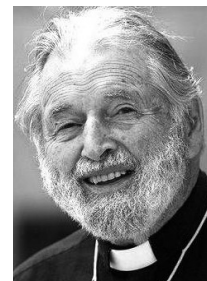
The reason we are behind schedule is because of

leave anyone standing there waiting and miss them. Once we settled down, I went down the line to assign a decade of the Rosary to all those sitting in the seats. When I got to her, she said, "I don't know how to pray the Rosary, I'm not Catholic." I thought to myself, "Lady, you are on the wrong bus. [Those were the days we made all those pilgrimages to Conyers, Georgia. And, we were heading for the Trappist Monastery first. I had a clip board for everyone to sign and put their seat number on. She wouldn't sign it. I later found out, that her mother told her, "You're going on a trip with Catholics, don't sign anything." True story.

The Holy Spirit jumped in to save the day.

All of a sudden, it came out from nowhere, I said, "Okay, you go up and sit in the front seat. You can read the meditations that we have printed in a folder. And this she did.

She found out that the Rosary beads for a prayer counter, the Rosary mysteries were about the life of Christ, and Catholics were asking for Mary's intercession. We asked her to pray for us. We didn't pray to her.

She and I, along with a gentleman from Metairie, were walking together, as we were leaving the Priory church, when we were called over to a private altar by one of the monks. He wanted to share a blessing with us, which we could share with the other members of our bus group. All three of us did that when we got back on the bus and headed to our motel.

We noticed that the monk was bent in two. Several of the monks were also in that condition. When we asked about it, we were told that they all hurt there backs, when they built the monastery. The monks actually built their own monastery.

CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

An ear to the people

Kerygma and mystagogical catechesis

163. Education and catechesis are at the service of this growth. We already possess a number of magisterial documents and aids on catechesis issued by the Holy See and by various episcopates. I think in particular of the Apostolic Exhortation *Catechesi Tradendae* (1979), the General Catechetical Directory (1997) and other documents whose contents need not be repeated here. I would like to offer a few brief considerations which I believe to be of particular significance.

164. In catechesis too, we have rediscovered the fundamental role of the first announcement or kerygma, which needs to be the centre of all evangelizing activity and all efforts at Church renewal. The kerygma is trinitarian. The fire of the Spirit is given in the form of tongues and leads us to believe in Jesus Christ who, by his



death and resurrection, reveals and communicates to us the Father's infinite mercy. On the lips of the catechist the first proclamation must ring out over and over: "Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you." This first proclamation is called "first" not because it exists at the beginning and can then be forgotten or replaced by other more important things. It is first in a qualitative sense because it is the principal proclamation, the one which we must hear again and again in different ways, the one which we must announce one way or another throughout the process of catechesis, at every level and moment. For this reason too, "the priest—like every other member of the Church—ought to grow in awareness that he himself is continually in need of being evangelized."

165. We must not think that in catechesis the kerygma gives way to a supposedly more "solid" formation. Nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful and wisdom-filled than that initial proclamation. All Christian formation consists of entering more deeply into the kerygma, which is reflected in and constantly illumines, the work of catechesis, thereby enabling us to understand more fully the significance of every subject which the latter treats. It is the message capable of responding to the desire for the infinite which abides in every human heart. The centrality of the kerygma calls for stressing those elements which are most needed today: it has to express God's saving love which precedes any moral and religious obligation on our part; it should not impose the truth but appeal to freedom; it should be marked by joy, encouragement, liveliness and a harmonious balance which will not reduce preaching to a few doctrines which are

at times more philosophical than evangelical. All this demands on the part of the evangelizer certain attitudes which foster openness to the message: approachability, readiness for dialogue, patience, a warm and welcome which is non-judgmental. 166. Another aspect of catechesis which has developed in recent decades is mystagogical initiation. This basically has to do with two things: a progressive experience of formation involving the entire community and a renewed appreciation of the liturgical signs of Christian initiation. Many manuals and programmes have not yet taken sufficiently into account the need for a mystagogical renewal, one which would assume very different forms based on each educational community's discernment. Catechesis is a proclamation of the word and is always centred on that word, yet it also demands a suitable environment and an attractive presentation, the use of eloquent symbols, insertion into a broader growth process and the integration of every dimension of the person within a communal journey of hearing and response.

167. Every form of catechesis would do well to attend to the "way of beauty" (via pulchritudinis). Proclaiming Christ means showing that to believe in and to follow him is not only something right and true, but also something beautiful, capable of filling life with new splendour and profound joy, even in the midst of difficulties. Every expression of true beauty can thus be acknowledged as a path leading to an encounter with the Lord Jesus. This has nothing to do with fostering an aesthetic relativism which would downplay the inseparable bond between truth, goodness and beauty, but rather a renewed esteem for beauty as a means of touching the human heart and enabling the truth and goodness of the Risen Christ to radiate within it.

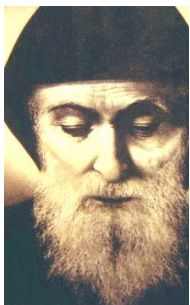

Mrs. Zabita returned to Aleppo to seek a second opinion. Tests were run and the diagnosis was the same. Not satisfied with the two identical opinions, she traveled to Saudi Arabia for a third opinion. Again, the same diagnosis, incurable colitis.

