

The Ring Championships Virtual Competition Guidelines

RULES

- All registrations must include team roster and video/photo-release
- All videos must be submitted by the video submission deadline no later than
 9:00 pm Eastern Standard Time
- The start of each video must include a Video Submission Label, which will include the organization name, team name, division, # of athletes competing, recording/submission time, and assigned submission code (check forms for the label)
- Submit one video per team with a backup
- Appropriate legal competing surface must be able to view the entire floor and team with NO OBSTRUCTIONS.
- Uniforms are preferred, will accept unified practice wear.
- No release/waivers are required for virtual events
- Please make sure your roster count matches the video count. Judges will confirm the team count.
- Follow the age, division requirements, and guidelines as outlined by YCADA and OCS. Please reference designated websites for requirements and guidelines.
- Judging will adhere to the rules and guidelines of the following organizations.

VIDEO GUIDELINES

- We recommend 2 devices when filming (one for a backup), using a phone, tablet, computer, and/or web camera
- Devices need to have a Wi-fi connection
- Device should be on a stand for stability to ensure minimal movement during recording.

- We require no cheering during the performance. WE NEED to hear the music and see the routine. Please refrain from walking, jumping, and cheering during the performance.
- Once registration and payment have been submitted, you'll receive an email
 with an assigned video submission code, appointed day, and time to submit
 the video.
- Videos will be uploaded to your RegChamp Account, a backup recording of each team is REQUIRED.
- Score sheets will be emailed to coaches but can also be found on your RegChamp account following awards.
- Awards will be held virtually for all participants. Please refer to the website for the schedule
- All divisions will be available to view during our Watch Party, check the website for additional information.

AWARDS

 GRAND CHAMPIONS (highest scoring team of the entire competition) will receive a Championship Banner

MARCH MADNESS CASH OUT

- 50% of your gym must register and compete to qualify for cash prizes.
- Highest scoring Level 1 or 2 team will receive \$500.
- Highest scoring Level 3 or 4 team will receive \$500.
- Highest scoring Level 5 or 6 team will receive \$500.
- For maximum compensation to be awarded, 6 teams must be eligible in each prize classification.

APRIL EASTER CASH OUT

- 50% of your gym must register and compete to qualify for cash prizes.
- Highest scoring Level 1 or 2 team will receive \$500.
- Highest scoring Level 3 or 4 team will receive \$500.
- Highest scoring Level 5 or 6 team will receive \$500.
- For maximum compensation to be awarded, 6 teams must be eligible in each prize classification.
