




# From the desk of FATHER PAUL BERGERON



## DEVOTIONS TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions, Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart

Below are five traditional and popular devotions to our Blessed and Immaculate Mother Mary. These devotions are endorsed by Saints, Doctors, and Popes of the Church. In most cases, these devotions are endorsed by Mary and Christ through approved private revelations.



- 1. Holv Rosary is the Marian devotion of the Catholic Church. Pope Leo XIII wrote eleven encyclicals exhorting the faithful to pray the Rosary daily. Our Lady of Fatima asked the faithful to pray the Rosary daily. The Popes have also granted a plenary indulgence to reciting the Rosary as a family or in a Church. So, do you think Christ, Mary, and the Church want you pray the Rosary? You bet.
- 2. Brown Scapular. The Brown Scapular goes back to the Old Testament in essence with Elias the Carmelite Prophet. It is worn under the clothes and is the sign that you are consecrated to Mary under her title Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Today, many Catholics still wear the brown scapular as a sign of their devotion to Mary and an appeal to her intercession and spiritual protection, especially at the moment of death. Just as St. Simon Stock and the Carmelites entrusted their lives to Mary, we are also called to do so as her spiritual sons and daughters. Consider that every time we pray the Hail Mary we ask her to "pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death." The brown scapular allows one to wear this prayer as a kind of "badge" at all times
- 3. First Saturdays At Fatima, Our Lady asked that the faithful attend Holy Mass, pray the Rosary and meditate for 15 minutes on a mystery of Rosary for five consecutive first Saturdays of the month. God chose five first Saturdays of the month for the five chief blasphemies committed against Mary
  - 1. Denial of her as Mother of God 2. Denial of her Immaculate Conception 3. Denial of her Perpetual Virginity 4. Desecration of images of Mary 5. Those who teach children not to love Mary
- 4. Wearing the Miraculous Medal. The Miraculous Medal is based on a directive from the Blessed Mother to St. Catherine Laboure in November 1830 in Paris. Catherine saw Our Lady standing on a globe, with dazzling rays of light streaming from her outstretched hands. Framing the figure was an inscription: "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." Then Mary spoke to Catherine: "Have a medal struck upon this model. Those who wear it will receive great graces, especially if they wear it around the neck."
- 5. Three Hail Mary's. (See Page 7) Mary has promised the gift of sexual chastity and purity to those who pray three Hail Mary's morning and evening. It's an easy and simple devotion to add to the end of your Rosary. There are many, many wholesome devotions to our Immaculate Lady. Remember, countless saints have taught that a person cannot be saved without devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. If you love and worship the Incarnate Christ, how could you not have reverence for the Mother who made it possible?

# Where did Scapulars originate?

The scapular originates in the habits worn by the monastic orders, beginning with the Benedictines, and later adapted by many other religious communities. Basically, the scapular is a piece of cloth, about chest-wide from shoulder to shoulder, and drapes down the front and the back of the person, with an opening for the head. At first, the scapular served more as an apron worn during work, especially farm work; consequently, in the Rule of St. Benedict identified it as the "scapulare propter opera" ("the scapular because of works"). After the ninth century, a monk received the scapular after the profession of vows, and it became known as "the yoke of Christ" (iugum Christi) and "the shield of Christ" (scutum Christi). While certain modifications were made by the various communities, the scapular was a distinctive part of the religious habit.

Over time, pious lay people who worked closely with the monastic communities adopted a smaller version of the scapular. This smaller scapular consisted of two small pieces of cloth joined by two strings, and was worn around the neck and underneath a person's clothing. Eventually these smaller scapulars were marks of membership in confraternities,

groups of laity who joined together, attaching women formed a confraternity in honor themselves to the apostolate of a religious of the seven sorrows of Mary. They wore community and accepting certain rules and a black scapular, usually with an image of regulations.

Eventually, these smaller versions of the scapular became even more popular among the laity. To date, the Church has approved 18 different scapulars, distinguished by color, symbolism and devotion. Most scapulars still signify a person's affiliation with a particular confraternity, at least loosely. The following is a brief description of a few popular and less popular scapulars:

#### The Green Scapular

In 1840, our Blessed Mother gave the green scapular of the Immaculate Heart of Mary to Sister Justine Bisqueyburu, a Daughter of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul. This green scapular has the image of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on one side, and the image of the Immaculate life. I hail thee with all the joy of the angels Heart itself, pierced by a sword, surrounded and saints during your descent from the by the inscription, "Immaculate Heart of Mary, Cross. I hail thee with the sadness of your pray for us now and at the hour of our death." This scapular has been known for miracles related to spiritual conversion as well as healings from physical and mental illness.