Having heard about St. Sharbel, Mrs. Zabita visited Anaya, Lebanon to pray and ask St. Sharbel's intercession. She told St.

Sharbel she lost all hope in medicine and that he was the only one who could help her by his intercession before the Lord for her healing.

On her return to Aleppo, she continued to pray and ask his intercession. In addition, she applied the saint's holy oil to her body and drank for three consecutive days some of the holy oil.

Later, she was admitted to the hospital for severe painful diarrhea. It was decided that all the tests should be run again including a colonoscopy.

The night before the colonoscopy, October 22, she saw St. Sharbel in her dream digging and withdrawing his hands in her belly for three consecutive times. She had excruciating pain each time he dug his hands in her belly. When she awoke in the morning she did not tell anyone about the dream. When the doctor performed the colonoscopy he was surprised that there was no sign of colitis. He told her to thank God for the cure. She then told him about the dream of St. Sharbel the night before the procedure.

On April 2, 2019, Janet Zabita visited St. Sharbel in Anaya to thank him for the grace of healing and brought with her the medical records to register the miracle.

Because we asked for volunteers to join a Rosary Rally for 30 days. To pray one

Rosary each day for Fr. Charbel's successful surgery and recovery. He feels that these prayers and all those Rosaries are what got him through. Fr. Charbel had previously had both hips replaced. He certainly is no stranger to serious surgery.

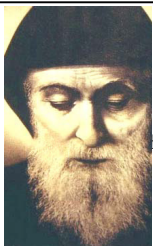

We helped stir up a lot of activity for him.

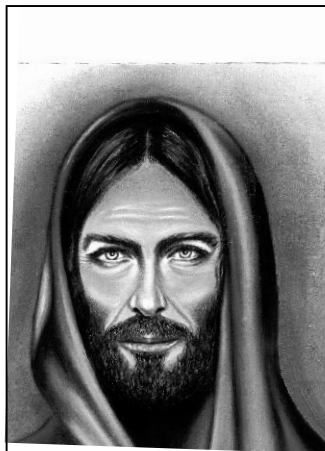

After I got Harold settled in the emergency room, I went to put his cloths in the car. That's when I discovered Mother Mary's picture was still in my trunk. This time it was wrapped as a gift. I brought it in and tore the Christmas paper off. I stood it up on a big flat top sheet pail. The male nurse told me I couldn't keep it there because the pail is used a lot. I found another place where she would be looking down directly to the front of Harold instead of the back. He and I prayed like we never prayed before.

Then the x-rays began. I hadn't phoned any family yet, I was waiting 'til I had some information. My daughter is expecting her second child next month, so many in the family are ill, I did not want to excite or worry anybody. We'd arrived at about 6:30 p.m., by 7:30 p.m. I decided to call Gayle to tell her what happened. Gayle asked if anyone was with me. When I said, "No one," she said, "Margaret, you have to tell Lori, she'll be more upset if you don't." I asked Gayle to call my son-in-law first, then let everyone else know. After I hung up the phone, I went back to where Harold was. He was in so much pain, I decided to phone Lori myself, but Gayle had already done that, so I called Jane,

Harold's sister. She waited until the next day to see him, since she had been helping all the other sick relatives. Harold was treated with anti-biotics to stop any infection, then more x-rays, anti-biotics and pain medication.

Harold's good friend and fishing buddy, Val, was a blessing to me. He came to relieve me so I could go home to rest. I had not had any sleep for 48 hours.

Thanks to Mary's Helpers, the Servite prayerline for all the prayers and through Our Lady of Compassionate Protection, Harold was released from the hospital, Friday, January 24th, our 49th wedding anniversary, without having to have surgery.

The 37th - Linda Danos, Raceland, La.

In January 1998, when I had my yearly mammogram it was discovered that an irregular lump was found in my left breast. On March 16, 1998 I had a biopsy done and the results came back as cancer. I returned to surgery on march 25 and they did a partial mastectomy with a lymphectomy. From May to July I had 35 treatments of radiation. After regular check up I was clear of the cancer. I continued to have yearly mammograms. In December 2002 another lump was discovered a quarter of an inch from the previous one. The doctor recommended that it be taken out immediately. The surgery was scheduled for June 14th. On December 17th, we came to the Mass here at Saia's and Louis said a Rosary for cancer patients. It really touched me that night. Also Benediction was for those there with cancer and I went up to receive the blessing.

My husband and I said the Rosary in front of the Blessed Mother's picture at home. He would ask that they wouldn't find the lump to be cancer and for a sign.

The surgery was performed on the 14th of January and we came to the Mass on the 17th. Louis said the Rosary again for cancer patients.

Well, I went for the results of the biopsy

and it wasn't cancer, just fatty tissue.

If you remember, it was very cold on the 17th and the next few days. The Sunday when returning from Mass on the 19th, there on one of the four rose bushes I have, was a very large pink rose next to the window closest to where I sleep. My husband said that's a sign that he had asked for, because the rose bushes have not bloomed since about Christmas and haven't bloomed since that day. Thank you Jesus and Blessed Mother.

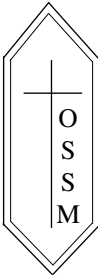
