
From the Reflections of Wavne White 9/27/15

The idea is expressed even more graphically by Sirach: "Water extinguishes blazing fire: so almsgiving atones for sin" (Sir 3:30).

Testament: "Maintain constant love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins" (1 Pet 4:8). This truth greatly influenced the thinking of the Fathers of the Church and helped create a prophetic, counter-cultural resistance to the self-centred hedonism of paganism. We can recall a single example: "If we were in peril from fire, we would certainly run to water in order to extinguish the fire... in the same way, if a spark of sin flares up from our straw, and we are troubled on that account, whenever we have an opportunity to perform a work of mercy, we should rejoice, as if a fountain opened before so that the fire might be extinguished".[160]

194. This message is so clear and direct, so simple and eloquent, that no ecclesial interpretation has the right to relativize it. The Church's reflection on these texts ought not to obscure or weaken their force, but urge us to accept their exhortations with courage and zeal. Why complicate something so simple? Conceptual tools exist to heighten contact with the realities they seek to explain, not to distance us from them. This is especially the case with those biblical exhortations which summon us so forcefully to brotherly love, to humble and generous service, to justice and mercy towards the poor. Jesus taught us this way of looking at others by his words and his actions. So why cloud something so clear? We should not be concerned simply about falling into doctrinal error, but about remaining faithful to this light-filled path of life and wisdom. For "defenders of orthodoxy are sometimes accused of passivity, indulgence, or culpable complicity regarding the intolerable situations of injustice and the political regimes which prolong

FROM HIDDEN HERMIT TO FAMED **MIRACLE WORKER**

On July 24, 1927On July 24, 1927, two doctors with the French Medical Institute examined Father Charbel's body in detail. They drew up various documents which were submitted to the proper Church authority. Their testimony was signed in the presence of ecclesiastical judges and other witnesses. The body of Father Charbel was clothed in new priestly vestments and placed in a new coffin of wood covered with zinc. A zinc tube containing all the documents pertaining to his case was sealed with the remains in a new tomb. The monks built an oratory especially for prayer before Father Charbel's remains. His body lay undisturbed here for 23 years.

In 1950. Pope Pius XII declared a jubilee year. Pilgrims to Father Charbel's tomb noticed a liquid seeping from the tomb and flowing onto the floor. The superior ordered the tomb opened at once, fearing damage to the precious remains. The tomb was dry, except for the liquid that flowed from a crack in the casket. Permission was granted to open the casket. In the presence of Church authorities and physicians the seal on the casket was broken on April 22, 1950. The liquid composed of sweat and blood continued to flow from Father Charbel's body, which remained flexible and lifelike.

While the body was being examined, no less than 5,000 pilgrims each day were arriving at the monastery. On feasts and Sundays, the numbers exceeded 15,000. Many traveled from distant countries in anticipation of a cure or favor. In just two years after exhuming the body of Father Charbel, the monastery had collected 1,200 reports of miracles.

A SAINT FOR LEBANON Two of these miracles reported were accepted by the Sacred Congregation for Father Charbel's beatification. Sister Maria Kamary suffered from gastric ulcers for 14 years and was completely bedridden. Neither surgery nor medication brought relief. She could not eat and received the last sacraments on three occasions. Brought to the tomb of Father Charbel for fervent prayer, she was completely and spontaneously healed. Her doctor testified: "This was a supernatural happening which is beyond man's power to explain."

Mr. Alessandro Obeid was blinded in an accident when the retinas of his eyes were torn when struck by a tree branch. Brought to the tomb of the hospital to have the doctors examine

Father Charbel, his sight was miraculously restored. After a thorough examination, his doctor concluded: "This can only be from an Almighty Will which operated only by divine grace. There is no other explanation and it is certain that we have seriously sought an explanation without finding one."

A third time Father Charbel's remains were exhumed in 1965, and once again they were found intact and secreting the same liquid. On December 5, 1965, Pope Paul VI presided at the beatification of Father Charbel in Saint Peter's Square.