#### The Black Scapular of the Seven Sorrows of Mary

After Pope Alexander IV's formal establishment

#### The Purple Scapular of **Benediction and Protection**

In 1878 Our Lady gave the Purple Scapular of Benediction and Protection to the world in a vision as a heavenly gift which promises divine protection for your family. Mary told Marie-Julie Jahenny: Those who possess the purple scapular "will see their family and home protected.. from fire, chastisements, storms, and darkness. They will have light as if it were plain day." It is "like a lightning rod beneath which the blows of divine wrath will not strike.





# St. Sharbel Makhlouf

Feast Day July 24 More than 33,000 miracles recorded as of July 2024 according to the records of Saint Maron Monastery

#### About Saint Sharbel

Saint Sharbel Makhlouf was a Maronite Catholic priest, monk, and hermit who lived from 1828 to 1898. During his life, he was revered as a humble and saintly priest, whose prayers brought forth blessings and miracles from God.

Following his death, people reported seeing lights around his tomb. When the tomb was opened, Saint Sharbel's body was found incorrupt and exuding sweat and blood. Soon after, pilgrims started flocking to his tomb to pray for his intercessions. God granted many physical healings and spiritual blessings. Saint Sharbel's vestments were changed several times after his burial due to the continued exuding of sweat and blood.

Pope Pius XII approved the decree recognizing the heroic virtues of the future saint in 1954. Pope Paul VI presided over the Beatification ceremony of Saint Sharbel at the end of the Second Vatican Council in 1965, and he was canonized a Saint by Pope Paul VI in 1977.

#### A GRAIN OF INCENSE IN THE HAND OF A NEWBORN BABY

Father Antoine Sadaga testified: Maria de Nazareth, a resident of Brazil, was barren. and medicine could not help her conceive. This failure increased her sadness and despair.

One day she met a Lebanese lady who had recently been to Brazil. She was carrying some blessed incense from St Sharbel, and started talking about the abundant miracles he had performed. Among the miracles was that God grant barren women the grace of bearing children. Maria was deeply touched and wished that the Lord would grant her a child. incense. Instead, she swallowed one grain of incense, after which she conceived a child.

veneration of St. Michael the Archangel. People who have accepted the scapular are called to serve Christ and His Church in the spirit of the Congregation of St. Michael the Archangel, as seen in its mottoes of. "Who is like to God?" and "Temperance and Work". The section worn on a person's back signifies an attitude of acceptance of Gods Will in bearing the crosses and difficulties of life. The front section of the scapular, worn on the chest, reminds us that our hearts should love God and our neighbor and that we should attempt to free ourselves from earthly attachments. and, through the intercession of St. Michael the Archangel, strive to attain eternal goods.

There are so many scapulars. Too many to describe like the Scapular in Blue; Trinity Scapular; Badge of the Sacred Heart; Five Way Scapular; Scapular of Our Lady of Mercy; Passion Scapular; Red Scapular of Christs Passion. Still the most well known of all times is the Brown Scapular and the most often worn.

#### The Brown Scapular of Our **Lady of Mount Carmel**

This scapular is the most popular of the different scapulars. Our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Simon Stock on Sunday, July 16, 1251. She presented him with the scapular and said, 'Take, beloved son, this scapular of thy order as a badge of my confraternity and for thee and all Carmelites a special sign of grace; whoever dies in this garment, will not suffer everlasting fire. It is the sign of salvation, a safeguard in dangers, a pledge of peace and of the covenant." In this apparition, our Blessed Mother promised a special protection for all members of the Carmelite Order, and a special grace at the hour of death to all who wear the scapular so that they would not perish in Hell but would be taken up to Heaven by her on the first Saturday after their death.

To be eligible for the scapular promise, one must be enrolled in the Brown Scapular Confraternity. This is a simple ceremony which can be performed by any priest.

#### The Crab, The Cross and St. Francis Xavier



ecember 3 is the feast of St. Francis Xavier, the patron of Xavier School

Francis Xavier was born on April 7, 1506 in the castle of Javier, Navarre, Spain. He was the youngest son of an impoverished nobleman, who had died while Francis was still a child. Francis grew up with the clear determination to repair the damage to his family's fortunes. His plans envisioned dreams of earthly ambition. In the end, instead of becoming a wealthy patron to tenants and soldiers, he became the patron of missionaries. Thus, God restored for all ages the family's honor by making him a legend and a saint.

