If you would like a more detailed account of the income and expenses, look for the report on the table in the church entrance. This wonderful blessing of donations received in December helps our finances. It helped get many bills paid that were set aside on a pile because there were no funds to pay them.

All daily expenses are caught up to date. Donations have come in for the following items over the past year that need to be remitted.

Mission \$ 11,244.00 (Includes Missionary Mahlburg's \$4000 to support his ministry)

Cemetery Fund \$6,600.00

Church Extension \$10,000

(per congregation vote to pay down principal \$40,000.00 was already sent still need to send the \$10,000.)

After these funds are remitted, we have about \$35,000.00 in the bank account which will cover payroll for the month of January.