For reasons known only to God, when Father Charbel's remains were exhumed in 1976 it was found that the body had succumbed to the effects of nature. Only the skeleton remained. This did not, however, stop the flow of miracles even for an instant. October 9, 1977, Pope Paul VI canonized Saint Charbel. Bishop Francis Zayek, head of the U.S. Diocese of Saint Maron, said: "Saint Charbel is like a Cedar of Lebanon, standing in eternal prayer on top of a mountain."

MIRACLES AROUND THE WORLD

Since his death over a century ago, Saint Charbel has taken his place among the greatest miracle workers of the Church. Nearly every Catholic in Lebanon knows personally someone who has benefited from the healing power of this great saint.

In 1993, a 55-year-old woman from Lebanon named Nouad El Shami suffered paralysis on the left side of her body. After examinations, the doctors said there was no treatment for her condition. Returning home. Nouad later recounted a dream she had on the night of January 22, 1993. In the dream, two Maronite monks stood over her bed. One laid hands on her neck and operated on her, while the other assisted holding her pillow. When she awoke, she discovered two wounds on her neck. She was completely cured and could walk again without trouble. The next night, Saint Charbel appeared to her in her dream stating: "I did the surgery to let people see and return to faith. I ask you to visit the hermitage where I lived on the 22nd of each month, and to attend Mass regularly for the rest of your life." Since that day, the faithful fulfill this request and gather each month to pray at the hermitage.

Early in 2012, a 17-year-old boy from Venezuela named Hanna Jabbour went to large red welts on his legs. After running tests and consulting a specialist, Hanna was diagnosed with blood cancer. Young Hanna was given just six months to live. His condition prompted an extended stay in intensive care.

Hanna was in the hospital for 20 days when his uncle came to visit him. His uncle had returned from Saint Charbel's monastery and brought a photograph of the saint for his nephew. Hanna thanked his uncle and placed the photo of Saint Charbel under his pillow. When his visitors left that evening Hanna prayed the rosary and asked Saint Charbel for healing.

That same week Hanna's father was staying with him in the hospital room. He was awakened when Hanna complained of feeling something cold on his back. Hanna's father lifted him up and found the photo of Saint Charbel on his back, covered in fresh blood. Pulling the photo off, he was stunned to find that his son was not bleeding, having no cuts or bruises.

Immediately Hanna's father called for the priest. Within the hour the priest arrived, and on seeing the astounding event told them not to reveal the photo to anyone, but simply have the doctors examine Hanna. In the morning, the doctors ran new tests, and were astonished to find no trace of the cancer.

On leaving the hospital in perfect health, Hanna Jabbour showed the blood-stained photo to everyone and recounted how Saint Charbel had healed him. Even greater than this healing was the fact that Hanna's family members, away from the sacraments, began to lead devout lives once again and spread devotion to Saint Charbel.

Saint of Miracles - Part 22 Recent Documented

The testimony in the following miracle involves miracle after St. Sharbel Feast Day Miss Sally Abdo Chaaya was born in Deir ElQamar 1993 and worked as a lawyer. As she

tells about her health condition attached to the medical reports: "In February 2020, I had a pain in my stomach for one week. I visited Dr. Rosette Daaboul in the Hospital, and after having done the necessary tests, she found an inflammation of the stomach and intestine. So she referred me to Dr. Geagea, who performed endoscopy for my stomach and intestine which found an ulcer in the intestine telling me that I suffer from Crohn's disease. He offered me a medicine that would accompany me for the rest of my life. To get a second opinion, I visited Dr. Philip Senior in the hospital at Mar Youssef Hospital, and after renewing the tests, he let my treatment continue and asked me to repeat the tests every two months. My inflammation had been increasing every month.

