COURSE LIST/CURRICULUM

- **1. Temporary Traffic Control (TTC) Advanced Full Course (20 HR)**: This **20-hour** course is required for personnel with the responsibility or authority to decide on the specific MOT requirements to be implemented in the State of Florida. These positions include:
- •The engineer responsible for the Work Zone traffic control plan development (TCP)
- •The Work Zone traffic control supervisor

The course is designed for individuals actively involved in the design of temporary traffic control in a work zone. Participants learn to read and interpret plans and specifications, and implement them in the field. As well as, how to design and implement temporary traffic control plans to make the project as safe as possible for fellow workers, motorists and pedestrians.

2. TTC Advanced Refresher Course (8 HR): This **8-hour** course is intended for participants who need to maintain their current AMOT certification status. Participants review:

- **3. TTC Intermediate Full Course (16 HR)**: This **16-hour** course is required for personnel with the responsibility or authority to decide on the specific MOT requirements to be implemented in the State of Florida.

- Group workshops on traffic plans
- Flagging operations
- Successful completion of this course allows individuals to train flaggers for their company.
- **4. TTC Intermediate Refresher Course (8 HR)**: This **8-hour** course is intended for participants who need to maintain their current IMOT certification status. Participants review:
- Proper and effective documentation in the event of disputes and litigation
- Design exercises and problem solving of MOT plans
- Group workshops on traffic plans

- Flagging operations
- **5. TTC Basic/Flagger Course (4 HR)**: The primary objectives of this **4-hour** course is to train flaggers to provide safe passage of traffic through and around work areas and to minimize confusion by following approved flagging procedures. Participants will learn:
- •Thorough understanding of flagging procedures and proper use of required equipment
- •Improved flagging skills from hands-on training, classroom activities and a flagging skills test
- •Increased ability to coordinate traffic movement through the work zone
