brought it in and tore the Christmas paper off. I stood it up on a big flat top sheet pail. The male nurse told me I couldn't keep it there because the pail is used a lot. I found another place where she would be looking down directly to the front of Harold instead of the back. He and I prayed like we never prayed before.

Then the x-rays began. I hadn't phoned any family yet, I was waiting 'til I had some infor-mation. My daughter is expecting her second child next month, so many in the family are ill, I did not want to excite or worry anybody. We'd arrived at about 6:30 p.m., by 7:30 p.m. I decided to call Gayle to tell her what happened. Gayle asked if anyone was with me. When I said, "No one," she said, "Margaret, you have to tell Lori, she'll be more upset if you don't." I asked Gayle to call my son-in-law first, then let everyone else know. After I hung up the phone, I went back to where Harold was. He was in so much pain, I decided to phone Lori myself, but Gayle had already done that, so I called Jane, Harold's sister. She waited until the next day to see him, since she had been helping all the other sick relatives. Harold was treated with anti-biotics to stop any infection, then more x-rays, anti-biotics and pain medication.

Harold's good friend and fishing buddy, Val, was a blessing to me. He came to relieve me so I could go home to rest. I had not had any sleep for 48 hours.

Thanks to Mary's Helpers, the Servite prayerline for all the prayers and through Our Lady of Compassionate Protection, Harold was released from the hospital, Friday, January 24th, our 49th wedding anniversary, without having to have surgery.

In January 1998, when I had my yearly mammogram it was discovered that an irregular lump was found in my left breast. On March 16, 1998 I had a biopsy done and the results came back as cancer. I returned to surgery on march 25 and they did a partial mastectomy with a lymphectomy. From May to July I had 35 treatments of radiation. After regular check up I was clear of the cancer. I continued to have yearly mammograms. In December 2002 another lump was discovered a quarter of an inch from the previous one. The doctor recommended that it be taken out immediately. The surgery was scheduled for June 14th. On December 17th, we came to the Mass here at Saia's and Louis said a Rosary for cancer patients. It really touched me that night. Also Benediction was for those there with cancer and I went up to receive the blessing.

My husband and I said the Rosary in front of the Blessed Mother's picture at home. He would ask that they wouldn't find the lump to be cancer and for a sign.

The surgery was performed on the 14th of January and we came to the Mass on the 17th. Louis said the Rosary again for cancer patients.


