"Mary has Been Our Mother of Joy & Hope!"

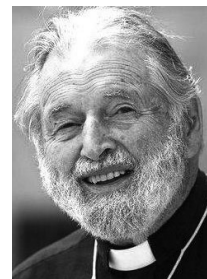

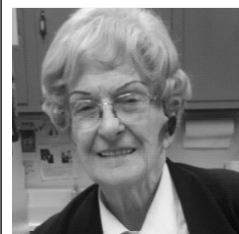

Gayle was born October 14, 1937, in New Orleans (Algiers), Louisiana, to the late Patrick Henry and Juanita Ruiz Gibson, Sr. and was a lifelong resident of the West Bank of New Orleans. She was preceded in death by her siblings: Edward Gibson, Sr., Joseph Gibson, Sr., Henrietta Gibson Lauman, Patrick Gibson, Sr., Juanita Gibson Boudreaux, Leo Gibson, and Mary Agnes Gibson. Gayle is survived by her beloved husband of 60 years, James Ponseti, Sr. and a brother, Francis Gibson. She was a loving mother of James W. Jr, (wife Trish), Borland Leo (Rik), Martin Robert (Mik), Gaylyn Ponseti McGlauchlin (husband Todd); Damian Ponseti Knight (husband Tim) and Erin Ponseti Bush (Husband Tom Sr); eight grandchildren, Edward Knight (wife Cloe), Melissa Clark (husband Todd), Jake Ponseti, Camille Ponseti, Elyn McGlauchlin, Julia McGlauchlin, Tom Bush, Jr. and Jack Bush; and two great-grandchildren, Daniel Clark and Sadie Clark. She graduated in 1955 from Holy Name of Mary High School in Algiers, La. Gayle then acted and modeled locally in the late 1950s and worked in data processing from the 1960s to the early 1980s. She enjoyed the history of New Orleans, and in the past, has volunteered as a docent/guide for various historic home tours. She also enjoyed painting and making silk-flower arrangements, preparing traditional family dishes, which she shared with her family. Since 1987, much of her energy, outside of family, was dedicated to Mary's Helpers, Inc., a Servite organization committed to advancing the messages of Our Lady of Medjugorje. Over the years, she led a number of pilgrimages to Medjugorje and other sacred sites in places like Europe, as well as edited the Mary's Helpers monthly newsletter, and hosted the weekly radio broadcast. In later years, she succeeded the late Margaret Trosclair as director of the organization.

Funeral Services were held at St. Martha Church in Harvey on Monday, December 16, 2019 and was buried in St. Bartholomew Cemetery in Algiers. Part 43 CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL



168. As for the moral component of catechesis, which promotes growth in fidelity to the Gospel way of life, it is helpful to stress again and again the attractiveness and the ideal of a life of wisdom, self-fulfilment and enrichment. In the light of that positive message, our rejection of the evils which endanger that life can be better understood. Rather than experts in dire predictions, our judges bent on rooting out every threat and deviation, we should appear as joyful messengers of challenging proposals, guardians of the goodness and beauty which shine forth in a life of fidelity to the Gospel.

Personal accompaniment in processes of growth

169. In a culture paradoxically suffering from anonymity and at the same time obsessed with the details of other people's lives, shamelessly given over to morbid curiosity, the Church must look more closely and sympathetically at others whenever necessary. In our world, ordained ministers and other pastoral workers can make present the fragrance of Christ's closeness and his personal gaze. The Church will have to initiate everyone – priests, religious and laity – into this "art of accompaniment" which teaches us to remove our sandals before the sacred ground of the other (cf. Ex 3:5). The pace of this accompaniment must be steady and reassuring, reflecting our closeness and our compassionate gaze which also heals, liberates and encourages growth in the Christian life.

170. Although it sounds obvious, spiritual accompaniment must lead others ever closer to God, in whom we attain true freedom. Some people think they are free if they can avoid God; they fail to see that they remain existentially orphaned, helpless, homeless. They cease being pilgrims and become drifters, flitting around themselves and never getting anywhere. To accompany them would be counterproductive if it became a sort of therapy supporting their self-absorption and ceased to be a pilgrimage with Christ to the Father.

