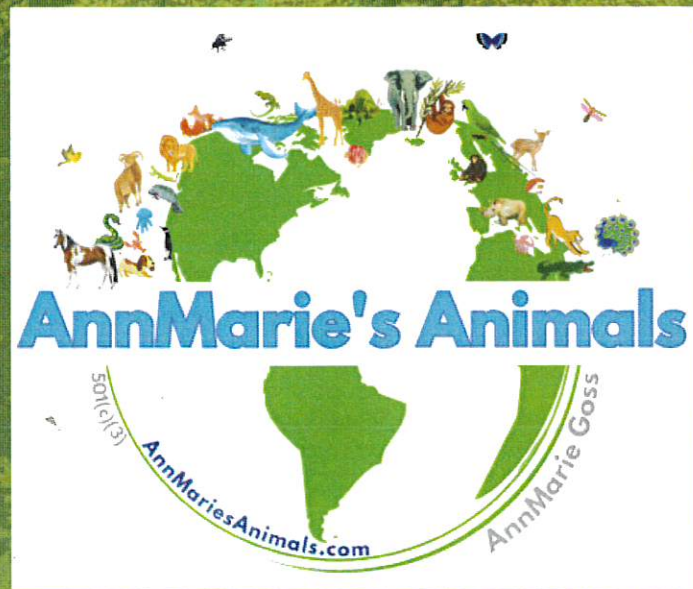

A habitat is the home of a plant or animal.

The Forest

The Mountains

The Prairie

Prairies have mild winters and hot summers, animals like Buffalo and Yak live there

Pond

A Pond is freshwater, animals like frogs and salamanders love to live in ponds

Marsh

A Marsh is usually where a freshwater source, like a river, meets a salt water source, like an ocean

The Tundra

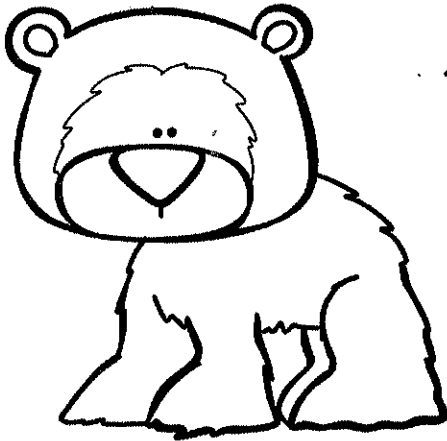
The Tundra climate is cold winters and mild summers, Animals need warm fur to live in the Tundra
