Motorcycle Barrel Race Rules

- One team member runs the barrel pattern horseback.
- Time starts when the horse crosses the start line.
- Time stops when the horse crosses the finish line.
- After all teams have run their barrel run, the second team member runs the pattern on their motorcycle. (4-wheelers are allowed)
- Time starts when the motorcycle crosses the start line.
- Time stops when the motorcycle crosses the finish line.
- Tipped barrel adds 5 second penalty.
- Broken pattern is a DQ.
- Horse time and Motorcycle time are added together. Fastest combined time wins the event.

Riders may run either right or left for the first barrel. Teams may share bikes but must provide their own.

Hide Race Rules

- One team member is horseback, the other rides the hide.
- Horseback rider dallies rope w/ hide tied on; second team member rides hide.
- Horseback rider pulls second team member on hide down the arena, around a barrel and back across finish line.
- Time starts at the drop of the flag.
- Knocked over barrel is 5 second penalty.
- Lost hide rider is DQ.
- Time ends when the hide rider crosses the finish line on the hide.

Rescue Race Rules

- One person horseback, one person starts on top of barrel.
- Horseback person runs to first barrel and around headed to second barrel.
- Horseback person picks up (rescues) their partner on the second barrel.
- Horseback person and rescued team member run around the 3rd barrel riding double and run home.
- Time starts when the rider crosses the start line.
- Time ends when the two riders cross the finish line.
- Knocked barrel is 5 second penalty.
- If the team member falls off the barrel while attempting to be rescued, they may get back on the barrel and attempt again.
- Team member may NOT mount the horse from the ground.
- If the team member or rider fall off at anytime after the team member is picked up DQ.
