

The love and the laugh of Father Jeanfreau of Immaculate Conception Church and School will be missed.

Father Jeanfreau, 60, died Nov. 28 in an accident in his woodworking shop IN HONOR OF on the grounds of Immaculate Conception Parish. The Jefferson Parish Coroner's Office classified his death as accidental blunt-force trauma.

Those who knew Father Jimmy Jeanfreau said he had a zest for life manifested through his love for parishioners and students at Immaculate Conception Parish in Marrero as well as through his tireless support of the church's universal call for Catholics to be missionaries for the faith.

"Father Jimmy was a homegrown missionary who lived life to the fullest." said Kristie Vollentine, who worked with Father Jeanfreau in his role as executive director of the archdiocesan Pontifical Mission Societies. "He lembraced his life of mission with a zeal like no other. He loved his family, his

faith communities, his brother priests, his church parish and his mission office as if all of these were gifts from God.'

Father Jeanfreau, who had a master's degree in oceanographic engineering, used his woodworking skills not just as a hobby to relax but also to create gifts for friends and coworkers. He hand-crafted large and small pieces – candy bowls for the desk, dip bowls, a chopping board, a school bell with a wooden handle and holder, jewelry cases – and often sold them to raise funds at parish events.

He signed each piece with a wooden stamp of a large tree encircled by the words: "Handcrafted by Fr. Jimmy-NOLA."

"He was always making gifts," DiMarco said. "He actually built a small pond that he filled with water and coy fish. I think we're going to name it Father Jimmy's Mission Pond."

Father Jeanfreau attended St. Mary Magdalen School in Metairie and St. John Vianney Prep and East Jefferson High School. He attended Louisiana State University, Florida Atlantic University, Duke University and Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans. He earned a bachelor of science degree in engineering, a master's in oceanographic engineering from Florida Atlantic and a master of divinity from Notre Dame Seminary. He was ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of New Orleans on May 30, 1992, and served as parochial vicar at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish in Belle Chasse, St. Catherine of Siena in Metairie and St. Luke the Evangelist in Slidell.

His pastorates were at St. Jerome in Kenner and Immaculate Conception in Marrero. Father Jeanfreau also served as chaplain at Cabrini High School, Pope John Paul II High School and Ursuline Academy.

His Funeral Mass was celebrated Dec. 6 at Immaculate Conception Church. He was buried in the tomb for archdiocesan priests at St. Louis Cemetery No. 3 in New Orleans.



#### FATHER PETER MARY ROOKEY AND HIS MIRACLE

Did I have pancreatic cancer? When I went for the biopsy, I can remember the doctor coming to the room next to mine and I heard him tell the young lady there that she did not have cancer. My mind was set. I was sure I didn't have it either. But when he came in my room, his news was different. It looked like I had pancreatic cancer. My faith began to take over, just like it had for the young woman in the article who had remained so positive through her pancreatic cancer ordeal. **Faith chased away my fear.** 

My next step was to see an oncologist. When he came in, he had positive aura about him. He glowed with hope. We were gonna get through this. It was Stage 1B. This was not necessarily a death sentence. I had a chance to beat this. He prescribed six treatments of the strongest possible chemotherapy one could take, one every other week. By the time I got to the third session, the Holy Spirit spoke to me saying "Linda you are about to be challenged." Despite being very sick from the effects of the treatments, I realized that many of the sick people taking chemo around me really needed my prayers. Their pain humbled me. I had so many prayer warriors praying for me. These people needed my prayers. The pregnant mother that was taking chemo, the gentleman who celebrated because he had regained 2 pounds despite the chemo, the lady who laid there unaware of what was happening around her and whose husband looked very concerned.

There is healing when you pray for others. Share your graces with others who are in need of them. Those who don't have others offering up adoration hours for them, mass intentions for them, rosaries for them. So I prayed for them. The first surgery was to remove the polycystic cysts.

Once they removed the large cysts they could see exactly what they were up against with the cancerous mass. By God's grace, everything went very well. Three months later, after that I got my strength back, I went in for the cancer surgery on the pancreas. I was blessed that I had two incredible surgeons, one who had recently relocated to Northside Hospital from MD Anderson in Houston. The other from Mt Sinai Hospital in New York. I had these angels at my side, fighting for my life. The surgeons did not know exactly what they would have to do – they would have to decide what to keep and what to remove as they were working on me.

I kept this positive attitude. Everything was going to be okay. The sweet Holy Spirit was with me. I had my Blessed Mother with me. Jesus with me. Saint Joseph with me. All the angels and the communion of saints. From the moment I met the oncologist through the able hands of the surgeons, I knew I would beat this cancer. Their hands and hearts were guided by my loving heavenly family. How could I have any doubt?

Our God is a God of miracles. He only asks that we have faith. I survived pancreatic cancer through early detection and my faith. Thank you for letting me share my story with you. 