So I started praying to the Lord asking for the intercession of St Charbel to heal me from my chronic illness, and as well my mother and my family were asking for his intercession. On June 17, Saint Charbel appeared in my dream in this way: "I saw that I was in front of the monastery gate at night and I was screaming with a loud voice, so St Charbel opened the door and said Literally to me: why are you screaming? I am with you, but you are not! You: you don't go to Mass" and then the dream ended. The next day, June the 11th, I had the last examination, and I was waiting for the result. Finally, but on June 22, 2020 I took the result from the doctor who showed his amazement as the result came that the inflammation had disappeared. The doctor praised God for my recovery. "I went to the Monastery of St Sharbel and thanked him for healing me and the medical report and recorded the miracle on June 27, 2020.

Miracle No. 47 - - - Ms. Claude Said Al-Khoury was born in Kafr Zabd 1973 and lives in Jbeil, a plastic surgeon. As she tells about her health condition attached to the medical reports: "I felt an external pain in the pelvis, so I visited Dr. Aboud. After laboratory tests, he scheduled a date, September 29th, 2019 for me to have a surgical operation to remove the cancerous disease from the ovary. Before surgery I dreamed, I saw a cup of yogurt in front of the picture of St Sharbel. In the cup I saw 3 Black points and a pinkish point. Ten days after the operation, I underwent a biopsy, and the result came back that I had cancer in the ovary, the bowel, and the urinary tract, and this is the interpretation of the three black points.

In this difficult stage, I prayed to St Sharbel asking for the grace of healing. The doctor decided to conduct 18 sessions of chemo before doing the surgery. After the ninth session, he asked me to have an MRI. The result showed the disappearance of the cancerous disease and the inflammation reduced. My Doctor, Marwan Ghosn, was totally amazed at the result and repeated the exams several times. During this time I never stopped praying and visiting the Monasteries of Saint Charbel and of Saint Rafga asking them to heal me from my disease. Today I have come back to full health and I thank Saint Charbel for his intercession and healing. I went to the Monastery of St Sharbel with the entire medical report and recorded the miracle on July 14, 2020.

STRANGE LIGHTS IN THE SKY... THE SIGN?

I was born in 1930, the seventh of ten children. We lived on a forty acre farm which supplied all our food. The winters in Michigan were sometimes brutal, but we were always prepared with everything ahead of time. We had a large garden and everyone helped planting and harvesting all the vegetables and cannning fruit. My mother and dad were so patient, seeing that each one of us did our share of the work. There was always fun things to do if we had time after all the chores were done. Once in a while there would be a day that was not good, and I would feel bad. I would run crying, down into the woods. I had a guiet spot where I would sit and talk to the Blessed Mother. Although I never saw her, nor heard Her voice, I felt that She was there. In a short time, my problems were solved, and I would return to the house happy again.

In the summer time after dark, after our day's work was done, we liked sitting in the large front yard and hearing dad's Irish stories, and talking about our day's work and what we had to do the next day. We loved watching the "northern lights" and counting the falling stars. This one night we were watching and like an instant, the entire sky was covered with all colors of moving lights, with no set patterns, all bright and covering the entire sky! I jumped up and said, "LOOK AT THE LIGHTS!" Nobody else saw it! They all ignored what I said and remarked, "There isn't any colors up there!" I got scared and ran to our old Model T car and climbed into the back seat and hid! I peeked out every few minutes, and it was still there! Later, everyone would laugh and say I was crazy, and they didn't see any bright lights, which would make me feel sad. I was 8 or 9 years old at the time, and so many times I remembered how it looked and why my brothers and sisters didn't see it that night. I would think about it on and off for years later and felt afraid. A few years later WWII began!

About sixty years later I happened to read "The True Story of Fatima," and that Blessed Mother had said, "When you see strange lights in the sky, that soon a world war will begin," I believe now, that this is what I saw The Blessed Mother has always been a big important part of my life, and looking back,

this event was a blessing for sure.


