- 5. Out of two ANMA trustee nominations, only past president Bala Ghimire is confirmed, the second name will be finalized in the next executive meeting.
- 6. General Secretary Om Dahal made an update on the "One Province One Computer Lab" project, an initiative of his 2021 Columbus Marathon sponsored by ANMA.
 - Fund collection is completed to build 9 computer labs.
 - Out of 9, 3 computer labs respectively in Province 1, 2 & 3 were built and handovered
 - Remaining 6 computer labs will be handovered once the rainy season ends in Nepal.
 - Meeting thanked all the donors including Executive Members Dev Bastola, Sandeep Singh and Guthee Foundation for sponsoring one computer lab with 10 computers.