#### The Story of the Miraculous Medal

#### Feast Day Nov 27 - Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal

On November 27, 1830, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Saint Catherine Laboure', a Daughter of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul. It was during that visit on November 27, that Mary asked Sister Catherine to have a medal made. Mary showed her what the medal should look like - Mary standing on the globe with a snake under her feet and rays extending from rings on her fingers to represent the graces given to us from her Son. She also asked for the words "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." She was claiming her title as the Immaculate Conception. On the back there would be a cross that was interlocked with an "M". Mary's mission is that of her Son. There would be the sorrowful hearts of Jesus and Mary at the base, indicating their communion with our suffering. Twelve stars were also included to remind us of the followers of God - the twelve tribes of Israel - twelve apostles - and us who follow in those traditions.

#### FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or Candlemas. It is based on the Scripture passage in Luke 2:22-40 where the Holy Family journeys to Jerusalem forty days after the birth of Jesus to present him to God and offer sacrifice in the temple. At this time Mary completes the ritual purification required of women after childbirth, and Joseph offers the sacrifice for the redemption of the firstborn, as required by the Law of Moses. The Holy Family offered two turtledoves, permitted to the poor instead of a whole lamb. During their time in the temple Simeon gave his famous prophecy about the Christ Child being a light to the Gentile nations and a sign for the Jews, and that a sword would pierce Mary's soul. On this day the Church has a special ritual involving a procession and the blessing of candles, a symbol of Christ whose birth illumined the world's darkness.

The righteous man Simeon takes the Child Jesus into his arms and turns to his Mother and says, "And you yourself a sword will pierce." Even before Jesus can walk, Mary is resolved "to walk just as he will walk" to his crucifixion. "Remember the sufferings which gave new radiance to the faith. All saints give testimony to the truth that without real effort, no one ever wins the crown" (Saint Thomas Becket)

Humans have a fundamental need to communicate with the Creator to grow in their humanity. They also need social communication: the child at home communicates emotionally with her mother and fathers. Then, when she grows up, she discovers the greatness of communicating with the Creator without whom no growth or perfection is possible. Humans delve deeply into the mystery of existence and the meaning of life through this communication with the Creator.

Saint Paul says that God has spoken to us in many ways, beginning with the prophets, but in the fullness of time he spoke to us through the Word, his son Jesus. Jesus is the communication between us and God. This is of great importance.

In our daily life, we live through many different experiences. We learn new things every day, and we take in many thoughts. All this shapes us. The human brain contains ideas, experiences, and knowledge. In interpersonal communication, all these are expressed: they proceed out of one person and are received by another. What proceeds

from one becomes part of the other and contributes to her formation.

Thus God spoke to us through the Word who took flesh and lived among us. Who is the Word of God? It is Jesus, God's mind, God's experience, God's love, God's might...All these became incarnate in the Word, so that this Word may be in us. This is a big blessing and the splendor of humanity. This is the greatest historical event, the apex of communication between God and humans, whose goal is for humans to receive the perfection of their humanity from Jesus, the perfect man, and the perfection of their divinity from Jesus, the perfect God.

Communication, then, takes from us and puts in the other person, and vice versa. True communication is founded on building up others.

How did Jesus communicate with people? With his disciples: who do people say that I

am? He asked them and they replied. Then he asked again, and Peter answered under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit who revealed the teaching to him.

The disciples of the road to Emmaus: two disciples were walking and communicating with each other. Jesus started a dialogue with them. He walked with them, asked them, explained to them, and heard them. Jesus' communication with people inspired techniques taught today in universities. When asked if it is lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, Jesus asked: whose image is this? In the encounter with the blind man, Jesus came to the blind man and asked him what he wanted so that he would engage him in dialogue. We see that, in his wonderful dialogue with the Samaritan woman, Jesus entered her life and redirected her from the water that quenches earthly thirst to the deep living water that springs out of the person's depth.

In other instances, Jesus did not talk, but his silence was very eloquent. In the episode of the stoning of the adulteress, he only wrote in

the sand. In many other instances, he spoke with his eyes, as when he saw Peter at the trial: he looked

at him and his look said a lot.
He spoke to his disciples in parables. He drew a picture in parables. He was the first to use audio-visual aids.
In sum, communication today is necessary for learning, progress, and development. Every experience we live and every word we hear shape us, either in a negative or in a positive way. But every dialogue with the other can be beneficial to us if put in the context of self-upbuilding through God's presence in us.

Communication does not need to be verbal. It is comprised of three elements: 40% audible, 50% visual, and 10% verbal. When we listen, we understand a lot from intonation. Our eyes communicate half the content, and they are the most important element of communication: eyes speak louder than words.

Saint Francis used to send out his disciples to preach and instructed them to even use their words in preaching, if necessary.

When we communicate and aim to convey an idea to another person, it is important to express it properly, then put it out there and wait for a response. We should not simply output ideas without listening to the other and understanding her

These are the rules of communication: convey a message and wait, without coercing or imposing certain ideas on the other.

It is crucial that I accept the other who is different from me, otherwise it is no use communicating with her. I must take into consideration obstacles, language, time, place, age, etc. All this affects communication and must be taken into account.