One of the miracle stories attributed to Saint Francis Xavier is how he got his cross back after losing it at sea. It was said that Francis Xavier was caught up in a storm as he was

> travelling to Malacca in the year 1546. With much faith, he threw his cross into the sea, asking God to make it an instrument to pacify the turbulent sea. God indeed came to his aid. The storm halted and the sea calmed down. But he lost his cross. According to the story, Francis Xavier, upon reaching the shores of Malacca, found a crab crawling towards him holding the missing cross in its claws. This story was so important that it was depicted on the altar at the canonization ceremony and was one of four miracles represented on the banner that decorated St. Peter Church on that occasion.

#### THE HAIL MARY DEVOTION

One of the greatest means of salvation is, unquestionably, devotion to the Most Blessed Virgin Mary. All the holy Doctors of the Church are unanimous in saying with St. Alphonsus Maria Liguori: "A devout servant of Mary shall never perish." The chief thing is to persevere faithfully till death in this devotion.

Would you like to see the Blessed Mother before you die? Here is a simple devotion which the Blessed Virgin Mary herself taught to St. Mechtilde about the year 1270. It is known as the "Three Hail Mary Devotion," and consists of saying three times each day the Hail Mary with the invocation "O my Mother, preserve me this day (or night) from mortal sin." The prayer is said three times to honor the Most Blessed Trinity, Who is the source of all of Our Lady's greatness. It is intended to honor the Power of God the Father, the Wisdom of God the Son, and the Goodness of God the Holy Ghost, as communicated with such generosity to Our Blessed Lady. Can there be an easier or a more adaptable practice for all, than the recitation each day of three Hail Marys, in honor of the privileges conferred by the Adorable Trinity on the Blessed Virgin Mary?

This devotion was revealed by our Blessed Mother Herself to the Benedictine mystic, St. Mechtilde. In the Book of Revelations of St. Mechtilde we read:

"While Mechtilde was beseeching the glorious Virgin to assist her in her hour of death, Our Lady appeared to her and said: 'I will certainly. But I also want you to say three special Hail Mary's to me every day.

The secretary who wrote down the revelations of St. Mechtilde at her dictation was St. Gertrude the Great. She was present when St. Mechtilde died and saw Our Lord appearing to her. Later, many revelations regarding the Three Hail Mary Devotion were revealed to her also.

On the Feast of the Annunciation, 1299, when the Ave Maria was being sung in chapel during Matins, St. Gertrude saw a vision of three bright flames emanating from each of the Three Divine Persons, which penetrated the Heart of the Holy Virgin, like three rays. She was given to understand that the three brilliant streams were symbols that: "After the Power of the Father, the Wisdom of the Son, and the merciful Tenderness of the Holy Ghost, nothing approaches the Power, the Wisdom, and the merciful Tenderness of Mary."

She then saw other streams return to their first source, and was inspired to know that these were graces which Our Lady sent to those who prayed her Ave Maria with devotion.

On another day, during prayer she saw our Blessed Mother in the form of a white lily with three branches before the Most Blessed Trinity. This revelation confirmed the title of "the Immaculate Lily of the Most Holy Trinity", which saints had given to Her. The saint learned on that occasion that the blinding whiteness of the lily signified the immaculate purity of the Holy Mother of God which was never stained with even

the slightest venial sin. The three branches signified Our Lady's participation in the omnipotence of the Father, the wisdom of the Son, and the charity of the Holy Ghost. Then Our Blessed Mother spoke to St. Gertrude and said:

"To any soul who faithfully prays the Three Hail Mary's, I will appear at the hour of death in a splendor so extraordinary that it will fill the soul with heavenly consolation."

One of the first to say the three Hail Marys and to recommend them to others was the illustrious St. Anthony of Padua. His special aim in this practice was to honor the spotless Virginity of Mary and to preserve a perfect purity of mind, heart, and body in the midst of the dangers of the world. St. Leonard of Port Maurice, the celebrated missionary (1675-1751), advised all his hearers to practice this devotion. It was given as a penance in confession, to obtain the grace of avoiding all mortal sins during the day or night, especially for those who were struggling with sins of impurity; moreover, he promised in a special manner, eternal salvation to all those who proved constantly faithful to this practice. He would always impose the Three Hail Marys to be said morning and evening. After the example of those two great Franciscan Saints, St. Alphonsus Maria Liguori adopted this pious practice and gave it his most ardent and powerful support.
