Tech Inspection

- 1) All drivers shall complete a signed self-tech inspection form and submit by email by Midnight 17 October 2022. There is not enough time for officials to review during the WCLM.
 - a. All cars shall be subject to on-site tech inspection at the Thursday WCLM Reception and Friday Safety Meeting.
 - b. All advanced class cars shall be subject to spot inspection on the day of the event.
 - c. Participants shall include proof of ownership and proof of insurance with completed Self Tech form or provide photographic copy of same to inspectors at Thursday or Friday tech session.
- 2) No motorcycles, trucks or high center of gravity are allowed to participate in the hillclimb.

Self Tech Form

- Crash helmet is Z90, DOT or better compliant – Novice & Intermediate classes.
- Crash helmet is Snell SA 2015 or better compliant. – Advanced class.
- No Snell M (motorcycle) or Snell K (karting) helmets allowed for any class.
- Seatbelts must be fitted. Check condition of seat belts. Look for fraying and excessive wear. Check seat belt mounts. Where fitted, ensure seat belt inertial stopping mechanisms effectively lock and unlock when loaded & unloaded
- Check seats are securely and adequately fixed and where fitted reclining mechanisms are in good working order
- Where fitted, ensure fire suppression systems / fire extinguishers are adequately and securely mounted.
- Where fitted, ensure aftermarket any radio / communications equipment is securely and adequately mounted
- Where fitted, ensure cameras are adequately and securely mounted.
- Remove all loose objects from trunk and from within the passenger compartment.
- Remove wheel covers and/or hub caps.
- Check lug nuts for tightness. Tighten to proper torque.
- Check tire pressures and ensure tire pressures are appropriate for the road and weather conditions and entry class.
- Check tires for condition and tread depth. Cracking, odd wear patterns, baldness of the tires are indications of excessive wear and weathering. 5 years old per sidewall date code maximum. Replace tires as needed.
- Check battery tie-down. Battery must be securely fastened to the car. Positive battery terminal must be adequately insulated
- Check brake linings for wear. Check for firm brake pedal. Confirm that all brake lines and fittings are free from cracks, defects or other signs of wear.
- Check steering for looseness.
- Check wheel bearings for excessive play when weighted.
- Check engine oil, brake fluid and coolant levels. Top off as needed.
- Check for fluid leaks. Confirm that all hoses are free from cracks, defects or other signs of wear.
- Check shock absorbers by the bounce method.
- Check fuel level. Have 1/2 tank maximum.
