Meditation on the February 25, 2023 Message





A word from FATHER PAUL BERGERON

We have heard the guestion before. What came first the chicken or the egg? With the price of eggs as high as they are these days, another question might just enter your mind-why don't we raise our own chickens then we can have all





the eggs we want? But I digress, we do know what came first in our Church's Holy Seasons i.e. Advent, then Christmas, then Lent, then Easter. They follow the Life of Jesus which starts at the crib and ends on The Cross followed by The Resurrection. In each case we are called to prepare ourselves spiritually so that when the event is remembered we know all that is entailed. For example before we receive The Holy Ashes on our forehead we are prepared to go forth and remember The Passion of Christ. Many people just wear a simple cross around the neck and that's ok but to wear that cross with the Corpus of Christ on it doesn't tell half the story, it tells the real and whole story. Once I heard a Priest say there is never a resurrection without a crucifixion first. Jesus knew this all too well when He laid down His Life so that we could truly live. This is why we can never erase His Passion and Death and just dwell on The Resurrection. In the same sense The Jews remember the full story of The Seder Meal when the youngest of the attendees ask The Rabbi why is this night so very special? Then The Rabbi answers with telling the whole story of when their people were in bondage by The Pharaoh in Egypt and how God rescued them to finally live in the Land of Milk and Honey. The Rabbi tells the whole story. So too we as Christians must begin our Lent remembering The Passion of Christ. Then and only then can we celebrate The Resurrection. The answer by the way of what came first the chicken or the egg is an easy one for the Christian to answer. God created the hen to lay the eggs thus the chicken came first. God Bless you-Fr. Paul



The Sword of Saint Michael

Quis ut Deus? Who is like unto God?

When Saint Michael the Archangel cast Satan and his demons into Hell during the Great Battle in Heaven, the war did not end there. As Satan continues to "prowl about the world, seeking the ruin of souls," Saint Michael opposes him everywhere.

This enmity is symbolized by a mysterious geographic line called the "Sword of Saint Michael," linking six shrines dedicated to the great Archangel. This line extends northwest to southeast from Skellig Michael in Ireland and ending at the Carmelite Monastery of Stella Maris Haifa, Israel. Some of these shrines were formerly places of

pagan devil-worship. Transformed into some of the most sublime monasteries, basilicas and churches, these shrines to Saint Michael represent his victory over the devil and his powerful intercession before the Throne of God.

Skellig Michael, County Kerry, Ireland
In the sixth century, Irish monks established a monastery on a rock island eight miles off the coast of County Kerry, Ireland. Seeking a place suited to extreme penance, lofty contemplation and acute solitude, the monks lived in stone huts high on the craggy summit of the rock. Only thirteen monks lived on the tiny island at a time, the abbot and twelve monks, symbolizing Our Lord and the Twelve Apostles. Skellig Michael (Michael's Rock) was a monastery fittingly dedicated to the mightiest archangel.

Saint Michael's Mount, Cornwall, England

On the coast of Cornwall in England is the site of another island monastery, Saint Michael's Mount. Accessible only at low tide, the monastery has attracted countless pilorims due to an apparition of Saint Michael to local fishermen and the miracles that occurred there.

Mont Saint Michel, Normandy, France

The most iconic of all the shrines of Saint Michael is Mont Saint Michael on the coast of Normandy, France. In a vision to Saint Aubert, Bishop of Avranches, in the ninth century, the Archangel ordered him to build the shrine on what was formerly a Druid devil-worship site. One of the most sublime examples of Gothic architecture, Mont Saint Michel continues to attract pilgrims and visitors. Each year, on Saint Michael's feast day, September 29, French paratroopers conduct a parachute jump in honor of their celestial patron.

Sacra di San Michele, near Turin, Italy
The Sacra di San Michele near Turin, Italy, hangs on a spur of Mount Pirchiriano, commanding a panoramic view of the Val de Susa. Built on top of an ancient pagan settlement and a Roman fortification, this shrine housed a Benedictine monastery starting in the ninth century. Its setting is consistent with the epic location of Saint Michael's other shrines.

Monte Sant'Angelo, Mount Gargano, Italy

The most prominent shrine to Saint Michael, one associated with four apparitions of the Archangel, is found in a cave at the top of Monte Gargano. On the spur of Italy, overlooking the Adriatic Sea, the Shrine of Monte Sant' Angelo sul Gargano is known as the "Celestial Basilica," having been blessed by the Archangel Michael himself in the fifth century after a series of miraculous events. In the seventeenth century, Saint Michael appeared to Bishop Alfonso Puccinelli and cured townspeople and anyone who devotedly kept stones from the cave marked with a cross and the initials "MA" (Michael Archangel). Many popes, nobles and saints number among the pilgrims who prayed at this shrine. Crusaders on their way to the Holy Land prayed to the Patron of Soldiers and carved numerous crosses on the cave walls

Monastery of the Archangel Michael, Island of Symi, Greece

On the island of Symi in Greece lies a monastery dedicated to Saint Michael built in the fifth century over the site of a temple to the pagan god Apollo. A miraculous icon of Saint Michael can be found there as well as a museum full of testimonials of the favors and graces granted through the intercession of Saint Michael, especially to sailors.

Carmelite Monastery of Stella Maris, Haifa, Israel

All of these shrines point to the Carmelite Monastery of Stella Maris in Haifa, Israel. Situated on Mount Carmel, the monastery has a sweeping view of the Mediterranean Sea and the port city. It is only fitting that the sword line of St. Michael shrines points to a monastery dedicated to the Queen of Angels, Mary Most Holy, at what can be considered the entrance to the Holy Land upon which she and her Divine Son walked.

