- **3.** Outside Coordinator by Bob Stokes: hardcopies were passed out and were reviewed Bob Stokes had all events included in his initial report. Bob will report on local upcoming events outside of NCRS events for future reports.
- **4. Inside Coordinator by John Jefferies:** my report has been submitted for 2018 4th Quarter. Chapter should qualify for Top Flight again for 2018.
- **5.** Newsletter Editor by Jimmy Patitucci: still need technical articles for future upcoming issues would like to have regional director Sue Strawmyre submit an update on National NCRS developments Will continue to send newsletter to Golden Quill awards.

6. Judging Chairman by Bill Bryan: Bill noted that chapters are permitted to conduct Concours judging at all meets. Bill wasn't sure how points are awarded to Concours judges. We should include Concours in our chapter meet in June and conduct judges training prior.

Somehow we need to advertise the B&D show to a wider audience to get more attendance. Need sponsors to help offset costs (John Kuhns). Don to contact John Kuhns about speaker for the judges training on 3/10, because Bill might want to change the agenda.
