## N. Other Ideas for the Good of the Organization: (Board Member's Name/ Topic/ Comments)

Comments: There was a lengthy conversation about the state of the organization, National and Chapter, regarding declining membership. This is a very difficult problem because the organization has traditionally focused on the restoration and preservation of the C1s, C2s, and C3s. We need younger members, but these antiques are generally not available to younger, potential Corvette owners. If they can afford a Corvette, they are C4s, C5, and C6s and these cars are either in low-milage, unrestored condition or the owner wants to modify them. Certainly, a challenge that requires organizational change. Suggestions included partnering with local Chevrolet dealers for events, more road trips, and attending (but not promoting) local Corvette car shows. Mike Bucheit suggested a review of the bylaws regarding member participation, having the board reach out to members to see what they want, and to ask members to help with events. John Kuhns suggested we separate the board meeting from a member meeting. Allen Hawks asked if we really understand our members in terms of demographics.
