






May we all become the instruments of God's Holy Will.

My friends, it was truly the most profound feeling of love and peace one could ever feel! Our Lord Jesus, with the most beautiful crystal blue eyes that seemed to penetrate our souls. Marie and I were in awe on our drive home that day, and hardly could speak for what we had witnessed together. Part 44 CHAPTER THREE
THE PROCLAMATION OF THE
GOSPEL

If, as St. Augustine says, we love only that which is beautiful, the incarnate Son, as the revelation of infinite beauty, is supremely lovable and draws us to himself with bonds of love. So a formation in the via pulchritudinis ought to be part of our effort to pass on the faith. Each particular Church should encourage the use of the arts in evangelization, building on the treasures of the past but also drawing upon the wide variety of contemporary expressions so as to transmit the faith in a new "language of parables".[132] We must be bold enough to discover new signs and new symbols, new flesh to embody and communicate the word, and different forms of beauty which are valued in different cultural settings, including those unconventional modes of beauty which may mean little to the evangelizers, yet prove particularly attractive for others.

168. As for the moral component of catechesis, which promotes growth in fidelity to the Gospel way of life, it is helpful to stress again and again the attractiveness and the ideal of a life of wisdom, self-fulfilment and enrichment. In the light of that positive message, our rejection of the evils which endanger that life can be better understood. Rather than experts in dire predictions, dour judges bent on rooting out every threat and deviation, we should appear as joyful messengers of challenging proposals, guardians of the goodness and beauty which shine forth in a life of fidelity to the Gospel.

Personal accompaniment in processes of growth

169. In a culture paradoxically

suffering from anonymity and at the same time obsessed with the details of other people's lives, shamelessly given over to morbid curiosity, the Church must look more closely and sympathetically at others whenever necessary. In our world, ordained ministers and other pastoral workers can make present the fragrance of Christ's closeness and his personal gaze. The Church will have to initiate everyone - priests, religious and laity - into this "art of accompaniment" which teaches us to remove our sandals before the sacred ground of the other (cf. Ex 3:5). The pace of this accompaniment must be steady and reassuring, reflecting our closeness and our compassionate gaze which also heals, liberates and encourages growth in the Christian life.

170. Although it sounds obvious, spiritual accompaniment must lead others ever closer to God, in whom we attain true freedom. Some people think they are free if they can avoid God; they fail to see that they remain existentially orphaned, helpless, homeless. They cease being pilgrims and become drifters, flitting around themselves and never getting anywhere. To accompany them would be counterproductive if it became a sort of therapy supporting their self-absorption and ceased to be a pilgrimage with Christ to the Father.

Today more than ever we need men and women who, on the basis of their experience of accompanying others, are familiar with processes which call for prudence, understanding, patience and docility to the Spirit, so that they can protect the sheep from wolves who would scatter the flock. We need to practice the art of listening, which is more than simply hearing. Listening, in communication, is an openness of heart which makes possible that closeness without which genuine spiritual encounter cannot occur. Listening helps us to find the right gesture and word which shows that we are more than simply bystanders. Only through such respectful and compassionate listening can we enter on the paths of true growth and awaken a yearning for the Christian ideal: the desire to respond fully to God's love and to bring to fruition what he has sown in our lives. But this always demands the patience of one who knows full well what St. Thomas Aguinas tells us: that anyone can have grace and charity, and yet falter in the exercise of the virtues because of persistent "contrary inclinations".[133] In other words, the organic unity of the virtues always and necessarily exists in habitu, even though forms of conditioning can hinder the operations of those virtuous habits. Hence the need for "a pedagogy which will introduce people step by step to the full appropriation of the mystery". [134] Reaching a level of maturity where individuals can make truly free and responsible decisions calls for much time and patience. As Blessed Peter Faber used to say: "Time is God's messenger". All these souls are greatly loved by Me. They are making retribution to My justice. It is in your power to bring them relief. Draw all the indulgences from the treasury fo My Church and offer them on their behalf. Oh, if you only knew the torments they suffer, you would continually offer for them the alms of the spirit and pay off their debt to My justice."

Most Merciful Jesus, You Yourself have said that You desire mercy; so I bring into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls in Purgatory, souls who are very dear to You, and yet, who must make retribution to Your justice. May the streams of Blood and Water which gushed forth from Your Heart put out the flames of Purgatory, that there, too, the power of Your mercy may be celebrated.

I am writing to give you my testimony on Our Lady of Compassionate Protection. Ever since I had my picture blessed by Fr. Paul, when I look at it, Mary's eyes seem to become alive and move. She also becomes illuminated by a white or golden glow. Sometimes she fades almost to transparent and is outlined in golden light. Sometimes I can see faces that look like negatives of a picture flash on both sides of her under the Cross. They are not clear and only appear for an instant. I wonder if they are the Holy Souls?

I have my picture on top of a chest of drawers on the right side of a Crucifix of Jesus with Mary at his side, which is about 12 inches high. Recently every time I say my Rosary, a duplicate image of Mary comes out of the original image of Mary and hovers or glides to the right side of Jesus on the Cross. This image has a pink tint to her veil, while the original image has a light blue tint. I am not certain that I am seeing correctly, but it seems real.

When I attend Church, I always sit in the last row, but I always go early and am one of the first ones there. There is an almost life sized statue of Jesus a little to the left of where I sit. It is on a wall across from where I sit and the altar is in the middle of that space. This Sunday when I

was in Church, after the Mass had started, I could see two of these statues. The image came out of the space and I saw it next to a stained glass window of the Assumption. I saw it all through Mass. When the priest moved in front of this image I could not see it but as soon as he stepped back, it was there. I could not see the bottom fourth of the original statue of Jesus because the people's heads blocked my view of it. But I saw the whole of it in the image on the statue. Jesus is standing on a blue pedestal which I could not see, but I saw it clearly in the appearance of the image. I know that I don't know how to word things correctly, but I wondered what you think of this? I have told no one about the Jesus image.