These are the shrines that make up the "Sword of Saint Michael." They shine on the tops of high, epic places honoring the Archangel whose very name makes the demons tremble and the angels exalt....

"JUST HAVE FAITH IN MY SON JESUS"


If only we had one mustard seed of faith and believed that we can be healed by our Lord Jesus, he would answer our prayers.

"I am the one appointed by the eternal Father to crush the head of the ancient serpent and anything that threatens to devour you. Say my rosary and bring me a rose and I will take your troubles to my son, Jesus Christ."



The Lebanese saint has become widely known as a miraculous intercessor on countless occasions.

Throughout history God has chosen certain individuals to work stunning miracles that reveal his great power and love for all of humanity. Among them, St. Charbel Makhlouf has proven time

and time again to be a powerful intercessor through whom God desires to reveal his healing touch.

He was a humble and holy hermit whose weaknesses became great strengths in the hand of God.

Charbel was born in 1828 in Lebanon and was raised in a poor shepherd family. As he grew, Charbel was attracted to the hermit's life of the desert and eventually entered the Monastery of St. Maron in Annaya. He was faithful to his duties in religious life and drew closer to God every day. After many years Charbel felt God calling him again to become a hermit and was granted permission to live the rest of his life at a hermitage set on a hill near the monastery.

Charbel died on Christmas Eve at the age of 70, and when his body was later exhumed it was found to be incorrupt. A holy oil was discovered flowing from the tomb, which has since been the source of numerous miracles.

For example, a blind woman from Arizona was healed in 2016 after venerating the relics of St. Charbel. The medical committee investigating the miracle admitted, "We have no medical explanation and therefore believe this to be a miraculous healing through the intercession of St. Charbel."

In France, a baby boy was destined to die, so the family used some oil from St. Charbel's tomb and prayed a novena to St. Charbel for a miraculous healing. At the end of September, Côme was evaluated again. To our joy and to the astonishment of the doctors, his condition had improved so much that it was determined he would live ... The Blessed Virgin and St. Charbel protected him."

There are many more miracles reported proving that God enjoys working miracles through this humble Lebanese saint.

While we are never "guaranteed" a miracle when praying to God through a saint, the process can often transform our hearts and help us be prepared for whatever plan God has designed.

There is the one novena (usually prayed for nine consecutive days) to St. Charbel that many turn to in their time of need.

There is a big difference between hearing and listening. We hear a lot of thinas, but listenina

is an art that requires concentrating and understanding what the other wants. Constructive listening has requirements: I must connect emotionally and empathize with the other and put myself in her shoes if we are to reach a resolution and build each

It is also crucial, when listening, to remove from our minds all prejudice: wait and do not form judgments before the other person finishes talking.

There is a difference, then, between dialogue, conversation, and discussion. Conversation is an exchange of ideas that happens every day and at all times between people. Discussion is a debate over ideas in which only one idea wins: it is an exchange of ideas in order to convince the other. Dialogue is the most important and the foundation of human life: it is a communication that aims to change and build up. Dialogue aims to produce a certain effect, a new birth. To be constructive and fruitful, dialogue must be neither condescending, nor cowed. A constructive dialogue is horizontally level. The Lord Jesus taught with authority, but when dealing with people, he communicated at their level. In today's world a lot of ideas and information reaches us. We must always discern which of it we need, is correct

and beneficial, and ignore the rest. In our conversations, we must think well before we spew words out, for the wrong word can destroy. We must speak carefully, weigh our words, and be clear. We must always check if the other person understands correctly what we are saying, asking, or clarifying. We must listen attentively. We must not react before the other person is finished talking. We must practice listening with patience, calm, and concentration. People use all five senses when they converse, and we should use all these senses constructively.

Every person is unique, and every dialogue must be built on the foundation of love and honesty. No dialogue succeeds without these

Let us consider this example: two people are playing tennis. Each of them hits the ball to the other containing a question or a thought. The other hits the balls back containing a question, an answer, or an idea...thrown back and forth until the players become less important than the ball that keeps getting bigger. The goal becomes more important, as do love, sincerity, and creativity. This constitutes true, constructive dialogue that leads to change in the family, society, and humanity.

All this occurs in the presence of Jesus, and, without Jesus, no upbuilding is possible. On this blessed feast, let us re-enter into dialogue with God, so we may be filled by him and start a dialogue with our fellow human. To every person we meet let us add a brick

all that we have. Similarly, let us allow every person we meet to add a brick to

our structure. But the Lord is the one who raises the building and helps it grow and develop. The spiritual message of this feast is a reminder that Jesus is the foundation, the focus of the feast. He dwells in every needy person and teaches us to reach out to the other in order to reach perfection.

From the experiences of Raymond Nader: "The word is embodied and not a soundwave reverberating in the air. Chisel every word in your mind before you say it, sculpt it in your spirit, smooth it out in your heart, and proffer it as you would lay out a brick in the right place. Disregard words that do not build up. Speak only when your words are deeper and more eloquent than your silence." Prayer: "Lord, you have revealed to us the dimensions of man, the creature you made in your image and likeness. We ask you to send us your Holy Spirit [...] which dwelt on the Virgin Mary and made her Mother of Christ. May this same Holy Spirit descend today upon us all, individuals and couples, and create in our hearts a new person, the creature awaiting to be born in us. Let us repeat with the Virgin Mary: 'I am the handmaid of the Lord, let it be done to me according to your word.' Then will the Word become flesh and dwell in us, as he dwelt in the womb of the Virgin Mary. Thus, Jesus will be born in our hearts... Amen. (Fr. Henri Boulad, S.J., from his book, "Toward a better life").