171. Today more than ever we need men and women who, on the basis of their experience of accompanying others, are familiar

with processes which call for prudence, understanding, patience and docility to the Spirit, so that they can protect the sheep from wolves who would scatter the flock. We need to practice the art of listening, which is more than simply hearing. Listening, in communication, is an openness of heart which makes possible that closeness without which genuine spiritual encounter cannot occur. Listening helps us to find the right gesture and word which shows that we are more than simply bystanders. Only through such respectful and compassionate listening can we enter on the paths of true growth and awaken a yearning for the Christian ideal: the desire to respond fully to God's love and to bring to fruition what he has sown in our lives. But this always demands the patience of one who knows full well what Saint Thomas Aquinas tells us: that anyone can have grace and charity, and yet falter in the exercise of the virtues because of persistent "contrary inclinations".[133] In other words, the organic unity of the virtues always and necessarily exists in habitu, even though forms of conditioning can hinder the operations of those virtuous habits. Hence the need for "a pedagogy which will introduce people step by step to the full appropriation of the mystery".[134] Reaching a level of maturity where individuals can make truly free and responsible decisions calls for much time and patience. As Blessed Peter Faber used to say: "Time is God's messenger".

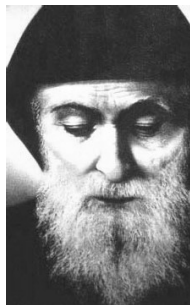
St. Sharbel Makhlouf

Recent Documented Miracle

The testimony in the following miracle involves a "visit" from St. Sharbel by Margaret Bieser



Mr. Salib Doub, a resident of Ohio, was born in Egypt in 1950. After being diagnosed with fourth degree lung

cancer, the cancer spread into his thoracic cavity. The treatment of chemotherapy and radiation was begun, but severe pain ensued. Nothing seemed to improve his condition; the doctors estimated that his time was short and therefore advised the family to fulfill all the father's request. Mr. Doub's daughter asked one of her friend's to obtain oil from the tomb of St. Sharbel for her father. On June 29, 2019, after receiving oil and soil from the tomb, Mr. Doub's wife anointed him with the oil and dissolved the soil in a glass of water for him to drink. On the same day, Mr. Doub was healed! St. Sharbel had answered their prayers through a miracle of healing!

The medical reports were sent to the monastery where the miracle was recorded on July 17th, 2019.

SECOND MIRACLE

Joe Michael Abi Hatem, an agricultural engineer born in Lebanon in 1995 began experiencing headaches that became more severe each day. An injury to his finger caused bleeding that could not be stopped. He was taken to the emergency room where he was examined by Dr. Salma Sfeir. Tests were taken that showed Joe Michael had cancer of the blood. He started chemotherapy and underwent surgery. St. Sharbel appeared to Joe in a dream and stayed beside him in silence. The Lord also appeared in the dream and placed his hand on Joe's waist. On the second day, December 22, 2018, Joe's immune system recovered! On December 30, 2018, Joe was discharged from the hospital.

After several reviews of the laboratory tests, the doctors told Joe and his family, "Congratulations! Joe Michael is healed!"

St. Sharbel appeared to Joe's mother in a dream and said to her sweetly, "Be quiet, be quiet." She asked him for a sign to understand if Joe Michael was healed. St. Sharbel then gave her a sign by closing and opening his eyes three times.

The family went to Annaya in July of 2019 to thank St. Sharbel and brought the medical records to register the miracle.

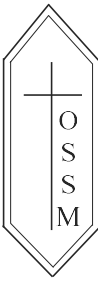
TESTIMONY #39

I am writing to give you my testimony on Our Lady of Compassionate Protection. Ever since I had my picture blessed by Fr. Paul, when I look at it, Mary's eyes seem to become alive and move. She also becomes illuminated by a white or golden glow. Sometimes she fades almost to transparent and is outlined in golden light. Sometimes I can see faces that look like negatives of a picture flash on both sides of her under the Cross. They are not clear and only appear for an instant. I wonder if they are the Holy Souls?

I have my picture on top of a chest of drawers on the right side of a Crucifix of Jesus with Mary at his side, which is about 12 inches high. Recently every time I say my Rosary, a duplicate image of Mary comes out of the original image of Mary and hovers or glides to the right side of Jesus on the Cross. This image has a pink tint to her veil, while the original image has a light blue tint. I am not certain that I am seeing correctly, but it seems real.

When I attend Church, I always sit in the last row, but I always go early and am one of the first ones there. There is an almost life sized statue of Jesus a little to the left of where I sit. It is on a wall across from where I sit and the altar is in the middle of that space. This Sunday when I was in Church, after the Mass had started, I could see two of this statue.
